The weather has certainly made its presence known to start the year. We experienced 15 consecutive days with covers on the course - the longest stretch in recent memory. Fortunately, the course came through it in strong condition and remains in excellent shape for this time of year. The recent storm did cause significant roof damage to one of our maintenance barns, along with a few minor repairs around The Club. I'm proud of how our team responded and kept things moving forward. That said, we were very glad to welcome our members back - The Club simply isn't the same without you.

Locker room renovations continue to progress. While weather and shipping delays have slowed us slightly, we anticipate reopening in April. We are confident you will be pleased with the refreshed space. A limited number of lockers remain available, and the list is filling quickly. Please contact the Membership Office if you would like to reserve one.

Over the past year, we have made several improvements to enhance your experience:

- Installed covered ice and water stations on the East and West courses
- Continued tree removal and canopy raising to improve playability and turf health
- Added irrigation and sod to the eroded area on #9 West
- Completed the Clubhouse entry and business office addition
- Began the locker room renovation



This season, we will continue building on that momentum. **Planned projects include:**

- Removal of diseased and overcrowded trees
- Entry drive and gate improvements
- Lighting upgrades at tennis, pool, entry drive, and north parking lot
- Kitchen enhancements to better serve members during busy times
- Collaboration with our golf course architect on a future range expansion plan
- Cart path and walkway repairs
- Drainage repairs and restoration of bare areas
- Updates to our WeatherBug lightning alert system
- Improvements to The Clubhouse tent experience

We are also excited to welcome our new 2026 Club Car fleet arriving in April. Cart fees will be \$22.88 per person for 18 holes and \$11.89 per person for 9 holes. Trail fees will be \$3.66 for 9 and \$6.41 for 18. All fees are subject to 9.25% sales tax.

Beginning with April billing, updated dues and initiation fees will take effect. These adjustments ensure we remain competitive while continuing to responsibly operate, maintain, and improve our facilities and services. **See page 2 for dues updates.**

Agronomy Update

March Course Update

January and the first couple of weeks of February were certainly not ideal for golf, as extended cold temperatures and challenging winter conditions limited play. During that stretch, our greens were covered for 15 days to protect them from extreme cold and to prevent desiccation caused by drying winds and fluctuating temperatures.

Prior to covering, our staff carefully managed surface moisture levels to ensure the turf was properly hydrated heading into the cold period. We also applied a preventative fungicide to guard against disease while the covers were in place. Thanks to that preparation and close monitoring throughout, the greens came through in excellent condition and look great following uncovering.

Winter Etiquette Reminder

During the winter months our turf is dormant and not actively growing, meaning it cannot recover from damage the way it does in the spring and summer. It is especially important this time of year to sand and fill your divots and properly repair all ball marks on the greens.

Taking a few extra seconds to care for the course now helps protect playing conditions for everyone and ensures the turf stays healthy as we head into the growing season. Thank you for doing your part to keep the course in great shape.

