Dear DTCS Families and Friends,



SCHOOL UPDATES & ACADEMIC ACCOMPLISHMENTS

As we move through the 2025–2026 school year, Dawn Treader Christian School is celebrating meaningful academic growth and steady progress across grade levels. This season has been marked by an intentional focus on instructional excellence, data-driven decision-making, and student achievement—particularly in literacy and mathematics.

Schoolwide reading and math data reflect encouraging trends, with students demonstrating measurable gains in foundational skills, reading comprehension, and problem-solving abilities .Diagnostic assessments and ongoing progress monitoring allow teachers to identify individual student needs and provide timely, targeted support.

In literacy, students are using Lexia Core Reading, an evidence-based program that delivers personalized instruction to strengthen phonics, vocabulary, fluency, and comprehension. Teachers use real-time data to guide small-group instruction and reinforce foundational reading skills.

In mathematics, instruction remains aligned with assessment data to reinforce core skills, build conceptual understanding, and promote academic confidence.

As students prepare to take their second i-Ready Diagnostic next week, we are confident that continued growth will be evident. The combination of targeted instruction, consistent progress monitoring, and intentional intervention is expected to result in noticeable improvement at both the individual student level and across the school as a whole.

Beyond academics, Dawn Treader remains committed to educating the whole child—academically, spiritually, and socially. This progress reflects the dedication of our staff, the perseverance of our students, and the faithful partnership of our families and supporters.
