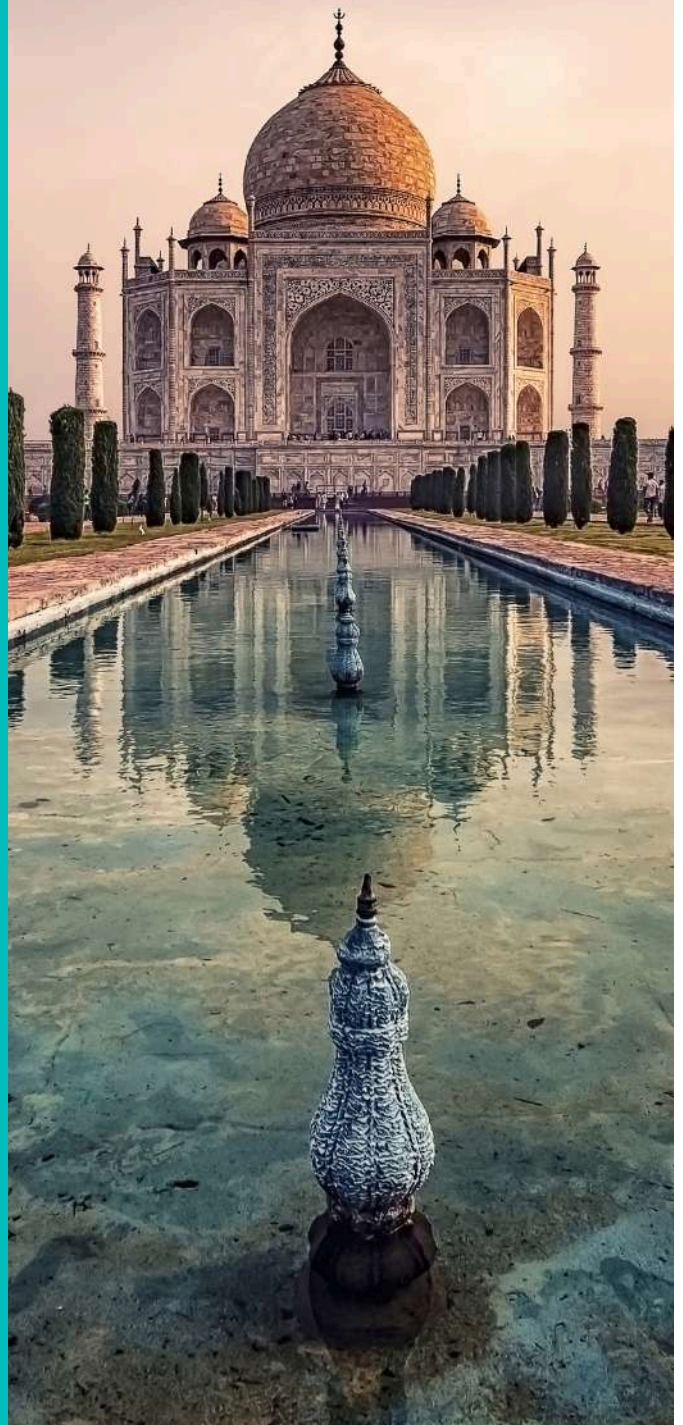

A wide-ranging adventure showcasing the region's natural wonders and fascinating cultures, this epic trip offers a combination of guided excursions and free time to explore beaches, ruins, urban culture, and awe-inspiring landscapes.

