WHAT IS THE POINT-IN-TIME (PIT) COUNT?

- A count of the sheltered and unsheltered homeless persons carried out on one night in the last 10 calendar days of January.
- Unsheltered Count- count of homeless persons who are living in a place not meant for human habitation (i.e. vehicle, car, abandoned building, bus/train/subway station/airport or anywhere outside)
- Sheltered count-count of persons living in emergency shelters, transitional housing, and safe haven project types

WHAT IS THE POINT-IN-TIME (PIT) COUNT

CONT.?

- The PIT count reflects the number of homeless people at **ONE** point in time within the CoC. These community counts are then reported to HUD and included in the Annual Homeless Assessment Report to Congress
- The goal is for communities to use a combination of PIT data, HIC (i.e. Housing Inventory Count) data, SysPM (i.e. System Performance Measures) data, local HMIS data, and any other local data sources to help drive decisions about who needs help and can be used to estimate costs of providing that help and tracking whether homelessness is growing or decreasing within the given community.

WHO IS NOT INCLUDED IN THE UNSHELTERED PIT COUNT?

Persons staying in:

- Emergency Shelter
- Safe Haven
- Transitional Housing
- Rapid Rehousing
- Permanent Supportive Housing
- Permanent Housing
- Other Permanent Housing

WHO IS NOT INCLUDED IN THE UNSHELTERED PIT COUNT?

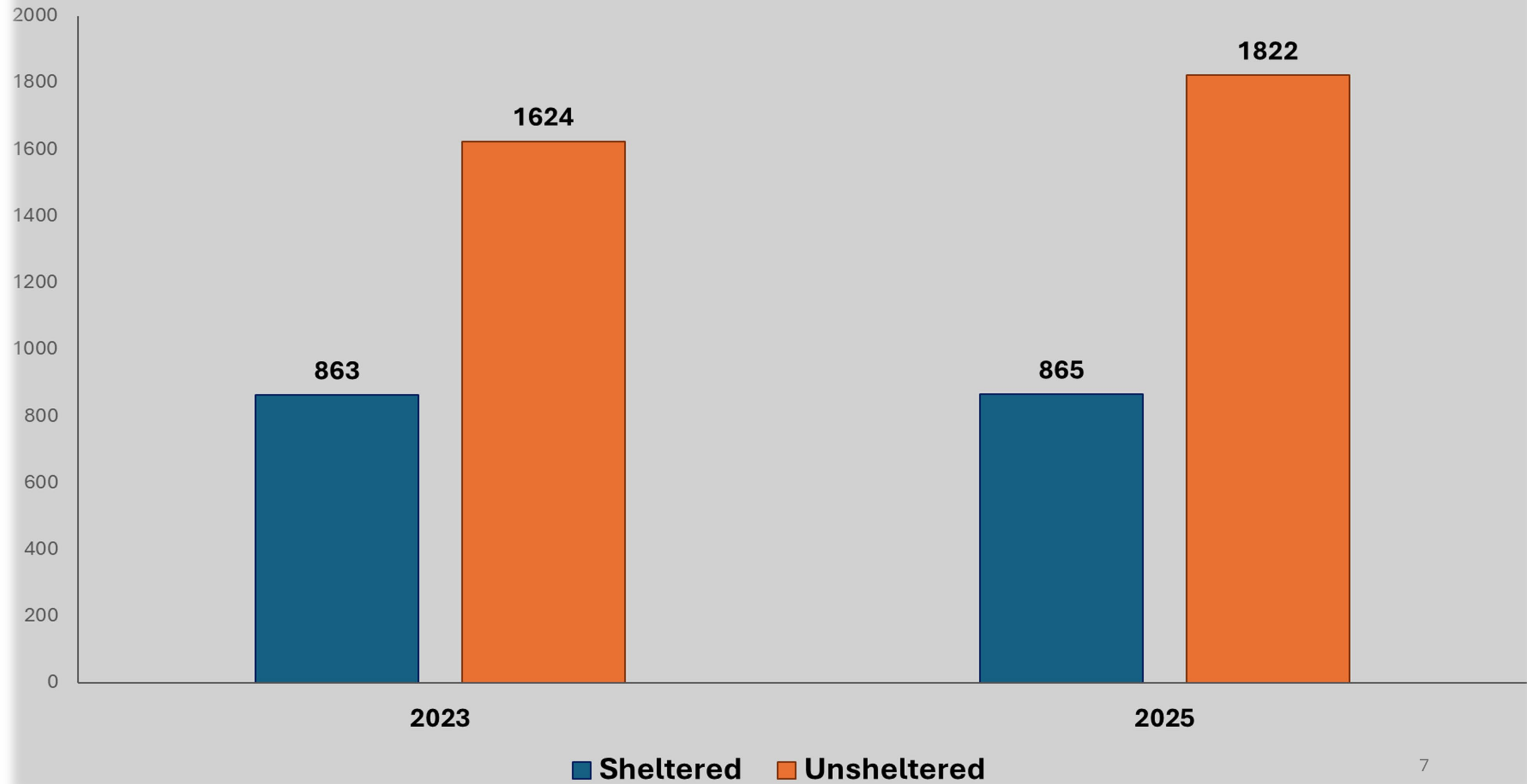
Persons staying:

- With family or friends (i.e. “doubled-up” or “couch surfing”)
- Institutions (i.e. foster care, jail, juvenile detention center, prison, nursing home, hospital, psychiatric hospital or facility, substance abuse treatment facility or detox center)
- In housing they rent or own without rental subsidy/assistance
- Hotels paid for without an emergency shelter voucher

