Recommendations for Parents:

Finding a provider:

- -Call the number on your insurance card for additional provider recommendations who accept your insurance.
- -Many communities in Massachusetts have access to the William James Therapy Referral Interface. Check https://interface.williamjames.edu/communities to see if you are eligible and call **(617)332-3666** or **1(888)244-6843** to request a referral.
- -If your child has experienced psychological trauma such as physical or sexual abuse, assault, natural disaster, witnessing violence, etc. you can also reach out to UMass Medical Center's Child Trauma Referral Network, available to all Massachusetts residents, at **1(855)LINK-KID** (**1(855)546-5543**) or **(774)455-4127**

Supporting your child:

- -Seek out natural supports for yourself and your child: coaches, teachers, relatives, and other trusted adults as well as close friends can be key players in your child's mental health.
- -Practice listening to your child's worries or stressors without offering judgment or advice. Ask your child what they need when they come to you--if they ask for advice, give it. If they just want you to listen and empathize, do it. It's harder than it sounds--try repeating back to them what you understood to make sure you get it, ask clarifying questions, and check in with them about how they would like you to support them.
- -Take care of your own physical and emotional well-being. Show and teach your child the ways you care for yourself. Not only does taking care of yourself allow you to be more present for your child, it also is important modeling to show them that even adults have feelings and need to take care of ourselves too! Plus, you are a whole human being as well as a parent--you deserve to be mentally and physically healthy too.
- -Remind your child often of all the natural strengths and abilities they have. Trusting them to work through their own problems goes a long way, but sometimes we all need a reminder of just how capable we are.
- -Know that as a parent, you cannot be everything for your child. Parents have a lot of different roles, including chore enforcer and homework police. It is ok if they don't tell you everything, especially when they are mad at you for making them brush their teeth. Offer alternatives to support communication (Can they text you? Write letters? Communicate using only emojis?) and make sure they have access to other supports.
