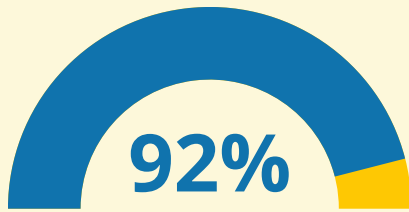

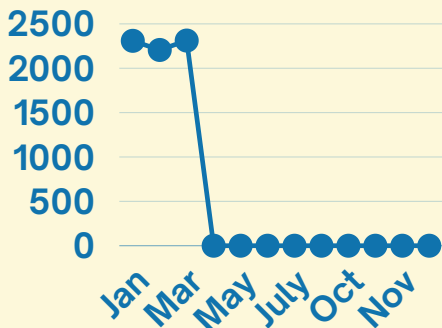

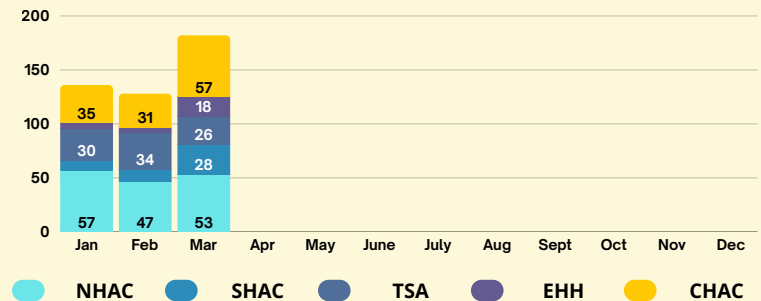

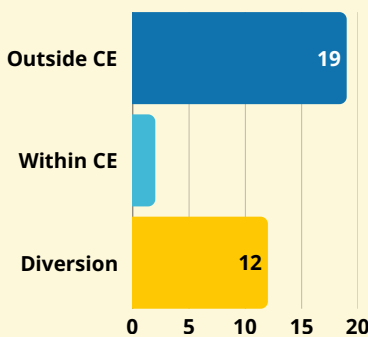

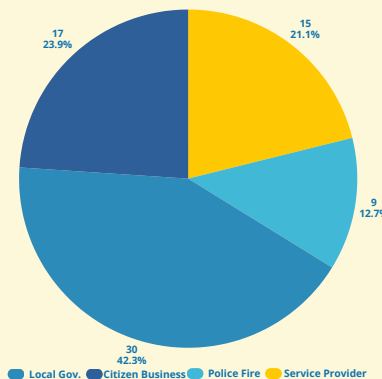

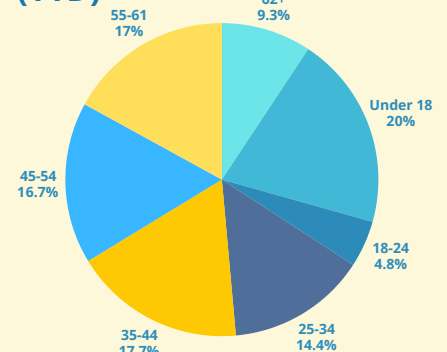

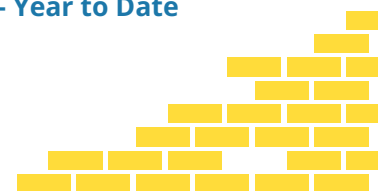

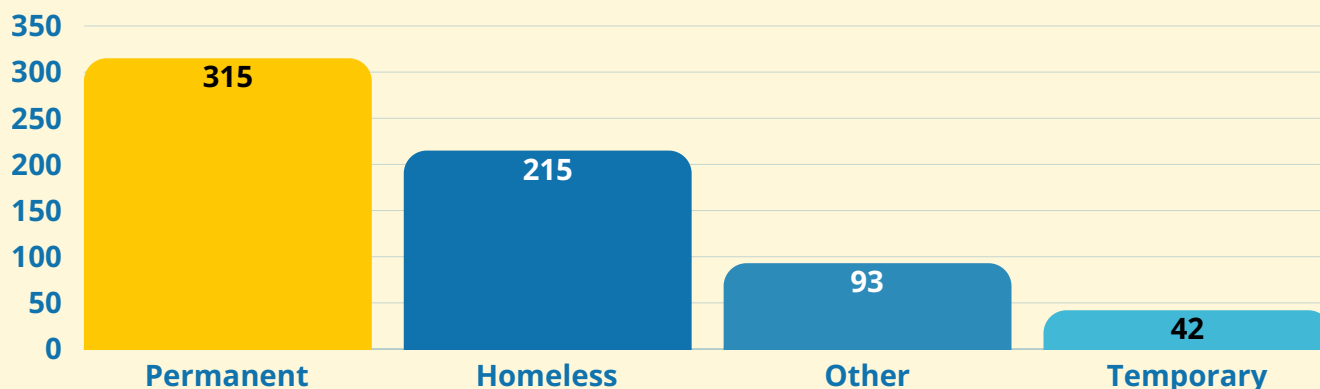

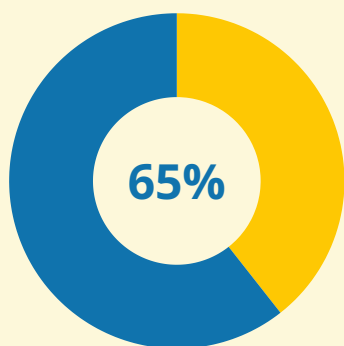