2025 POINT-IN-TIME COUNT PRELIMINARY RESULTS

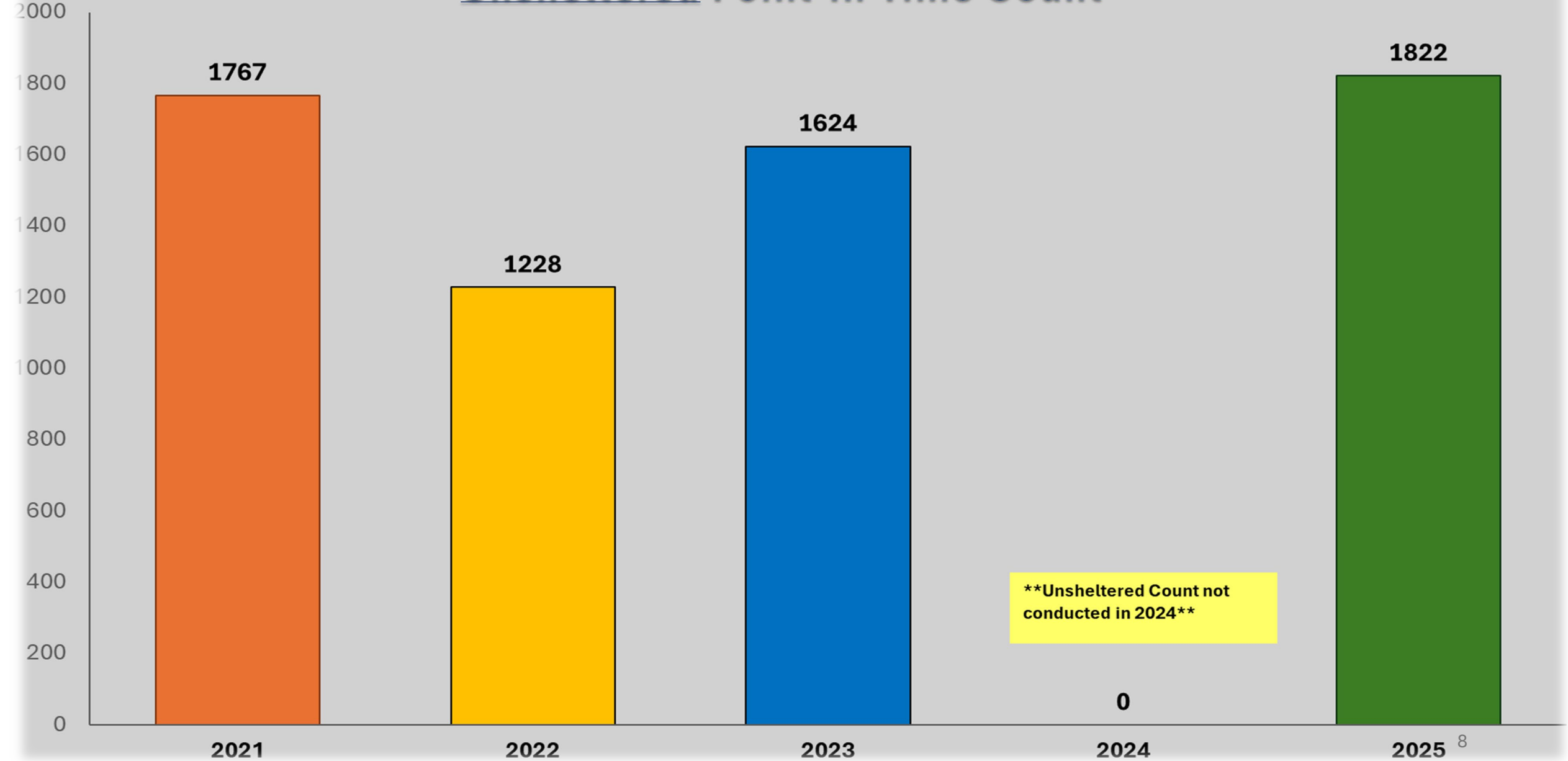


2023 & 2025 Point-In-Time Count Comparison

