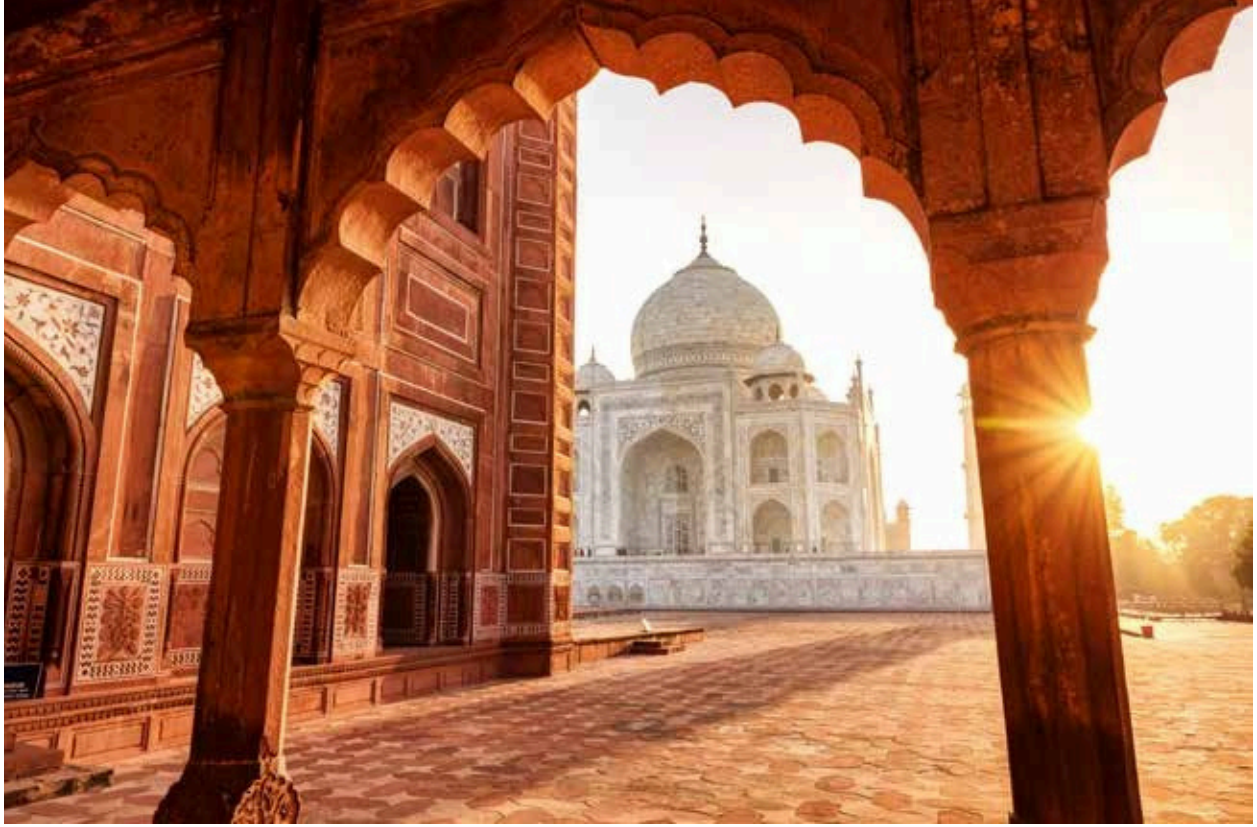

Where and when to travel

Thailand has a tropical climate with varying temperatures and rainfall. Three seasons define the weather: the cool season (November to February), the hot season (March to May) and the green season (May to October).

In **Malaysia** and **Singapore**, it is hot and humid with intermittent rainfall throughout the year. The climate in **Hong Kong** is subtropical, with a relatively dry winter from December to February, and a hot and rainy period from May to September.

The **Indochina** region experiences warm, humid summers with heavy rainfall (especially in July and August) and cooler, drier winters. In **Japan**, it is cold in the north with snow in winter (December to March), temperate in the central regions, and almost tropical to the south. Rain during the summer months (June to August) is abundant almost everywhere, with frequent typhoons.

India's climate is subtropical in the north and tropical in the south. The wet season is generally from July to September. Temperatures are high from April to June, falling in winter (December to February), with snow in the northern regions.
