



Purpose of the FCA Victory Bowl

It is the vision of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes to see the world impacted for Jesus Christ through the influence of coaches and athletes. *FCA is a nonprofit organization, and all staff raise their own support* to do the ministry they love.

The FCA Super Centex Victory Bowl was created with the intent of providing the resources required to fund the Heart of Texas FCA chapter which reaches nearly 200 campuses in 12 counties. The area stretches from Goldthwaite to Fairfield and Jarrell to north of Hillsboro.

The FCA office supports coaches and athletes by:

- Being a Christian presence on school campuses
- Providing leadership training to area huddle groups
- Fundraising scholarship money to send students and coaches to FCA Summer Camp
- Disciplining coaches and colleges athletes one-on-one
- Leading coaches and athletic staff Bible studies
- Running a Team Chapel Ministry for local high school sports teams
- Organizing Area huddle outreach events with Baylor Volleyball, Football
- Providing FCA materials and Bibles

Victory Bowl participants sponsorships make the Victory Bowl possible. 92 football players, 36 baseball players, 30 softball players, 24 volleyball players, 20 cheerleaders and 32 basketball players from over 85 high schools will participate in the Victory Bowl. Victory Bowl event's expenses will range from \$45,000-\$50,000.

- Opportunity to participate in a game with players from 12 counties in Central Texas
- All meals
- Housing
- Entertainment during Victory Bowl Week
- Use of all football, volleyball, baseball, and softball equipment
- Support of Licensed Athletic Trainers
- Bowl Gifts
- Major medical health insurance for the week and Catastrophic medical coverage
