ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP (Precepts of the Church)

3. Confess your sins at least once a year.

4. Receive the Sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter Season.

5. Observe the days of fasting & abstinence established by the Church.

6. Help to provide for the needs of the Church.


Holy Days of Obligation

In the Catholic Church, Holy Days of Obligation are the days on which the faithful are obliged to participate in the Mass. They

also abstain from unnecessary works, "which hinder the worship to be rendered to God, the joy proper to the Lord's Day,

or the suitable relaxation of mind and body." (Canon 1247 of the Code of Canon Law).

> All Sundays are obligatory for the faithful to participate in the Mass.