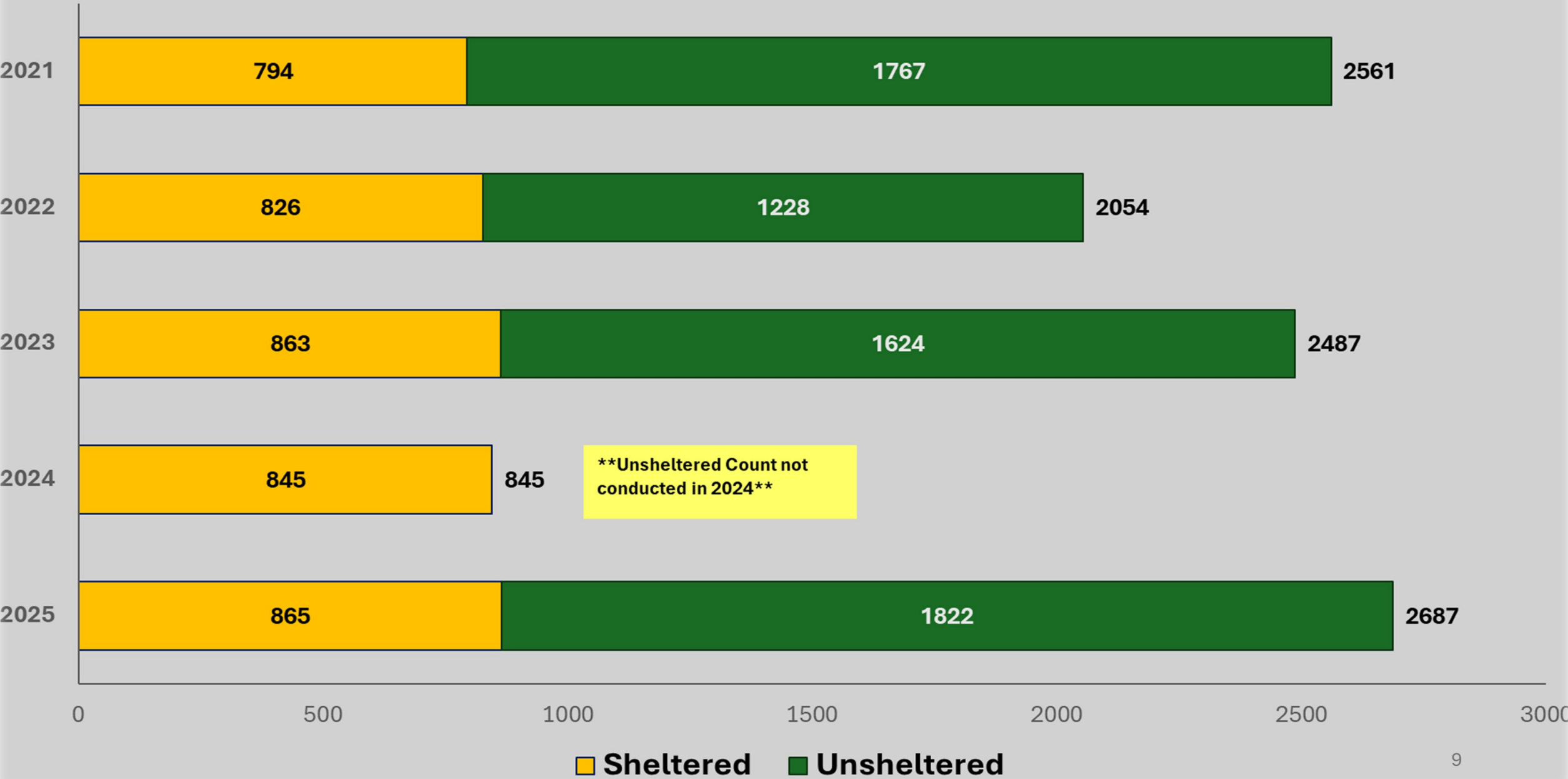


5 Years Comparison

Unsheltered Point-In-Time Count

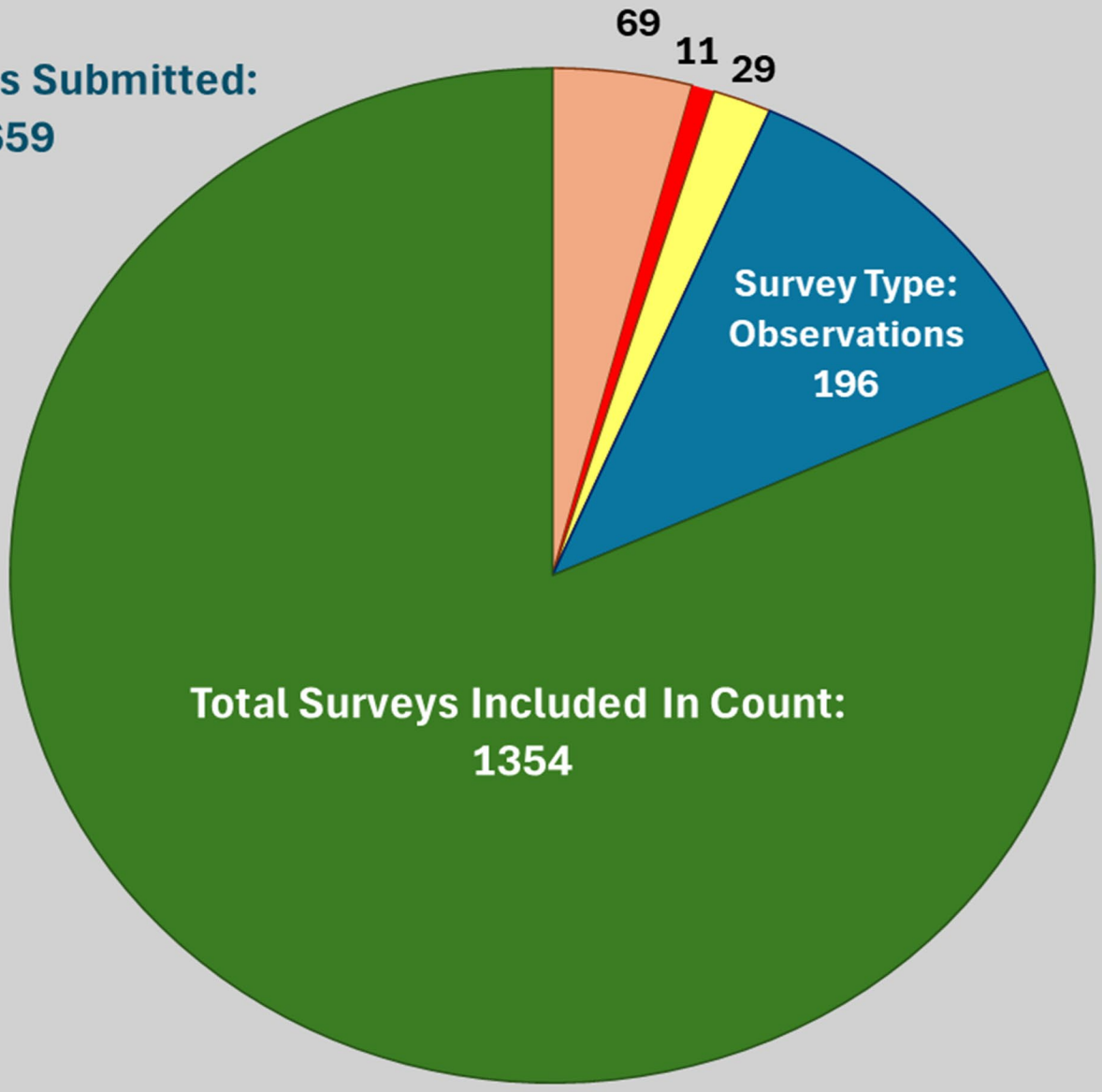


