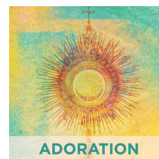

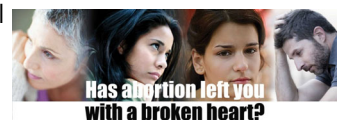

St. Anne's Society

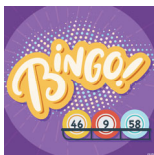
The St. Anne's Society is a partnership of churches in Sebastian County working with each other to assist the poor and homeless in our area.

2020 Summer Care Program

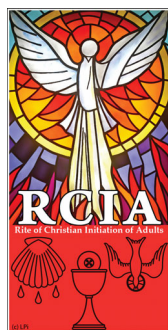

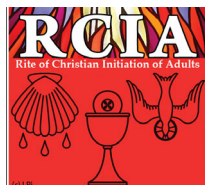
