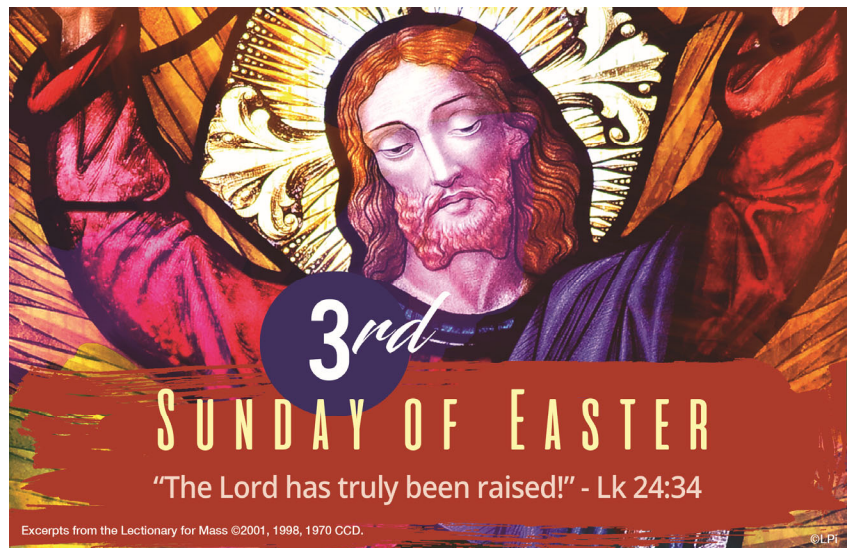

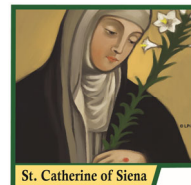

SAINT CATHERINE OF SIENA (1347-1380) April 29

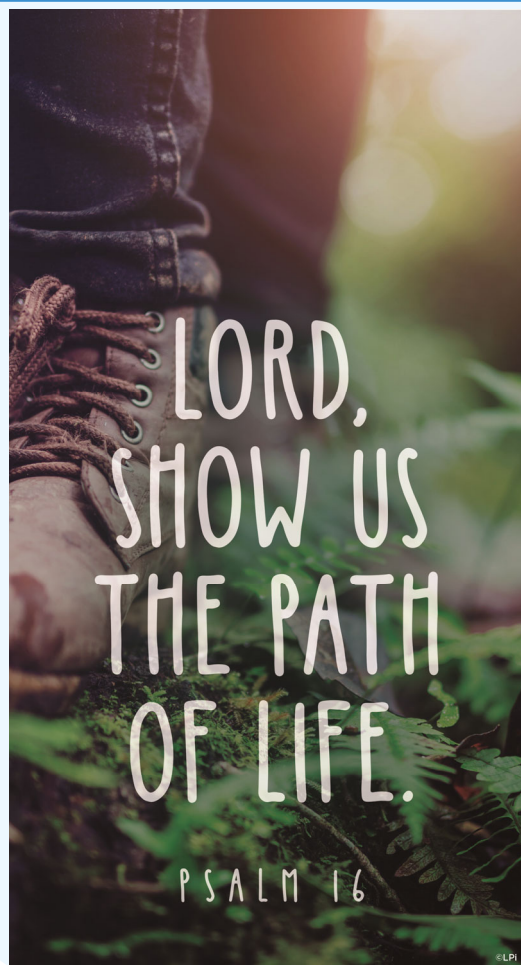
Imagine the pope receiving a young woman still in her twenties who addresses him as "my sweet Christ on earth," then orders: "Get back to Rome where you belong!" Amazingly, Gregory XI complied! Yet this was but one astonishing incident in the extraordinary life of Catherine of Siena, a truly unique medieval woman. Youngest of twenty-five children, Catherine refused marriage and became a Dominican Tertiary at sixteen, cloistering herself at home in contemplative prayer, austere penances, and mystical experiences, culminating in "spiritual espousal" to Christ. Then, incarnating the Dominican ideal of "passing on to others the fruits of contemplation," Catherine left her solitude to care for the poor, nurse the sick, comfort the dying, and bury the dead. Increasingly renowned for converting souls and healing bodies, she was sought after to broker peace during civil wars and Church schisms. All this, and like Jesus, whom she called "my Divine Spouse," she died at thirty-three! Four hundred letters and her spiritual classic *The Dialogue* inspired Paul VI to name her, together with Teresa of Ávila, the first women Doctors of the Church. —Peter Scagnelli, Copyright © J. S. EL PLAN DE DIOS

Hoy san Pedro nos habla dos veces. En la primera lectura, escuchamos un pasaje de su sermón en Pentecostés; en la segunda, parte de su primera carta. Antes, un aterrorizado pescador con poca educación quien a menudo decía lo equivocado, el Pedro de ahora habla sobre la verdad que conoce. Todo lo que Jesús había dicho ahora tiene sentido. Su muerte y resurrección eran parte del plan de Dios, y nuestra fe y esperanza pueden centrarse en Dios.

El Evangelio de hoy describe el relato del camino a Emaús en el que Jesús se une a dos discípulos. Aterrorizados, tristes y confundidos aquellos dos no reconocen a Jesús, quien les dice lo que escuchamos a Pedro decir arriba: todo esto tuvo que suceder como parte del plan de Dios. Al final, estos discípulos reconocen a Jesús así como nosotros debemos reconocerle –al partir el pan.

Mausoleo en la Inmaculada Concepción

Una alternativa a la sepultura tradicional. Un Mausoleo es una construcción en donde se depositan las cenizas del ser querido en un nicho. El Mausoleo será construido en el área cercada al Norte del Edificio Santa Anna y al Este de la iglesia y contará con un pabellón para ofrecer un lugar en donde realizar el último servicio funerario. Cada nicho podrá albergar hasta 2 urnas. El costo de cada nicho es de \$1,750 e incluye cuidado perpetuo, placa con el nombre, apertura y cierre del nicho y colocación de urna. SANTA CATALINA DE SIENA (1347-1380) 29 de abril

Catalina, siendo la más pequeña de una familia de 24 hermanos pidió a su madre un cuarto privado para orar. Este deseo ferviente de Dios fue el hilo conductor de su vida. Siendo muy pequeña hizo del amor a Dios y a los pobres el centro de su vida. A los 16 años ingresó a la Orden Terciaria de las Dominicas llevando una vida de oración, de obras de misericordia y viviendo recluta en su casa. Sus encuentros místicos con Dios eran frecuentes después de la comunión, pero no quería que se hablara de ello. Fue ella misma quien le urgió al Papa Gregorio XI que regresara a Roma, que allá estaba su lugar. En vida dictó más de 400 cartas y dos libros. En su tiempo fue vista por todos como una gran líder. Murió a los 33 años y en 1970 Pablo VI la declaró Doctora de la Iglesia. —Miguel Arias, Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.



St. Catherine of Siena