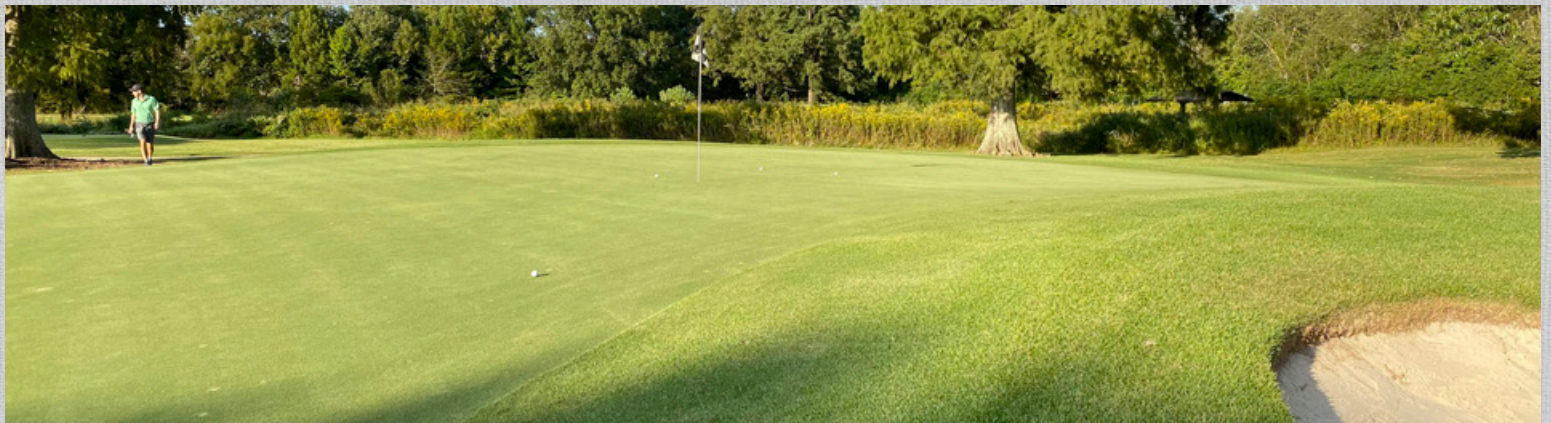
Preparing for Spring

As we transition toward spring, our team is hard at work preparing the course for the growing season. We are completing irrigation repairs and routine system maintenance to ensure everything is ready for consistent watering as temperatures rise.

In the shop, our focus has been on preventative equipment maintenance - rebuilding rollers, grinding reels to ensure a sharp, clean cut, performing oil changes and addressing minor repairs to keep our fleet running efficiently and improving overall performance.

We are also finishing up winter tree work to enhance turf health, sunlight exposure, and overall playability. In the coming weeks, we will be applying pre-emergent herbicides to prevent summer weeds before they germinate. For those managing your own lawns at home, now is the ideal time to apply pre-emergent products as well.

With March approaching, we are looking forward to longer days, warmer temperatures and seeing the course transition back to green. Spring is right around the corner, and we are excited for another great season ahead on the course.



Last Man Standing

This event will be a single elimination match play event. The main difference is that it will span over a 2-month period of time. Matches will be played at a time to be scheduled by the players themselves with a 2-week deadline per match. The exact length of the event will be determined by the total number of players signed up. One of the best side effects of having Club events is that it allows for players who would not normally play with each other to meet. My goal for this is to have players invite their opponent to play their match with them in their regular group if they are part of one which will only strengthen the bond between Club members.

- Players seeded by 12 month low index
- Highest seed gets priority in scheduling matches
- Players to schedule their own matches and report result to Proshop
- Gross Division will play Gold tees
- Net Division will play Gold tees 59 and under, White tees 60-74, Red tees 75 plus