5-Year Point-In-Time Count Longitudinal Perspective



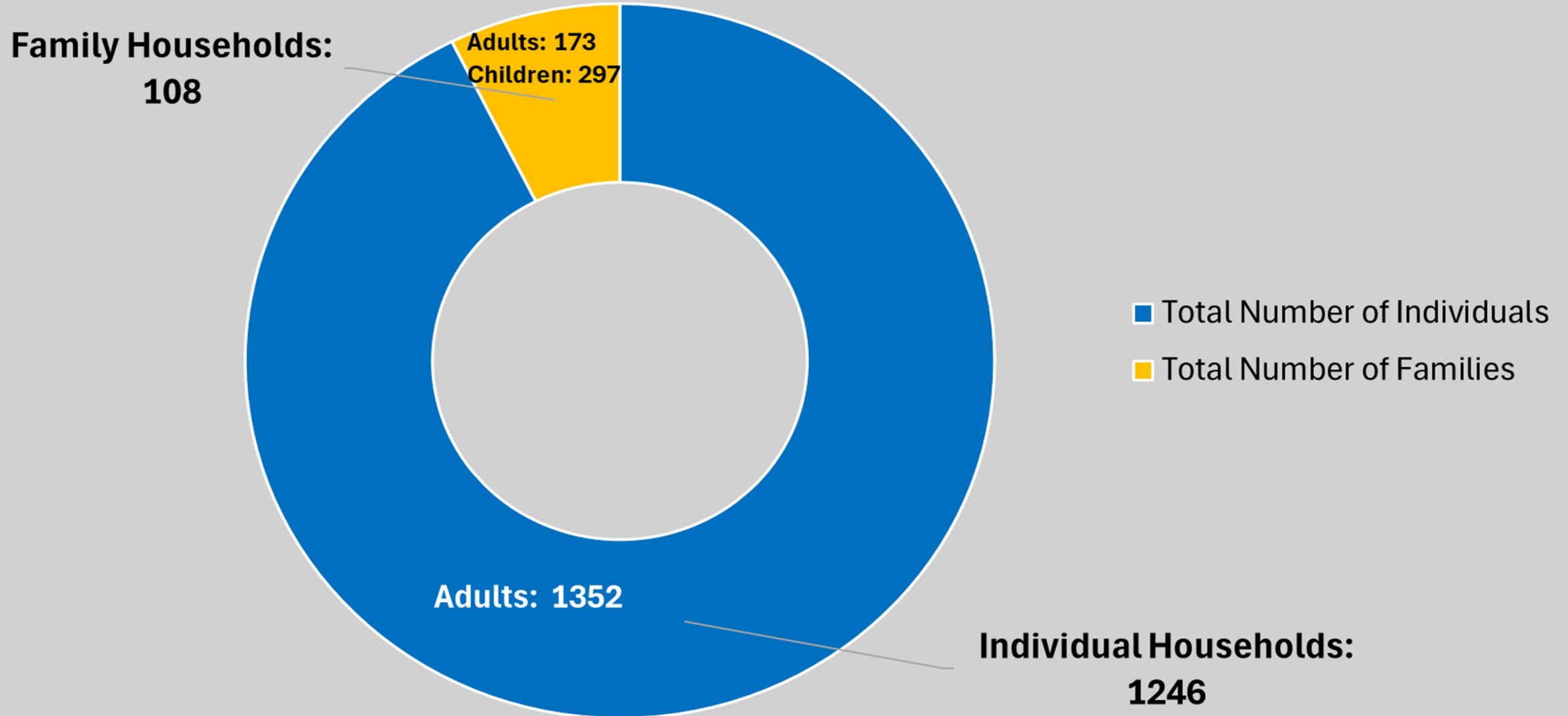
2025 TOTAL SURVEY COUNT

