**NATURALIZATION APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS-  
CITIZENSHIP BY DESCENT : SECOND GENERATION**

For people applying for citizenship by descent through a grandparent .  
Documentary Requirements

- 2 Original Application Forms No. 2A
- Four (4) identical passport photographs sized 5cm x 5cm that are certified by a Notary Royal, within six months after taking the photographs
- Original Birth Certificate of Applicant
- Original Saint Lucian Birth OR Baptismal Certificate of Grand-parent ( if name changed after birth, evidence supporting the change is required e.g., original marriage certificate/deed poll/death certificate)
- Certified Bio-Page of the Applicant's current Passport
- 2 Referees who are Saint Lucians (must present valid St. Lucian ID) -for applicants born before 22 Feb 1979.
- Mariage certificate or statutory declaration of applicant (if applicable)
- Translations must be provided for foreign language documents.
- A Letter of Authorization must be provided for people conducting applications on behalf of others

Kindly note that ***Baptismal Certificates*** are only accepted for persons who are deceased but must be accompanied by the death certificate.
