• Dresses no shorter than 2" above the knee • If dresses are strapless, a jacket or sweater must be worn the entire evening. Dresses must not show cleavage and may not fall more than 1" below the bottom of the natural bra line in the back. • No side cut outs are allowed. • All mesh and lace must have a non-flesh colored lining underneath. • Dresses must not be too tight/clingy, otherwise known as "bodycon". Dresses must be modest at all times, when dancing, standing, and sitting. • No pants, pantsuits or jumpsuits of any kind allowed. • If girls choose to bring a comfortable pair of shoes for dancing, those shoes need to fit into the dress shoe category (no tennis shoes or TOMS.) • No boots of any kind. This includes cowboy boots.	• Dresses no shorter than 2" above the knee, including slits • Dresses must not show cleavage and may not fall more than 1" below the bottom of the natural bra line in the back. • No side cut outs are allowed. • All mesh and lace must have a non-flesh colored lining underneath. • Dresses must not be too tight/clingy, otherwise known as "bodycon".