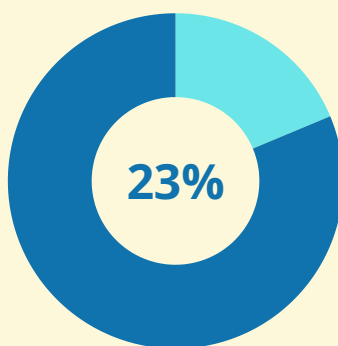

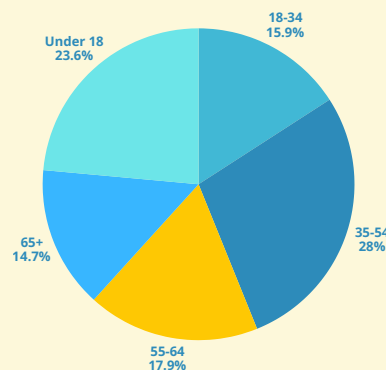
Percentage of Veterans Exiting to Positive Housing Situations (YTD)



Veteran Population Percentage (YTD)



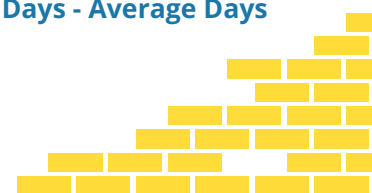

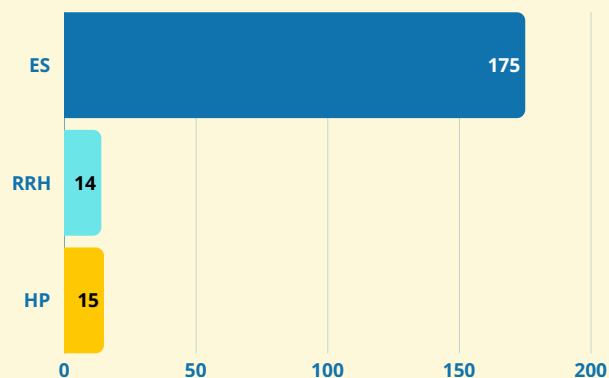

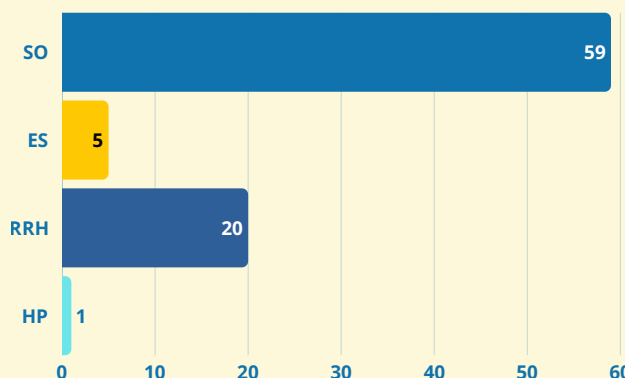

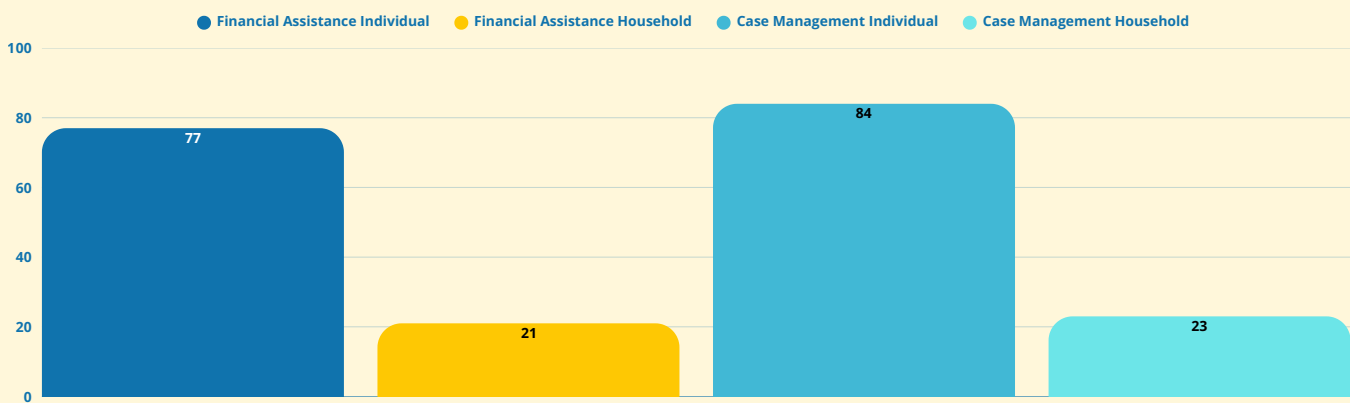
