Scott Hovey will be hosting the first campfire on their Lot # 37**

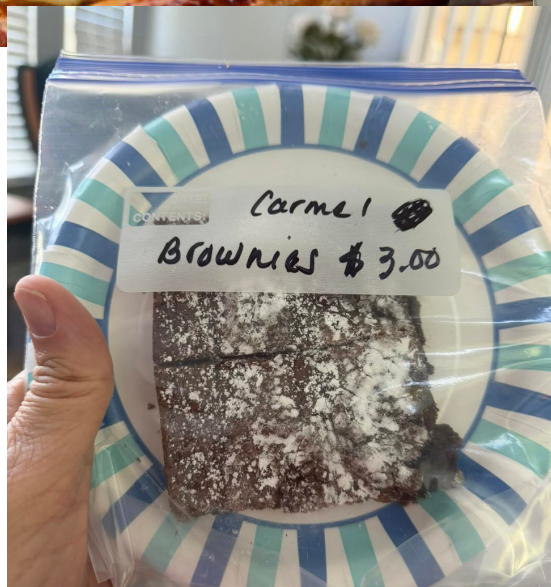
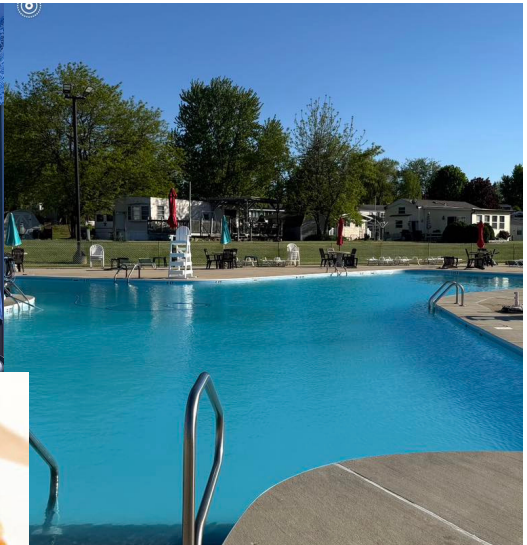
