

2026 Windyke Cup Points Rules

The winner in each event will receive 100 points going down by 10 points through 6th place winning 50 points. The points will then go down by 5 points through 11th place winning 25 points. Points will then go down by 1 point until all places are awarded with a guaranteed 1 point for a full field last place finish. Any tie including first place in any event will award Cup points by adding the tied points and dividing by the number of ties and then rounding using standard rounding practices to two decimal places.

The Club Championship awards the winner of each match won with 20 points and 20 points awarded for participating. The Last Man standing will award points in the same manner except due to the potential for a larger bracket, only once the bracket has been reduced to 16 will points be awarded for winning a match. In both events should a player receive a bye they will play their next match for points. If that match is won they will receive points as if they had won their bye match. There will be no points given out for the Senior Club Championships.

Points will be updated after each event and posted in the Golf Shop and at windyke.com. Other than the last few men's night and ladies day events the final point's event will be the 2026 Dykema in the fall.

In flighted events where there are a different number of participants in each flight, the least amount of points any player will receive will be the equivalent of last place in the smallest flight.

Men's Night and ladies day participation points may be earned toward the Cup Race of 10 points per week played with a maximum of 50 points for the season, counting toward the Cup Race. The top five in the Men's Night and Ladies Points Race will be awarded bonus points. The winner will get 50 points down by 10 points for each place to 10 points for 5th place.

The top 20 players in the Cup Race will receive a bonus gift certificate payout at the year-end Champion's Dinner.

In the event of a tie for first place the players will play an 18-hole handicapped stroke play match to determine first place only. The date and time will be agreed upon after the final points have been earned.
