Congratulations on your decision to apply to the Leadership CILB program! Leadership CILB offers you an opportunity to improve your leadership ability and develop the knowledge and skills to become a strong disability advocate.

The annual leadership program begins with an Opening Retreat in September. The following monthly Program Days will expose participants to the competencies necessary for strong leadership and advocacy and allow them to network with community leaders. During the program year, participants also work together on a community project designed to put their leadership into practice. The program culminates with a Graduation Reception in May where the graduates mingle with Leadership alumni.

Thanks to the generosity of our supporters and corporate sponsorship, <u>we are able to offer scholarships to program participants</u> that cover the program cost so there is no cost to those selected to participate in the program.

Program graduates are afforded special networking and educational opportunities.

Eligible participants must:

- Have a disability
- Commit to full participation and active involvement in the program (Opening Retreat, monthly Program Days, community project activities, and Graduation)
- Arrange for their own transportation to and from Program Day sites and other program meeting locations
- Be willing to be an ambassador of CILB and spokesperson for disability issues

- 3. Participation in the **community project group** process
- 4. Miscellaneous Activities: other activities may be required as part of the program curriculum

CILB recognizes that emergencies do arise and that as a result a participant may not be able to attend all of the required components of the program. However, attendance at certain events is mandatory as being integral to the program. Accordingly, the following policy shall apply to attendance:

<u>Opening Retreat and Graduation</u> – <u>attendance is mandatory</u> at these events. (On a case-by-case basis, a participant may be allowed to miss these events and continue in the program.)

<u>Program Days</u> – a participant who <u>misses more than two (2) program days</u> (or substantial parts thereof) during the year may be dismissed from the program upon review of circumstances.

<u>Notification</u> – in all instances, a participant is required to notify the Program Director of the inability to attend a program or event.
