### **Eyes and Ears-Father John**

- Stained glass windows- St. Michael sponsored by Fidelis and Fraternus. St Faustina and St Therese are fully funded and the next to be installed. We still need sponsors for 8 more windows.
- Scriptural verse will be installed...closing of Mark's Gospel, gifts and fruits of the Holy Spirit
- Room in the Inn- Angels & Sparrows- require vaccination in order to receive services. Not requiring volunteers to be vaccinated.
- Catholic charities- tasked with partnering with immigration services. Refugee families need assistance with housing and supplies- immediate need are car seats. Would like to have in each parish a group of volunteers that could step up in an emergency to assist- if they need food, diapers etc. need partners who can help gather supplies, have volunteers available to pick up refugees at airport. Beth Zuhosky is contact for that group for Catholic Charities. Need to form the group for future needs.
- Catholic news Herald- Synod in process- each parish asked to have delegate to coordinate efforts in the parish- Paul Laskowski will be our delegate. Facilitate discussions with different groups, ministries.
- Jubilee of the Diocese- 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary in January- special events coming. Guidebook will give suggestions on how parishes can work together for common outreach.
- USCCB met and approved document on Communion. Bishops discussed Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis in 2024.
- Budget- Letter will go out from Father John soon.
- Sunday collection and gifts restarting at Masses.
- Request for the nursery to start up again- contact Donna Fodale.
- Christmas Masses- Friday Mass Times- 3:30, 5:30, 7:30, 9:30pm (Spanish), Midnight Mass (11:15 Carols),
  Christmas day Mass Times- 9am and maybe 11am. No 5pm vigil Mass on Sunday.
