ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP (Precepts of the Church)


is defined as:

- 1. Registered in the parish for a sufficient length of time. (6 months)
- 2. Attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation and rest from servile labor.
- 3. Confess your sins at least once a year.
- 4. Receive the Sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter Season.
- 5. Observe the days of fasting & abstinence established by the Church.
- 6. Help to provide for the needs of the Church.

Holy Days of Obligation

In the Catholic Church, Holy Days of Obligation are the days on which the faithful are obliged to participate in the Mass. They also abstain from unnecessary works, "which hinder the worship to be rendered to God, the joy proper to the Lord's Day, or the suitable relaxation of mind and body." (Canon 1247 of the Code of Canon Law).

> All Sundays are obligatory for the faithful to participate in the Mass.

Guidelines for the Reception of Holy Communion

FOR CATHOLICS:

As Catholics, we are encouraged to receive Communion devoutly and frequently. In order to be properly disposed to receive Communion, participants should not be conscious of grave sin. A person who is conscious of grave sin is not to receive the Body and Blood of the Lord without prior sacramental confession.

FOR OUR FELLOW CHRISTIANS: We welcome you to our celebration, yet because Catholics believe the celebration of the Eucharist is a sign of the reality of the oneness of faith, life, and worship, members of those churches with whom we are not yet fully united are encouraged to come forward, with their arms folded across their chests, to receive a blessing. All are asked to express their hearts a prayerful desire for unity with the Lord Jesus and with one another.
