- 1. The Ramps for Independence Project provides and eligible people with disabilities and senior citizens (62 years or older) Broward County residents financial assistance for modifications to their home to increase accessibility and provide health and safety repairs.
- 2. Must own home- Single Family, Apartment Home, Condominium, or Townhome.
- 3. Must Live in the following cities: Cooper City, Dania Beach, Hallendale Beach, Hillsboro Beach, Lauderdale-by-the-Sea, Lauderdale Lakes, Lazy Lake Village, Lighthouse Point, North Lauderdale, Oakland Park, Parkland, Pembroke Park, Sea Ranch Lakes, Southwest Ranches, Weston, West Park, Wilton Manors, or Unincorporated.
- 4. Must meet income eligibility guidelines.
