19th Sunday in Ordinary Time



In a bible study Julie and I had with a group of men at the Minnehaha County Jail, a question was asked about the meaning of "gird your loins". I explained that in Jesus' time, people wore long robes, and they could be cumbersome. "Girding your loins" meant tying up these robes with a belt or rope that allowed for greater mobility and freedom in movement in doing daily tasks. Today in Luke's Gospel, Jesus uses this term as a metaphor to signify spiritual preparation to prepare us for a state of readiness. But be ready for what? Frequently, part of this same gospel is read at wake services and is meant to cause us to reflect on a subject that most find hard to think about: the coming of the Son of Man, either by Jesus' second coming or through our own death.

Remember the word gospel means 'good news'. The encouraging good news of this gospel is that Jesus gives us the keys to be prepared at any time to meet Him face to face. Because of our free will, we always have a choice on how we respond to this good news. I pray for loved ones who appear to be acting as the servant in today's second parable, who believe that the "master is delayed in coming." But I also must examine my own stewardship in how I treat the master's goods. As an ordained clergy, I try to be very mindful of the last line in today's gospel. "Much will be required of the person entrusted with much, and still more will be demanded of the person entrusted with more". God has a special plan for each of us that only we can fulfill. The question we should always seek God's understanding of is "What is your will for my life?" As Jesus says in the first sentence of today's gospel, "your Father is pleased to give you the kingdom." As in, "thy kingdom come thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven."

This is the first step to "gird our loins." We let go of our will and begin to follow God's will for our lives. Please understand that we cannot do it on our own. It all starts with God's grace being poured into us at our Baptism and continues to be poured out through the Holy Spirit through prayer and a sacramental life. It also involves using our time, treasure, and talents for the glory of God and the good of our neighbor.

Another verse in the gospel that cuts to the bone is, "For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be." Is God the top priority in your life? Each time I prepare to preach or write a bulletin article, I remember what my spiritual director once told me. "Before you preach to someone else, they must first see it lived out in your life." So understand that as I write this article, the Holy Spirit is convicting me of how I could better "gird my loins." Let's help each other be prepared, for at an hour we do not expect, the Son of Man will come! Deacon Tim Dickes

St George Cemetery Announcements!

As the St George Cemetery published rules state, "Flowers, shrubs or trees may not be planted on a plot. The parish will retain control of any plants in the cemetery. Any concrete planters must be on a monument's base extension to facilitate grass trimming and minimize sinking and be maintained in good condition. Temporary decorations such as plastic flowerpots, artificial flowers, and wreaths will be allowed one week prior to and two weeks after Memorial Day. Any such decorations are to be removed by the family by June 15th. Those remaining after June 15th shall be subject to disposal, including those in planters if they have become weather-beaten. Plastic flowerpots shall not be dug into the ground and left, as they hinder mowing and trimming efforts. No glass containers are allowed in the cemetery. Any decorations not on a cement base are the responsibility of the family to maintain and trim around. All decorations must remain within the footprint of the plot, so as not to encroach on an adjoining plot.

There are many graves that contain items that have NOT been trimmed around. This is the responsibility of the family. The items will be removed at the discretion of the cemetery committee so the mowing contractor can trim around all stones. Items can be retrieved from the directory stand by the columbarium.

ALSO! The columbarium, benches, and altar are complete. Grass will be seeded in the fall. Remember that all CFSA donations above our assessment will go toward cemetery projects and the upkeep of the cemetery. Columbarium sales are now open!
