This year we are again combining these two events for your convenience. To help with everyone's busy schedule and to make the Stroke Play a two-day event we have moved it to August 2nd and 3rd. It also serves as the qualifier for the Club Championship Championship Flight. The top 15 players, along with last year's champion Alex

Snyder, will be seeded into the championship flight.
This event will be pre-flighted based on handicap and will cost \$100 including cart for both days. The cost to play in the qualifier as well is \$100 and that entry also covers the entry fee for the Club Championship August 16th and 17th even if you do not qualify for the championship flight.
