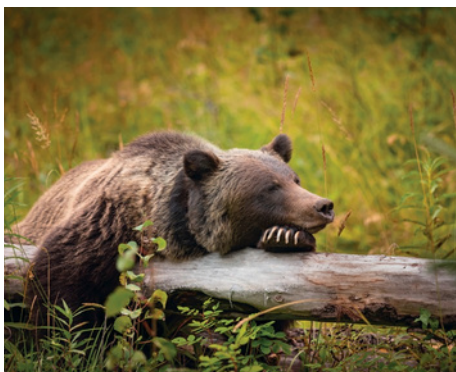
## Pacific Rim – whales & bears

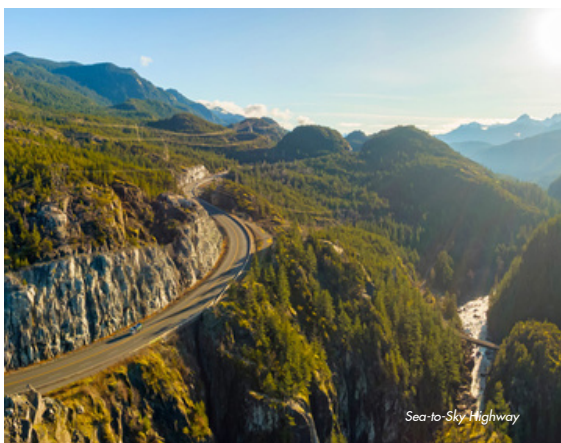
