



The Episcopal Church of the Good Shepherd Foundation was incorporated in 1982 with a mission to support the activities and maintain the facilities of the Good Shepherd Episcopal Church. Founding trustees Violet Howell, L.L. Feickert, John Polk, C.A. King II and James Boyer established the fund as a permanent endowment governed by a separate Board of Directors overseen by the church Vestry. Endowment funds are professionally managed by an independent third-party firm.
