



## Terms and Conditions

### Wild West Works – One-to-One Field Sessions

These Terms & Conditions apply to all outdoor painting sessions booked through **Wild West Works** with artist Sarah MacDonald.

By booking a session, participants agree to the following terms.

#### 1. Booking & Payment

Sessions are confirmed once full payment has been received.

Following your enquiry, Sarah will contact you to discuss suitable dates, weather conditions and session details before confirming your booking.

All sessions are bespoke and arranged around availability, landscape conditions and seasonal considerations.

#### 2. Weather & Rescheduling

Sessions take place outdoors and are shaped by the natural environment and weather conditions. Light rain, wind or changing conditions may form part of the experience and will not normally result in cancellation.

However, in the event of severe weather conditions including named storms, weather warnings or conditions considered unsafe, sessions will either:

- be rescheduled to a mutually agreed alternative date, or
- receive a full refund if rescheduling is not possible.

The decision to postpone or cancel due to unsafe conditions rests with Sarah MacDonald / Wild West Works.

#### 3. Cancellation Policy

As all sessions are arranged on a bespoke one-to-one basis, cancellations can be difficult to refill at short notice.

If you need to cancel your booking:

- More than 7 days before your session: 80% refund available
- Less than 7 days before your session: non-refundable

However, in the event of severe or unsafe weather conditions including named storms or weather warnings, sessions will be rescheduled or fully refunded where rescheduling is not possible.

Where possible, reasonable efforts will always be made to find an alternative date.

#### 4. Health, Safety & Participation

Field sessions take place in outdoor environments, including coastal and moorland locations around West Penwith, where terrain may be uneven.

Participants are responsible for:

- wearing suitable clothing and footwear
- informing Sarah of any relevant medical conditions, injuries or accessibility concerns before the session
- taking reasonable care for their own wellbeing during the experience

Sessions are designed to be relaxed and supportive, and walking routes are tailored where possible to suit individual ability levels discussed during booking.

#### 5. Food & Allergies

Seasonal vegan picnic refreshments may be included as part of the session experience.

Participants must notify Sarah in advance of:

- allergies
- intolerances
- dietary requirements

While reasonable care is taken, Wild West Works cannot guarantee an allergen-free environment.

## **6. Transport**

Door-to-door transport may be offered from Penzance and surrounding areas where agreed in advance.

Transport is provided as part of the session experience and availability may vary depending on location and scheduling.

## **7. Insurance**

Sarah MacDonald / Wild West Works holds membership with **a-n The Artists Information Company** as an Arts Organiser.

This membership includes:

- Public & Products Liability Insurance
- Professional Indemnity Insurance

## **8. Photography & Documentation**

Occasionally, photographs may be taken during sessions for website or social media purposes.

No identifiable images of participants will be used without permission.

Participants are welcome to request that no photographs are taken during their session.

## **9. Respect for Landscape & Environment**

Wild West Works encourages a respectful relationship with the landscape and local environment.

Participants are asked to:

- leave no trace
- respect wildlife and surrounding land
- follow guidance during outdoor sessions