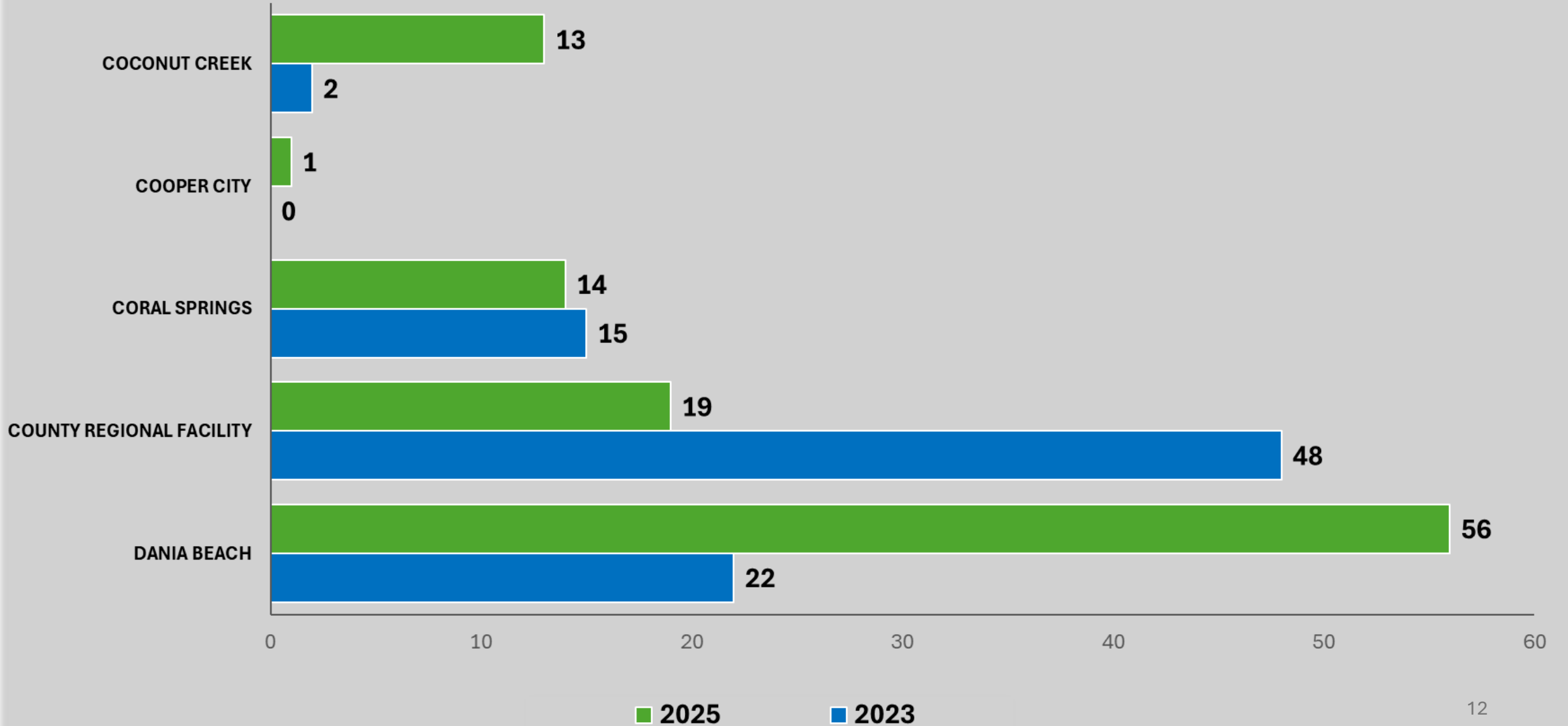

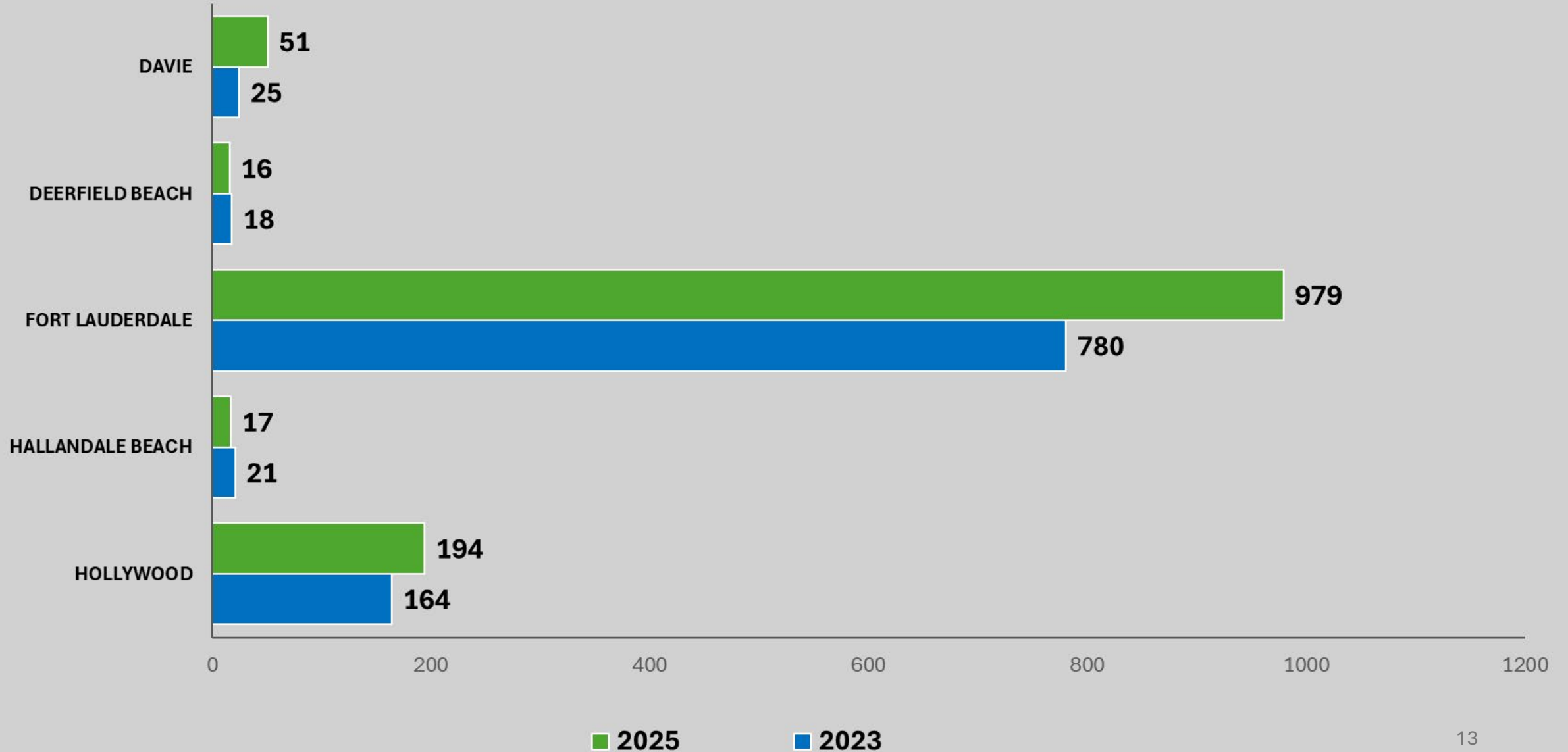
2025 Individuals & Families (Households)



