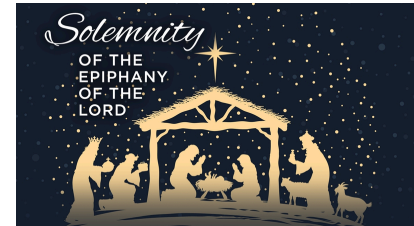


The Epiphany of the Lord brings back fond childhood memories for me. In our home, we had a Nativity set that included the three Magi on camels. My parents would place the Magi figurines some distance from the manger. Each passing day after Christmas, they would move the Magi a little closer until the feast of the Epiphany, when they would arrive at the manger scene to meet the Holy Family. This childhood memory helps me appreciate the excitement and joy the Magi must have felt after their long journey to finally behold the child Jesus.

The Magi, who were pagan, traveled an estimated 800 miles to follow a star and pay homage to a newborn Jewish king. Their arrival troubled King Herod and all of Jerusalem. The idea of a new king could upset the status quo. There is no mention of the Jewish leaders traveling just six miles from Jerusalem to Bethlehem. Not even out of curiosity. The Jewish leaders knew of the prophecies about Jesus, and yet they refused to acknowledge His lordship from the very beginning. This can be a cause for reflection for us as a new year approaches. For example, are there areas in our lives that we feel the need to control and are unwilling to relinquish to Jesus so He can be our Lord? As for me, I need to renew daily my commitment to God's sovereignty in my life. I must trust that His love and Divine Providence will align my day with His holy will. Jesus desires to be Lord of our lives. Because He is a loving and merciful king, He will never impose His lordship upon our free will. Thankfully, he never stops pursuing us and longing for us to become a part of His kingdom here on earth.

The Magi understood by faith who Jesus the King was, even though all they saw was a little child. It's that same gift of faith that leads us as Catholics to Jesus' true presence in the Holy Eucharist. As the Magi paid homage to Jesus with gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh to honor His kingship, we too, can bring our spiritual gifts of worship, praise, and thanksgiving. As we humbly submit our entire lives to Jesus' Lordship, just as the Magi did, we can depart from here today another way.

The three Wise Men, Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar followed the star of God's Son who became man two thousand and twenty-six years ago; may Christ bless our home and remain with us throughout the new year. Amen.

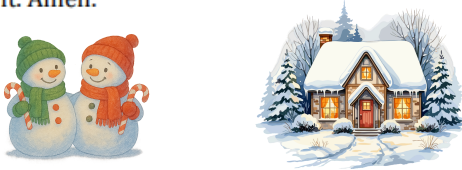
