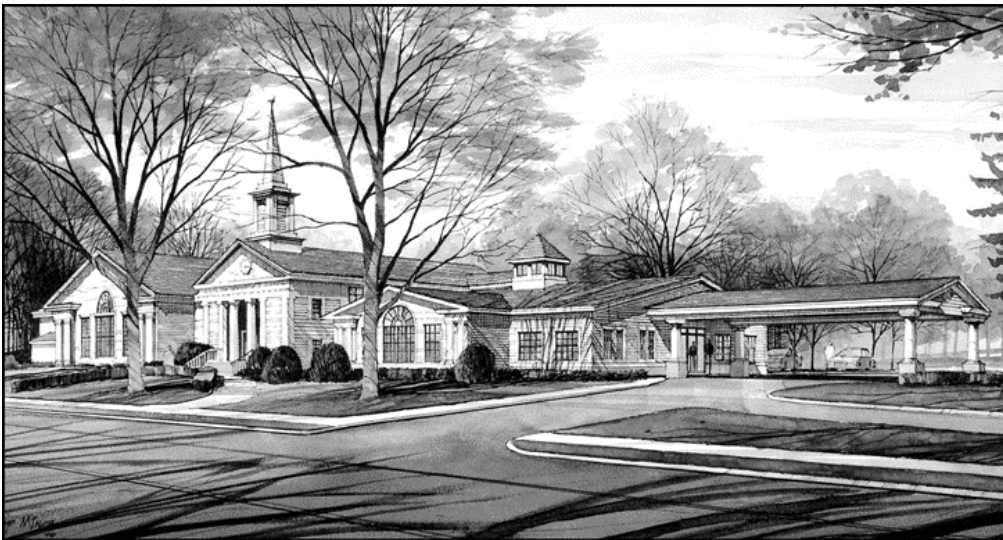

**\*Gathering Prayer**
