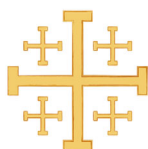

I.C. Church Columbarium

A Columbarium is an above the ground facility where your loved one's remains will be entombed. A full funeral Mass, with the body, will still be available if the family wishes. The Columbarium is located in the area North of St. Anne's Building and to the East of the Church. This area is handicap accessible and a sheltered pavilion offers covered space for the final burial service. Each niche will hold up to two cremains. The cost of each niche is \$1,750 and includes perpetual care, name plate, opening and closing of the niche and placement of cremains in niche. Twelve-month payment plan available.

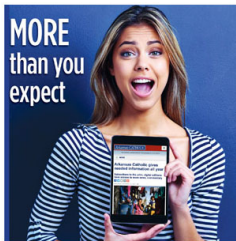

RAZÓN DE NUESTRA ESPERANZA

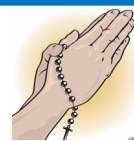

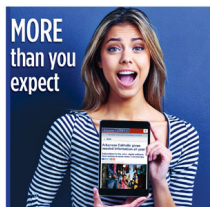

El Mausoleo será construido en el área cercada al Norte del Edificio Santa Anna y al Este de la iglesia y contará con un pabellón para ofrecer un lugar en donde realizar el último servicio funerario. Cada nicho podrá albergar hasta 2 urnas. El costo de cada nicho es de \$1,750 e incluye cuidado perpetuo, placa con el nombre, apertura y cierre del nicho y colocación de urna.
