In the **Maldives** the hottest month is April and the coldest is December, while in the **Seychelles** the temperature rarely falls below 23°C. **Sri Lanka** enjoys good weather on the west and south coast between December and March. **Africa's** weather is diverse, and when to go really depends on what you want to do and see there. **Safaris** are generally regarded to be better in winter months (June to August) while **city** and **beach breaks** are most popular in the summer (December to March). The **Winelands** are best visited during wine harvest season – February to April, or visit **Hermanus** for some Southern Right Whale viewing between the months of June and November.