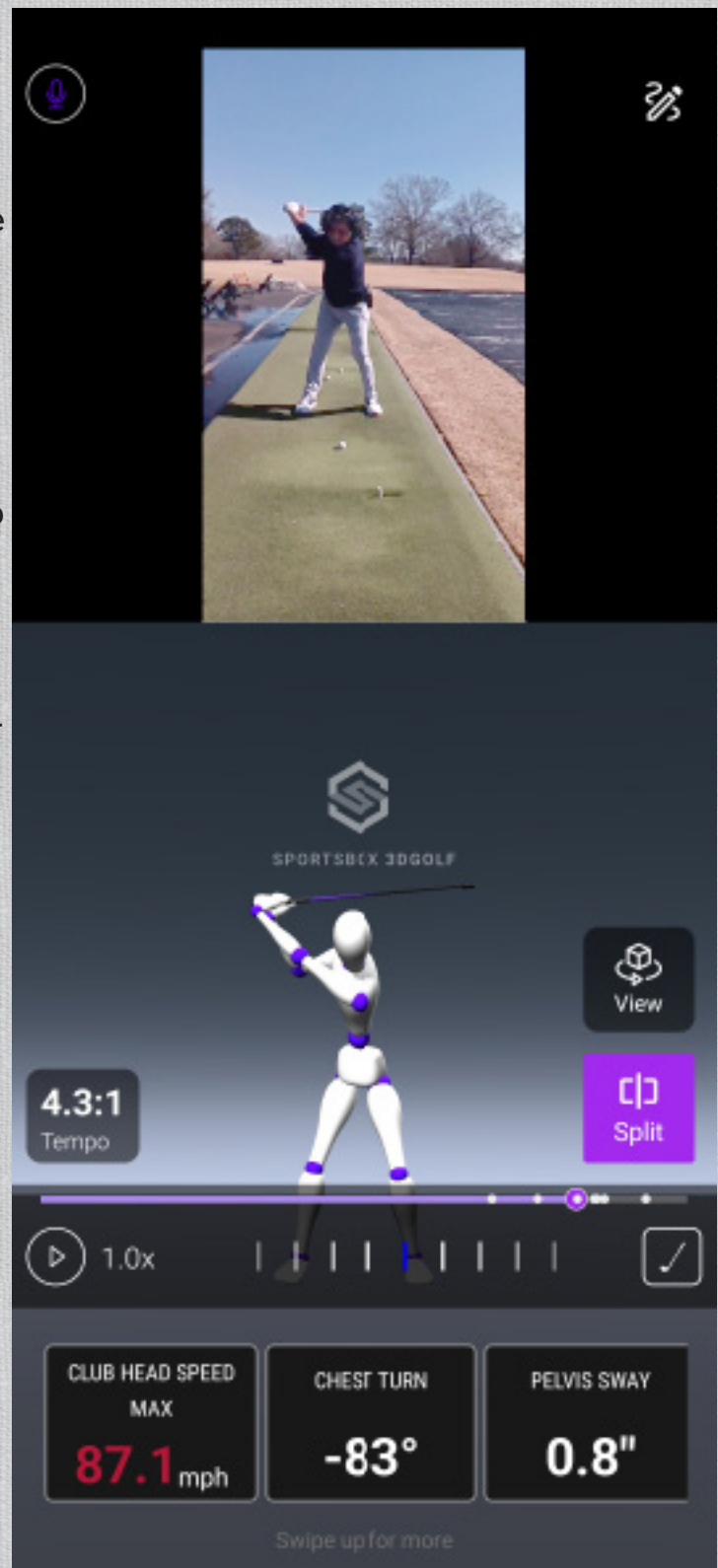
Sportsbox AI

Many of you know that I worked for GolfTEC before coming to Windyke in 2009. GolfTEC was the leader in online video lessons and motion analysis (how the body moves in the golf swing). GolfTEC would compare students to professional swings and body positions and help its clientele to become more athletic and consistent in their swing motion. Once I moved over to Windyke, I used a system called K-VEST that helped me see my students' body positions at setup, the top of the backswing, impact, and finish. K-VEST was part of a TECH package of lessons. The K-VEST system is out of date and I needed a new form of technology to help my students better see what they are doing in the golf swing and document improvement when that is accomplished.

In 2026, I am incorporating Sportsbox AI as my motion analysis software. It doesn't require any cords or 'VEST' setup. By simply taking a video of your golf swing, I can provide you all the data numbers for your body motion throughout the swing. It helps our students answer questions like:

Is my body aligned consistently at setup?
Do I use my body well in the takeaway?
Do I get to a 90 degree shoulder turn at the top?
Is my body rotating well through impact?
and much more.....

Our five lesson TECH pack is great for students who are interested in getting hard data about their golf swing. It also helps students see progress during their lesson with accurate data proving the changes. 5 lessons for \$450 includes two video lessons, two Sportsbox AI lessons, and one more using our simulator. You can also purchase a single lesson using any of these features for a \$20 upgrade.

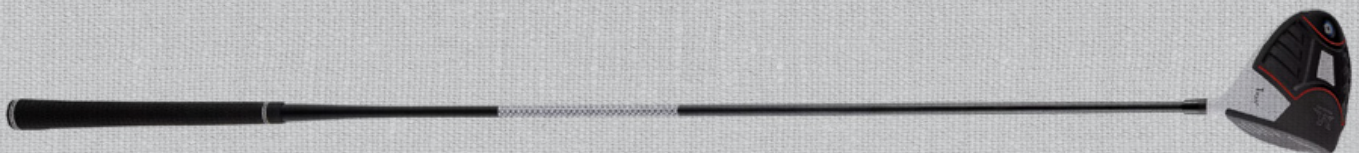