This tour starts with a traditional junk boat cruise of Halong Bay with visits to enchanting caves and island lookouts. After a delightful seafood experience on board, you'll travel by overnight train to Hué, once the imperial capital of Vietnam and home to the tomb of a former emperor. Dive into the culture and shop for tailor-made clothes in Hôi An before visiting Oodles of Noodles. 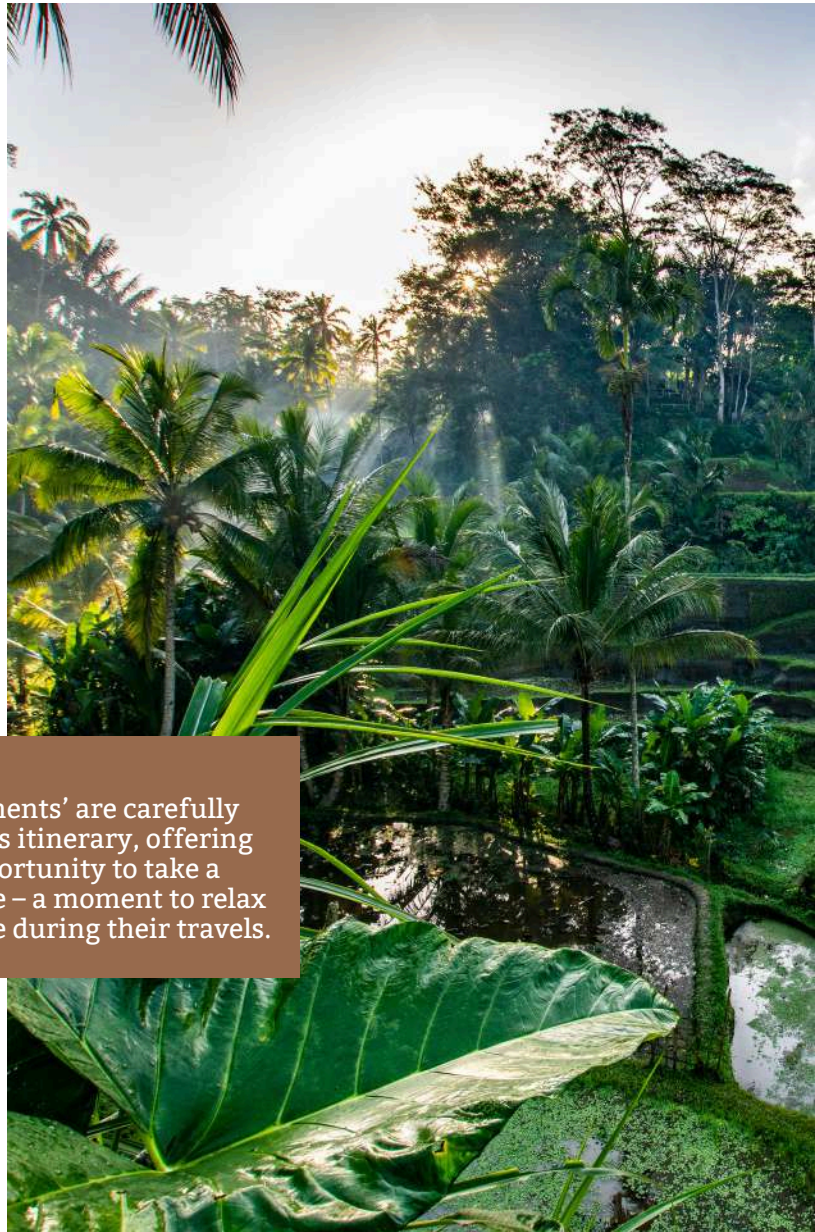
## Classic Bali and Lombok

Starting in Vietnam, in the bustling metropolis of Ho Chi Minh City, witness the beauty of architecture of a bygone era. Go down under to the unique underground network of passages at Cu Chi; dare to go deeper with an expert guide. Step back in time and journey to the Mekong Delta, its winding waterways telling stories spanning centuries. Then equally as historically rich Hô An and Hanoi await. Cycle through picturesque Vong Nhi Village to admire colourful flora and fauna and take a trip to the grand Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, a moving experience.

Your next stretch of hiking is to Tengboche, crossing rivers, walking through forests and alpine meadows.

After another two days acclimatising in Dingboche, you will venture onto Everest Base Camp itself. The highlight of the trip is your breathtaking sunrise view. After challenging days hiking uphill, you begin the descent through the highest settlement areas of the region. Back in Lukla, you will have a chance to relax before a flight back to Kathmandu for some last-minute shopping and light sightseeing. The last day is yours at leisure.
