# Tuesday Night Men's League

It's time!! Last year was the 16th year for our very successful Tuesday Night Men's Group. The formats will remain similar to last year's Men's Night with a gross and net division. The formats will closely follow the regular formats, but there will be no handicap involved. The purpose of this was to not only attract more players, but also allow more players to feel as if they have a great chance of competing no matter their handicap. This will strictly be a voluntary flight, so you will have to sign up for it each week and can go back and forth if you choose between the gross division and the net division. There will be a 6 and below index suggested to play in the gross division. This was something that was asked for by players already playing in Men's Night and we hope that those interested will not only participate, but get their friends who have not played in Men's Night before to play as well.

This year we will again award points for playing and for finishing "in the money." We will then keep up with the points and post them to our website so that you can track your progress. We will use \$1 of each player's weekly entry fee to build a pot that will be awarded to the top 20 players after the season is over at the final event, which will be held on Sunday, October 4.

One of the reasons that we feel we were so successful is there is no league to join and you did not have to play in every event to win. This will still be the case with 95% of the weekly entry fee going directly to that week's event. So if you are a new member or have been around since the trees were planted, this will be a great time for you to come out and meet other Windyke members or maybe find a new group to play with during other times of the week. We again will be making the pairings each week so sign up will be strictly individual. One of the main reasons for starting this group is for members to meet other members and get out of the routine of playing with the same old group each week.

A few of the most important points are listed below:

- Tuesdays at 5:30 for the majority of the season
- Call to sign up by 3:00 on the Tuesday that you wish to play
- Official play with points 4/4 thru 10/3 with the Final being on Sunday, October 4.
- \$25 per week to play including cart and prizes
- Prizes paid out each week
- Windyke pro shop staff to make pairings each week
- Points race for a year-long champion
- Optional dinner while you wait for prizes
- Lots of fun!

## **Guidelines:**

- **Two-Person Teams - one person must be the primary member on the account**
- **Make your own team or sign up as an individual and we will pair you**
- **This event is open to all classifications of members**
- **Each team's handicap is based on the average of the two players' index**

**Example: Greg Hynes 4  
Russ Garner 2 = 3**

**Format:  
9 Holes Scramble  
9 Holes Best Ball  
9 Holes Alternate Shot**

**We will then use the team's handicap to flight the teams before play. Once your team's handicap has been used for flighting purposes it will not be used again.**

## **Tee Assignments:**

- **Seniors 75+ play Red**
- **Seniors 60-74 play White**
- **Females & Juniors under 12 play Red**
- **All other players play Gold**
- **Championship Flight will play Blue except Men 60+ will play Gold**

## **Approximate payout will be as follows (based on 144 players and 6 flights)**

- **First Place \$800/Team**
- **Second Place \$600/Team**
- **Third Place \$400/Team**
- **Fourth Place \$350/Team**
- **Low Alternate Shot \$200/Team**

# GOLF TIP FROM TYLER

Putting is a largely understudied part of golf, and that is mainly because it is difficult to measure or quantify what creates good putting. There have been great putters throughout the history of golf with blatant inefficiencies. Billy Mayfair sliced his putts. Tiger Woods hooked his. Brandt Snedeker has a short and choppy stroke. Ben Crenshaw was very long and fluid. Phil Mickelson and Brad Faxon were known for extremely firm pace, with their putts slamming the back of the hole with regularity. Jordan Spieth and Loren Roberts generally eased the ball in the hole rather than slamming it. So what creates a great putting stroke? There are several key themes when it comes to good putting.



## Pace control:

No matter what the tempo of the stroke is, great putters have incredible control of the speed of their putter, and thus, the speed of the ball. The speed at which the ball is rolling affects how you read putts, and it affects how much break you need to play. On breaking putts, there is a range of aim points between the firmest pace you can play and the slowest pace. Great putters understand this and adjust their reads to their natural pace. It is very rare to find a great putter that uses both extremely firm pace and extremely slow pace on putts. They pick one or the other because they don't want to confuse their eyes. Choosing which type of pace makes you more comfortable is crucial for dialing in your green reading. If you like slower pace your 3-putting should decrease, but at the same time your make percentage from 8 - 12 feet also decreases due to the amount of break you need to play. Firmer pace means you'll be better from shorter distances because you're able to aim closer to the hole, but at times lagging can be difficult because your brain won't see enough break on 30 footers. Understanding these differences can help guide you to what you need to do for your own game.

## Line Control:

Obviously to make any putt on purpose you need to be able to hit it where you are aiming. Being fit and playing the correct style of putter for your stroke is crucial for being able to repeatedly accomplish good start lines. As it turns out, the pace of your putting stroke also affects this. Long and slow putting strokes (ie. Ben Crenshaw) work best with lighter putters with usually substantial toe hang. Normally this type of stroke prefers a blade-style putter. Short and quick putting strokes (ie. Brandt Snedeker) work best with heavier putters with reduced toe hang or face balance, usually mallet-style putters. If your unsure what your stroke type is or need help choosing a putter, don't be shy to ask any of the Professionals in the shop or book a fitting. Putting is half of your strokes in a round of golf so it's an important club to get right.

Honing in these aspects of putting will greatly help your confidence and your green reading because you will establish your putting "identity". Having a strong putting identity is crucial to being a great putter. The best part is, no method is really wrong if it works for you. Come see me for a lesson if you have any questions or need help identifying your own putting identity. It can make or break your rounds day to day and maybe even your season. The fun part is when you figure it out!
