Permanent means that clients will meet with the intake coordinator and case worker to work on goals for stability and housing. The housing program covers application fees, security deposits, utilities deposits, and up to 3 months rent covered. To continue staying in the shelter, clients must work a program and meet goals. The shelter closes from 8am to 4pm.
