SUBJECT: 2023 Legislative Session – Week 7 Summary (April 17-21)

'Twas the week before budget conference, and all through the House (and Senate), Protestors were shouting, while amendments filed about the Mouse. The priority bills were passed on party-line votes

The priority bills were passed on party-line votes, Knowing that Gov. DeSantis always keeps his notes.

. . . .

"Now, Renner! Now, Broxson! Now, Passidomo and Perry! On, Altman! On, Brodeur! On Harrell and Chaney! To the top of the spreadsheets! To the top of the call! Now appoint conferees! Conference! Conference for all!

It is silly season in Tallahassee with budget conference looming and major priorities still in play. The final two weeks of the 2023 Legislative Session will be as much about finishing on time, as it is racking up victories for the Governor.

These and other highlights are featured below in our summary of the week that was in Tallahassee.

## **NAIOP Activities**

Rusiness Rent Tax – Both chambers t

Business Rent Tax – Both chambers now have released a tax package. The House version (HB 7063) provides a one penny cut to the BRT. The Senate version (SB 7062) released this week and does not cut the BRT. It appears that the two packages are now set for negotiations over the next two weeks.

**Bidirectional Antennas** – There are two bills in play on this issue. The first bill is HB 89 (Maggard) and SB 512 (Hooper). This is a Building Construction bill that deals with fire issues. Senator Hooper has expressed interest in supporting an extension of the current requirement for antennas.

The other bill is SB 1614 (Rodriguez) and HB 1575 (Brackett). This would require that before a local authority having jurisdiction may require an assessment of the need for or the installation of a two-way radio communications enhancement system in a new or existing building, a qualified third party must certify that

the jurisdiction's public safety emergency communications system meets or exceeds the minimum radio coverage design criteria for emergency services communications systems in the current edition of the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 1221: Standard for the Installation, Maintenance, and Use of Emergency Services Communications Systems. Such certification is valid until the next triennial adoption of the Florida Fire Prevention Code which incorporates any changes made to NFPA 1221.

Further, if a jurisdiction has a valid radio coverage design certification under paragraph (c), the local authority having jurisdiction may only require an assessment of a new or existing building's interior radio coverage and signal strength in such building once every 3 years for high-rise buildings or once every 5 years for any other buildings in order to determine the need for a two-way radio communications enhancement system.

Finally, if an assessment of a new building's interior radio coverage and signal strength determines that installation of a two-way radio communications enhancement system is required, the local authority having jurisdiction may not withhold the issuance of a certificate of occupancy for the building if the registered architect or professional engineer who designed the building determines, in his or her professional judgment, that a two-way radio communications enhancement system is not necessary in order for the building to meet the minimum standards for interior radio coverage and signal strength. The local authority having jurisdiction may not require the installation of a two-way radio communications enhancement system until at least 90 days after the building's interior radio coverage and signal strength assessment report is completed.

SB 1614 passed the Rules Committee and is now ready for a floor vote. The House Bill 1575 passed the Commerce Committee this week. It is up on Special Order next week. Chris Carmody is working with the bill's stakeholders to amend some language that makes this good bill even better.

**Florida Building Commission** – We are working with sponsors of construction and DBPR-related legislation to potentially amend our proposed expansion. Based on feedback from House and Senate leaders, this would appear to be a 2024 legislative issue.

**Energy Benchmarking and Other Anti-Business Ordinances** - Senate Bill 170, by Senator Jay Trumbull, that would significantly hamper any local ordinance that would create increased costs to businesses. This bill passed the Senate and is moving in the House. The House bill is waiting on a vote by the House.

**EV Charging Stations -** SB 1176 (Simon) and HB 1591 (Maggard) are legislation that would require the Public Service Commission to adopt rules for electric vehicle charging stations which meet certain requirements; provide a timeline for the proposal and adoption of such rules; and prohibit a public utility from using rate base investment for certain purposes. We are working with these sponsors to also seek preemptions to the state from local governments.

## Summary of Week Seven (April 17-21)

### Reading, Writing and Partisan Elections

The Senate on Wednesday passed a proposed constitutional amendment (HJR 31) that seeks to make school board elections partisan races starting in November of 2026. First, the question will go to voters, who will be asked to amend the state constitution to affect the change. Sixty percent of voters have to vote yes on the proposed amendment for it to go into effect. The vote in the Senate was 39-11. The measure had passed the House earlier. Proposed constitutional amendments don't need gubernatorial approval.

### **De Santis vs. Disney Continues**

Lawmakers moved quickly Wednesday to retroactively invalidate an agreement between Walt Disney World and its special taxing district that was taken right before a state takeover of the board responsible for overseeing the area around Disney's theme park that provides services to the complex. The move was the latest in an ongoing feud between the company and Gov. Ron DeSantis, who pushed the Legislature to invalidate the previous board's final actions. Passage of amendments to Senate Bill 1604 and House Bill 439, land use bills, in committees in both the Senate and House on Wednesday came over warnings that the effort may not be constitutional.

### **Stop Stealing Cats**

The House on Wednesday passed legislation (SB 306) that aims to reduce catalytic converter thefts. The measure restricts who can buy detached catalytic converters, which are frequent targets of thieves, who cut them off the exhaust systems of cars because of the high value palladium, platinum and rhodium contained in the devices. The bill, called the "Catalytic Converter Antitheft Act," also puts new requirements on auto parts dealers for record-keeping and makes it a third degree felony to knowingly possess, purchase, sell, or install a stolen catalytic converter, one that is missing certain information or without proof of ownership. It would also make it a second degree felony to knowingly import, manufacture, or purchase counterfeit, fake, or nonfunctional catalytic converters for resale. The proposal cleared the House on a 105-2 vote after unanimously passing the full Senate earlier this month. It now heads to the governor's desk and if given the green light, would take effect on July 1.

### Senate Unveils Tax Package

The Senate Finance and Tax Committee on Tuesday unanimously advanced a tax cut package that's estimated to set Floridians up for hundreds of millions in savings. The proposal (SB 7062) includes two 14-day back-to-school sales tax holidays, tax breaks on baby and toddler supplies and a three-month long "Freedom Summer" tax holiday for recreational activities and concerts, among other breaks. It would also direct sales tax dollars to thoroughbred breeders, worth \$27 million, to help the state's horse racing industry. It now heads to its second and final committee, the Senate Appropriations Committee. A similar tax package (HB 7063) is ready to be considered by the full House. Neither version includes the governor's suggested one-year tax exemption for basic household goods under \$25, such as toilet paper and hand soap. A final tax package will be hammered out during budget conferencing between the House and Senate over the next couple of weeks.
