Luke 13:22-30 Lord, will only a few people be saved?

The questions about salvation, the afterlife, and the final realities, or Eschatology, are of crucial importance for our personal lives. It's important to remember that the adjective eternal is crucial for understanding those realities correctly. Salvation or condemnation is eternal, while purgatory is only temporal, although it can last until the end of time. The teachings of Our Lord Jesus have led the Church to embrace as solid doctrine the final things: death, judgment, hell, purgatory, and heaven. In today's Gospel, Jesus urges us to be diligent and concerned about our salvation, which won't be easy: strive to enter through the narrow gate, for many will attempt to enter but will not be strong enough. Other passages support this same approach (Mt 7,14; Mt 25,34; etc.). Some decades ago, priests used to stress the possibility of condemnation much more than they do today, even frightening the congregation. Nowadays, people often take their salvation for granted. The causes for this belief might be the influence of Luther, who preached the assurance of salvation by faith alone. Another cause for the confusion might be the erroneous interpretation of the Vatican II Council, particularly Lumen Gentium 16, which states the possibility of salvation following the voice of conscience, even outside the church and through baptism. As always, it is essential to possess the Catholic balance: don't take salvation for granted nor despair of salvation. Let us embrace the task of saving our lives with diligence, never postponing conversion, which is essential for that goal. Finally, let us remember what our Mother Church teaches as necessary for salvation: faith in Jesus Christ, repentance from sin, baptism, dying in the state of grace, and the works of charity. These are the pillars of our faith and the path to salvation. In Christ.
