Renovating a 65-year-old building certainly comes with its share of challenges, and we sincerely appreciate your patience throughout the process as we worked to get it right for you.

Many of you have probably heard me say over the years, "If members support it, we will continue it." Once again, you have exceeded our expectations. In 2020, we doubled the size of our kitchen to meet growing demand, but continued member support has shown us that even more expansion is needed. During the final week of May, we began installing an additional vent hood that will allow us to add much-needed cooking equipment and improve efficiency during our busiest dining times. We believe these upgrades will greatly enhance the overall dining experience for our members and guests.

Our event tent has also reached the end of its useful lifespan, with the February ice storm causing the final significant damage. Over the past several years, we have explored multiple options for this space and ultimately believe replacing it with a newer, more modern tent is the best solution for the club at this time. Installation will begin the Monday following Father's Day and continue into early July. I spend quite a bit of time at the Par 3 course with the junior golfers, but I want to share how I enjoy it as an adult. I encourage all members to utilize the course more effectively. First of all, Par 3 courses are quite rare. I don't know of another one in all of Memphis, unless you count Audubon's 6 hole Par 3 course, but each hole is about 60 yards. An 18 hole course, and one that is wide open for play, is such a great resource! You are allowed to hit 3 balls per hole as long as no one is waiting behind you. You could get 54 fairway shots in a round that would take about 1 ½ hours. Because the greens are small, you will get ample chipping practice as well. You don't need the driving range and short game areas as much as a result.

Here are a few stats to consider while you play. Logging your results keeps you focused and able to track improvement. Greens hit as well as up and down percentage are great ways to track your full shot and short game prowess. Set a goal and try to hit it. Once accomplished, move the goal post to a greater challenge. For example, you might shoot for 50% greens in regulation and 50% up and down percentage. This standard would be a decent metric for a 10-15 index player. Just start logging results on your scorecard and see what challenges you can set for yourself. 20-25 index players may shoot for 33% in both categories. Scratch players might should for 75%. Scratch players might also enjoy such challenges as making 1 birdie out of the 3 balls attempted. No need to putt the pars out, just go for birdies! Fast play, too! Another scratch challenge might be hitting one of the three shots within 10 feet of the hole. This game targets distance control and accuracy. It is a great way to boost your birdie total with wedges in your hand. It gets you into 'birdie' mode when you get to the West and East courses. Just take 3 large steps from the hole and see if a ball fall in the range. If so, you gain a point. Shoot for 9 points or more on 9 holes. No need to putt at all if you don't want to.

Hope this helps inspire you to greater practice habits as you use the Par 3 course effectively. It really is a gem to have as a member at Windyke.

Finally, junior programming is in full swing! Sign your kids up for all the great programs we have at Windyke.

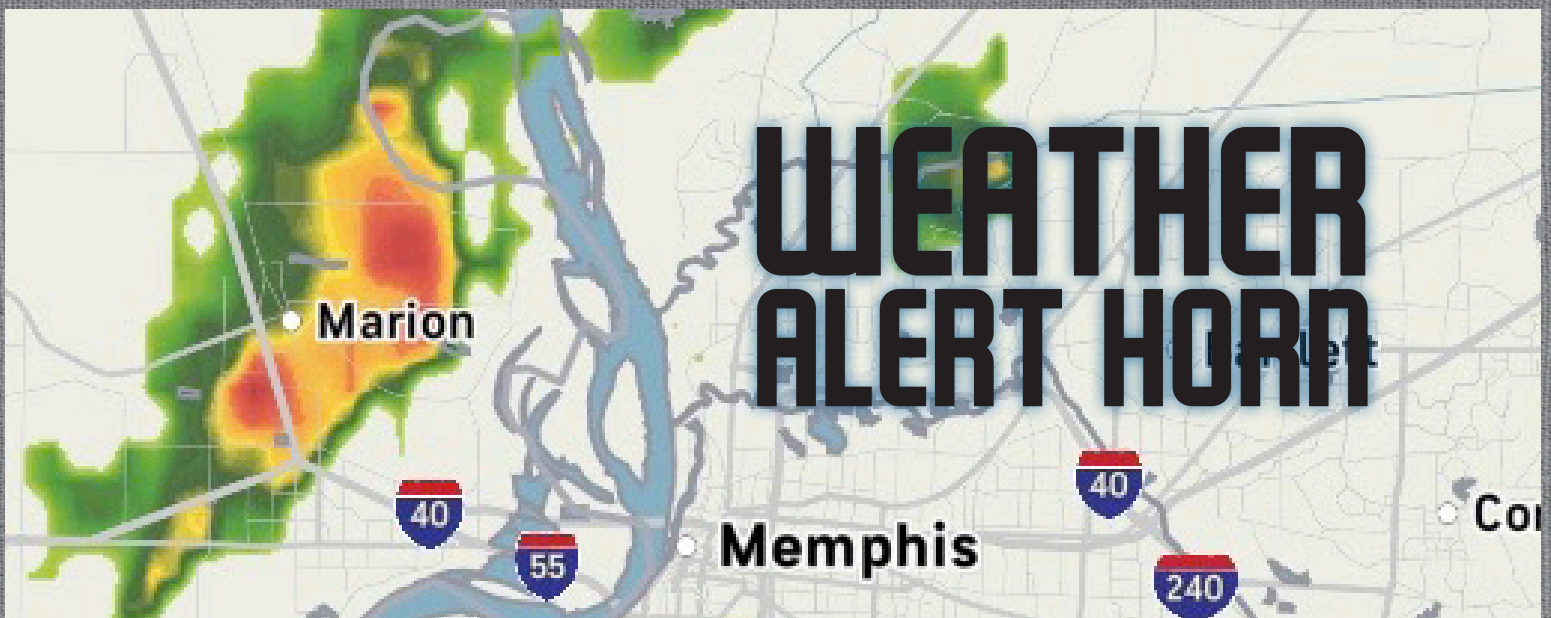

Since the last time we discussed our weather alert system we have had quite a few new members join as well as existing members who have questions regarding it. So here are a couple basic facts. The system is from Weather Bug, and you can get a free app to get accurate course information regarding previous, future and past weather from our exact location. The system measures all kinds of weather from our location but is most noticed during a lightning storm. When a lightning strike occurs within 8 miles of our location the horns make one long blast notifying those on property that dangerous conditions are present. Then when no lightning occurs for 30 minutes within that circle three blasts from the horns will occur signaling that safer conditions are present.

During a warning event we make every effort to make sure that all juniors are safe and back inside. Adult golfers are playing at their own risk if they continue playing after being warned. I hope this answers most of your questions but feel free to reach out to me for other questions you may have.
