As we keep moving toward the end of this liturgical year, Holy Mother Church keeps inviting us to reflect on the four last things: heaven, hell, death, and judgment. This Sunday, the readings focus their attention on the final judgment. Jesus in the Gospel reminds us that no one knows the time when this will come and warns us against false prophets. For this reason, Jesus calls us to persevere in our faith, even amidst tribulation and persecution, because it will be our salvation.

The Church reminds us of these realities so that we remain attentive to the care of our souls, of our relationship with God. Only those who are in the state of grace will be found innocent on the day of the last judgment. Two concrete ways that will help us be prepared are daily examination of conscience and frequent participation in the sacrament of Confession.