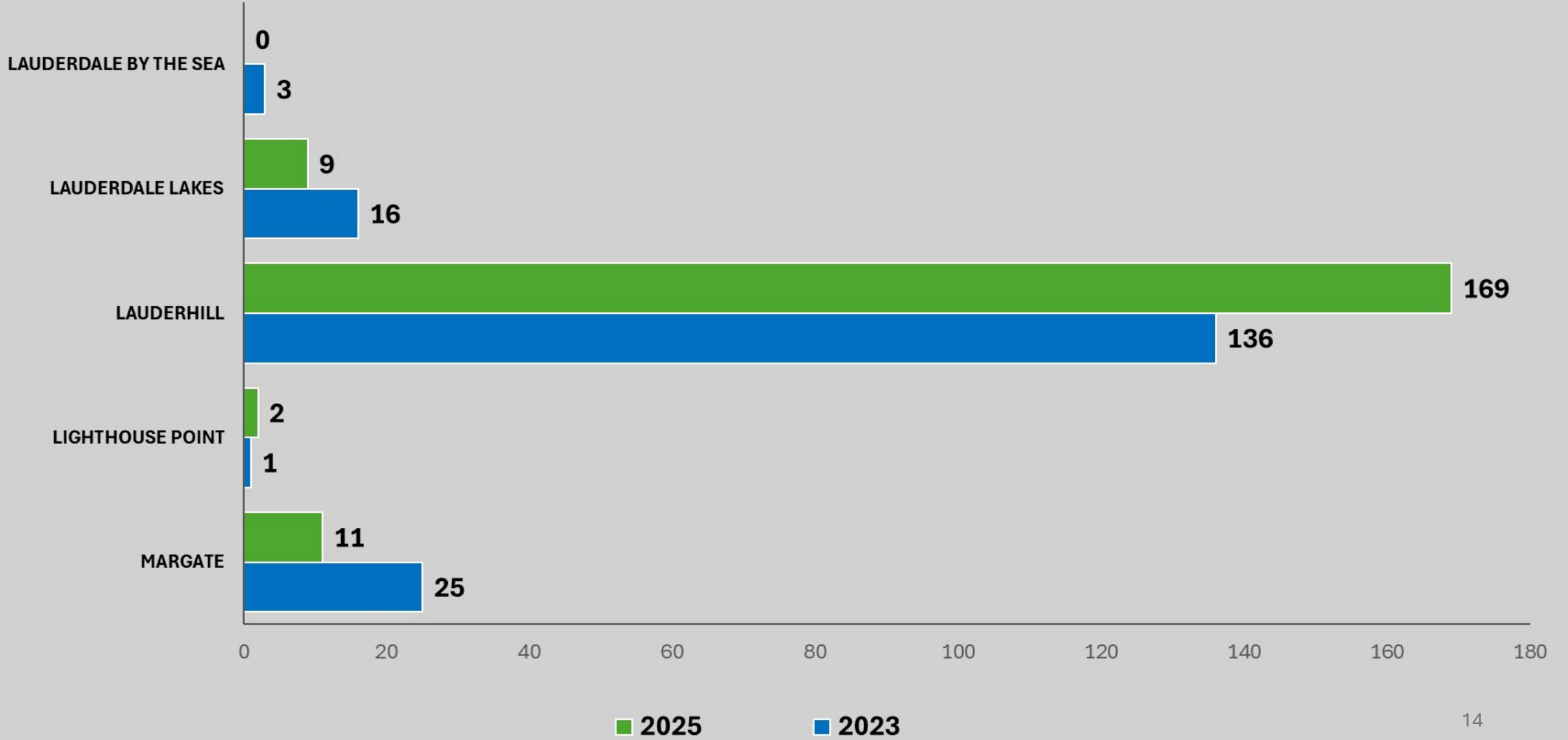
2023 & 2025 UNSHELTERED BY-CITY POINT-IN-TIME COUNT COMPARISON



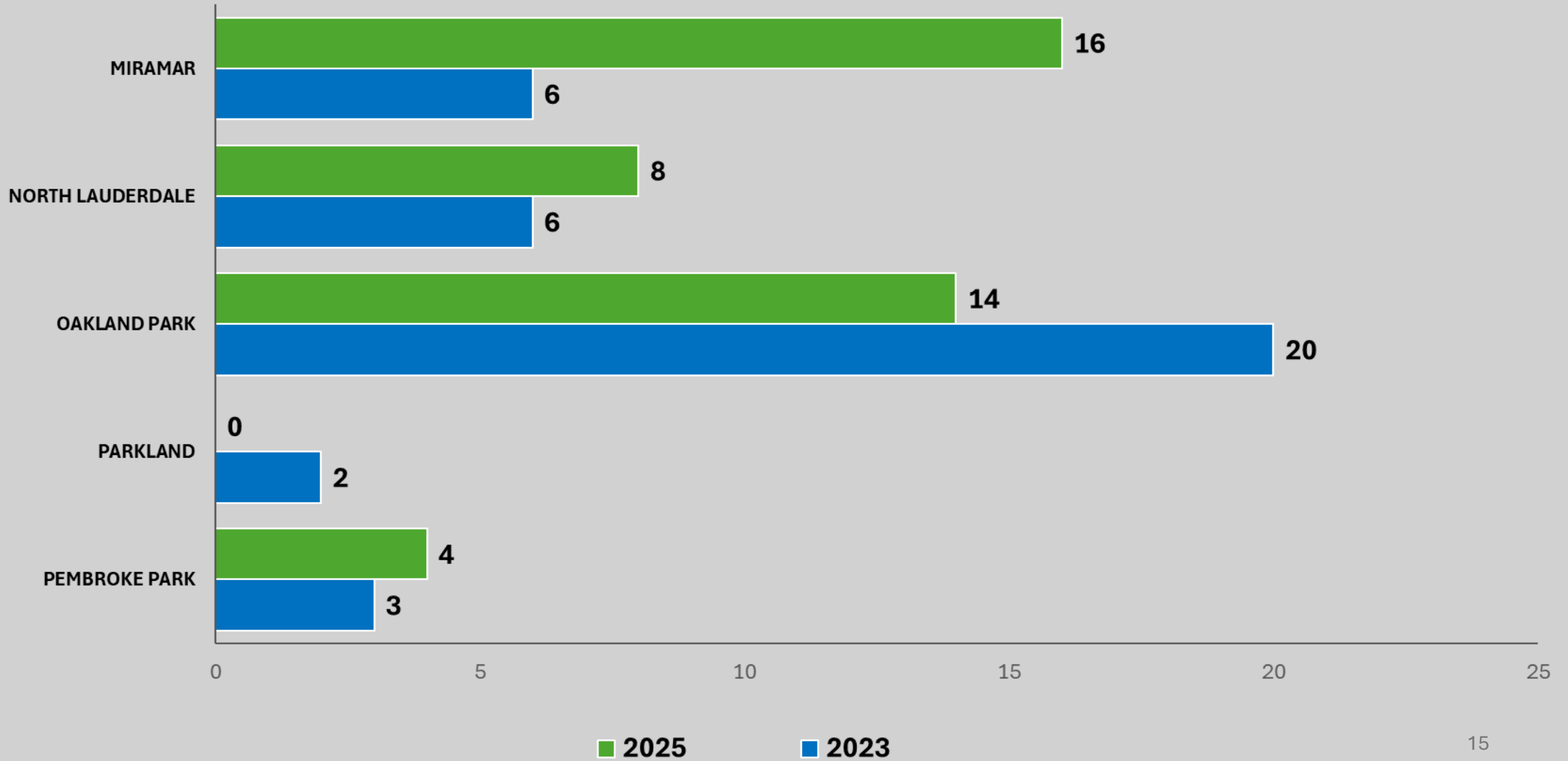
