Prayer, fasting, and almsgiving: these disciplines, prescribed by Jesus himself in the Sermon on the Mount, along with strict instructions not to flaunt them in public to win recognition and praise (Matthew 6:1-18), have been embraced by all the saints at the beginning of every Lent for almost two thousand years. But mention Lent, and many react with a grimace or slight shudder—even now, years after official obligations have been reduced to a minimum! No wonder the Eastern Rite's "Lenten Announcement" sounds surprising: "Let us receive with joy, O faithful people, the divinely inspired announcement of Lent! The Lenten Spring shines forth! Begin the fast with joy! Let us fast from passions as well as food, taking pleasure in the good works of the Spirit, and accomplishing them in love!" Saint John Chrysostom, whose feast is September 13, elaborates: "Do you fast? Give proof by your works. If you see a poor person, take pity. An enemy, be reconciled. 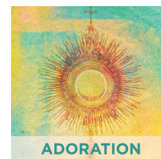

A Columbarium is an above the ground facility where your loved one's remains will be entombed. A full funeral Mass, with the body, will still be available if the family wishes. The Columbarium is located in the area North of St. Anne's Building and to the East of the Church. This area is handicap accessible and a sheltered pavilion offers covered space for the final burial service. Each niche will hold up to two cremains. The cost of each niche is \$1,750 and includes perpetual care, name plate, opening and closing of the niche and placement of cremains in niche. St. Anne's Society

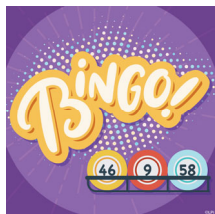
The St. Anne's Society is a partnership of churches in Sebastian County working with each other to assist the poor and homeless in our area.

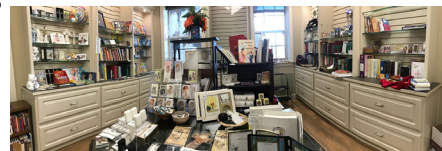
Colecta del Miércoles de Ceniza

Una alternativa a la sepultura tradicional. Un Mausoleo es una construcción en donde se depositan las cenizas del ser querido en un nicho. El Mausoleo será construido en el área cercada al Norte del Edificio Santa Anna y al Este de la iglesia y contará con un pabellón para ofrecer un lugar en donde realizar el último servicio funerario. Cada nicho podrá albergar hasta 2 urnas. El costo de cada nicho es de \$1,750 e incluye cuidado perpetuo, placa con el nombre, apertura y cierre del nicho y colocación de urna.
