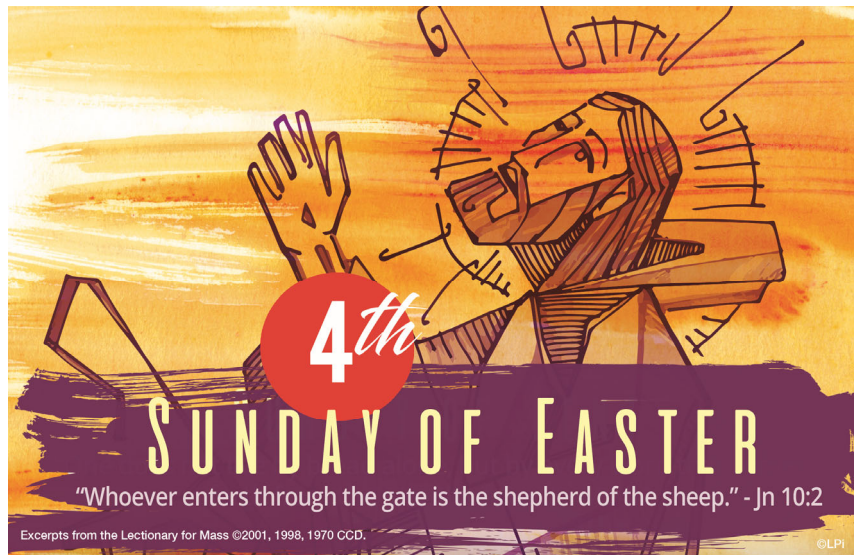

Sad to say, sheep will most likely never enjoy this sort of domestic vogue. They are neither clean nor smart and are largely defenseless when left on their own, even in large numbers. The biblical image of us as the flock of sheep is not a particularly flattering one. Sheep without a shepherd are truly sad, because they most likely will perish either from their inability to fend for themselves or from their lack of defenses against predators. Placing ourselves in the heart of this unflattering image can reinforce our faith. Cada nicho podrá albergar hasta 2 urnas. El costo de cada nicho es de \$1,750 e incluye cuidado perpetuo, placa con el nombre, apertura y cierre del nicho y colocación de urna.