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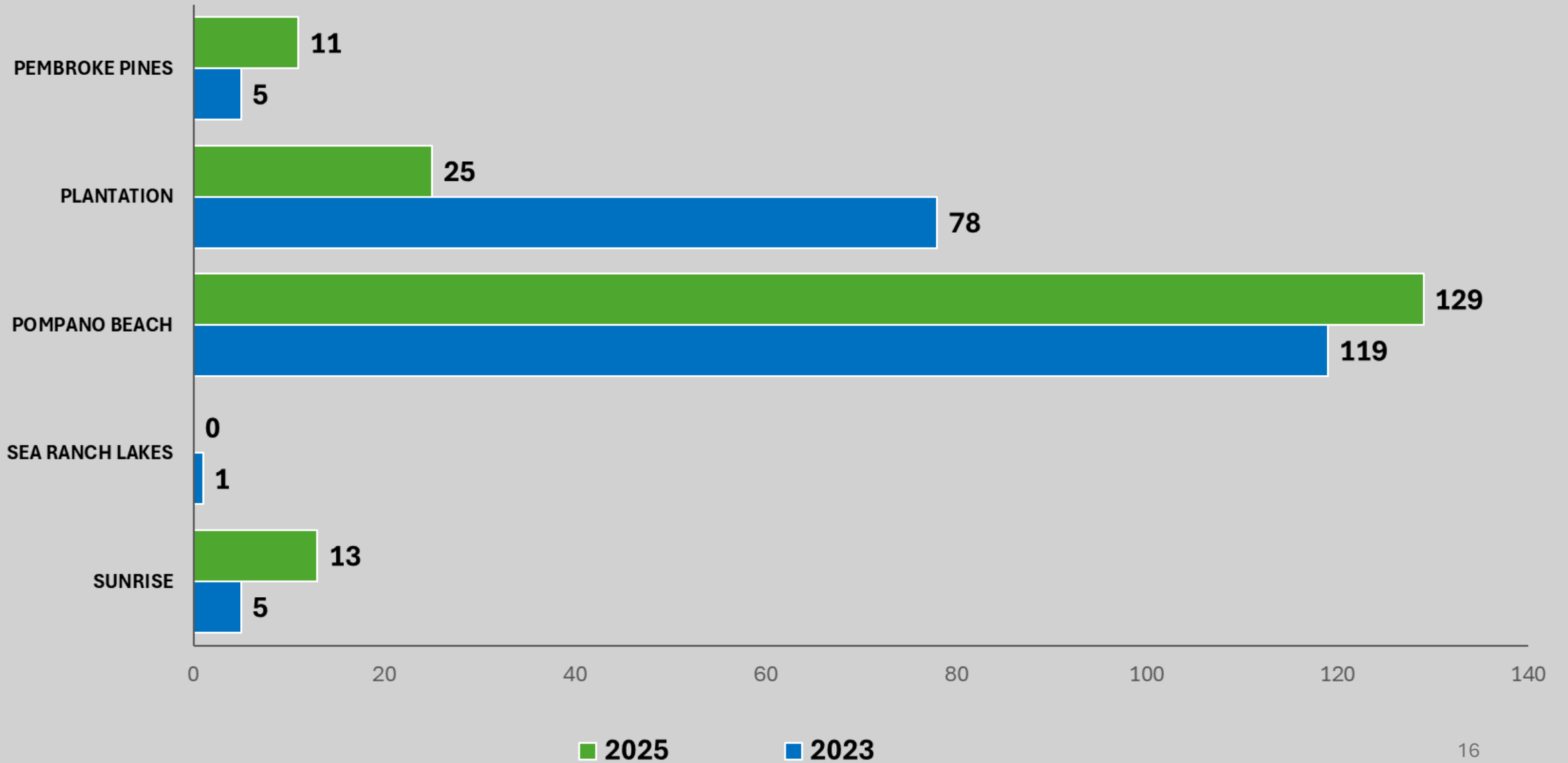
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