



# Highball

## 10-0-10 with .5% Boron

Highball is a complementary source of nitrogen and potassium that can be applied to a variety of crops, when the soluble and available nutrients represented on the label are needed. It can be used on a broad spectrum of field, fruit, vegetable, and forage crops.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

**CORN AND SOYBEANS:** Apply 1 to 3 gallons per acre during the vegetative growth stage. (Highball can be applied during the reproductive growth stage, we suggest utilizing other Sugar Creek Ag products that address additional crop needs during the reproductive growth stage.)

**WHEAT:** Apply 1 to 3 gallons per acre at flag leaf.

**Other Sugar Creek products that can be applied with Highball are:** Sweet N Loam, Shug Nitro, Micro-N-Rich, Micro-N-Tense, Brimstone 17.

**NOTES:** Apply with 10 to 20 gallons of water. Can be applied with other Sugar Creek Ag products and most herbicides, pesticides, and fungicides. Can be applied through drip or overhead irrigation. Agitate before use.
