## The Disciples of Emmaus

After the death of Jesus Christ, several people were disappointed and were losing hope, including the disciples. Before the disciples met Jesus, everyone had their own job. Some were married fishermen; others were administrators. Each had his own occupation. But Jesus dies; he leaves and abandons them. On the road to Emmaus is a biblical narrative (Luke 24) in which two disciples, despairing after the crucifixion of Jesus, are traveling. They walk toward Emmaus and encounter the risen Christ, yet do not immediately recognize



Him. It serves as a metaphor for faith: moving from despair to hope, and recognizing the divine presence in everyday life, in the Word, and in the breaking of bread. Jesus joins the disciples in their distress to explain the Scriptures to them. This means that when we are in distress and suffering, we must never lose hope, because Jesus is always there to accompany us.

The disciples recognize Jesus during the meal, when he breaks the bread, symbolizing spiritual recognition. Through the breaking of the bread in the communion of Christians in mass, we recognize that Jesus is still alive and has risen. The Eucharist is the sign of an active and permanent presence of Jesus among us. After recognizing him, the disciples regain hope and return to bear witness. Encountering Jesus during the Mass through the Eucharist encourages us and fills our hearts with joy.

The spiritual metaphor in the account of the disciples of Emmaus symbolizes the journey of the believer who, despite life's doubts and trials, discovers God's presence by his side.

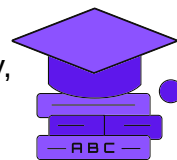

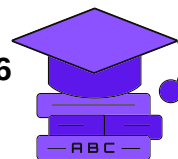