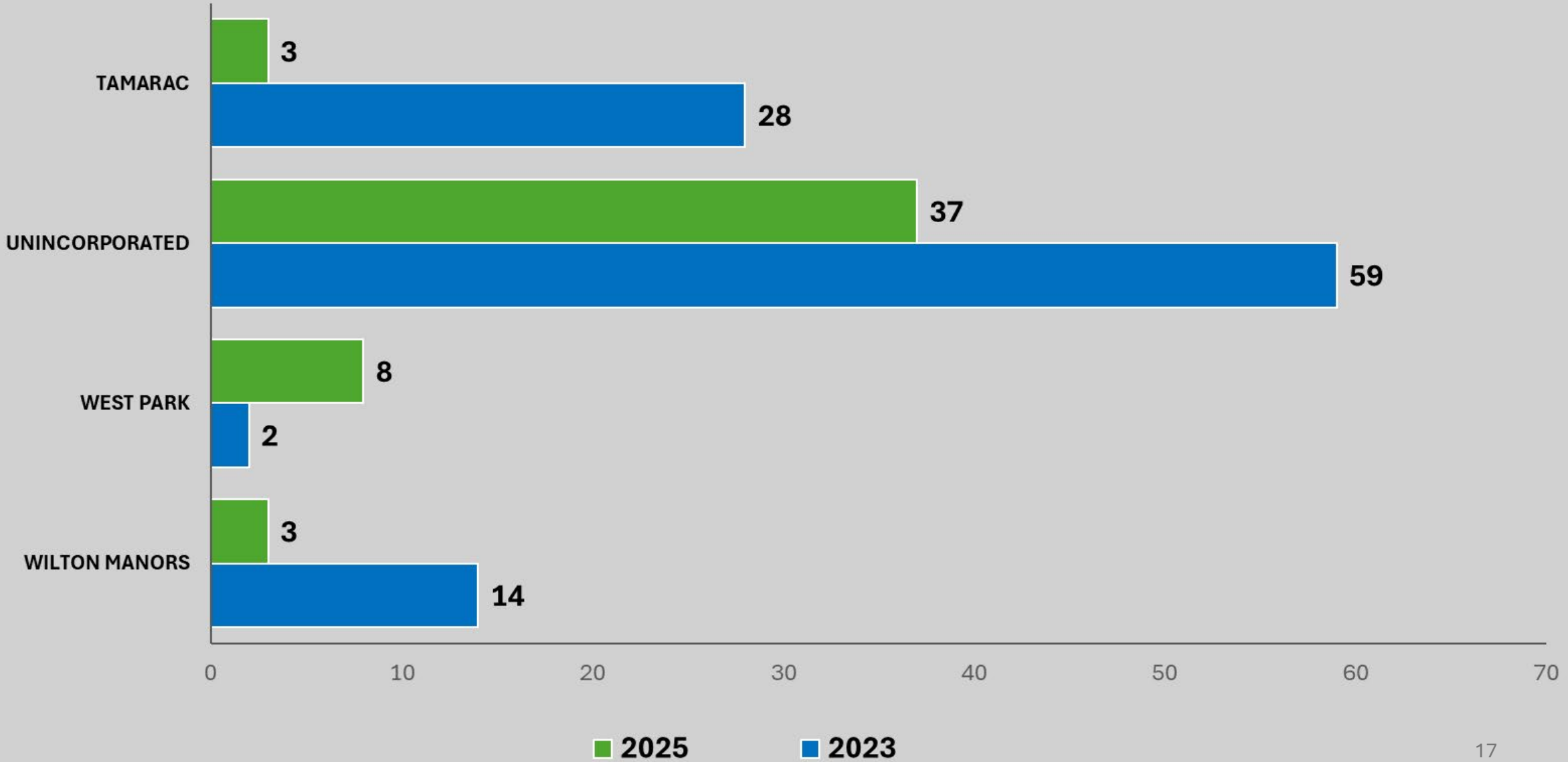
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2023 & 2025 UNSHELTERED BY-CITY POINT-IN-TIME COUNT COMPARISON
