The National Directory for the Formation, Ministry and Life of Permanent Deacons in the United States, states in #36, The deacon's ministry, as Pope St. John Paul II has said, "is the Church's service sacramentalized." Thus, Pope St. John Paul II affirms, "This is at the very heart of the diaconate to which you have been called: to be a servant of the mysteries of Christ and, at one and the same time, to be a servant of your brothers and sisters. That these two dimensions are inseparably joined together in one reality shows the important nature of the ministry which is yours by ordination."

On October 17, I will celebrate my tenth year as a deacon in the Church, and I wouldn't change a day of it, because it has been so fulfilling. When I saw the priesthood starting to reduce in numbers, I wondered what I could do to help. One of my dear friends in Virginia suggested I become a deacon. And at the time, she knew more about the diaconate than I did. I went to my Pastor at the time, and he told me I would have to wait because he was leaving for a diocese position, and I would have to ask the new Pastor, but he also told me I should try to do more ministry. One year later, I asked the Pastor, and he told me the same thing: he was going to Richmond to work for the bishop, but he wanted me to wait and do more ministry. HUMPF!

With the third Pastor, I was allowed to formally seek out acceptance in the diaconal formation program, to undergo psychological testing, and interviews with myself and my wife. Then, I had one year of discernment in prayer to see if this was really what I wanted to do.

This past weekend, we learned of persistence in prayer, and you can see how formation in the diaconate can be trying. Again, I wouldn't change a day of it! The bishops I have met who are interested in me and what I do for the Church, the priests who have nurtured me along the way, and my brother deacons, along with their wives, have helped me to become the man I am, and I am incredibly grateful!

You all have allowed me to come into your lives, and I am the one who is blessed. Thank you! I have learned perseverance, patience, and to walk humbly through life.

I look forward to meeting each of you in my ministry and hope this continues as long as I am able.


