All the Faithful
Departed



Feast days of All Saints and of all the Faithful Departed

The deposit of faith resembles a large tree with a broad canopy and many limbs. The trunk of that tree is the Trinitarian faith and the Christological faith, based on the revelation of God in Jesus Christ as the foundation of human Redemption and salvation. The content of the faith is trustworthy because it is founded in the authority of the Word of God, which is the authority of the Holy Spirit and the authority of Jesus Christ. A fundamental teaching concerns His body, the church. He used many images to depict this reality: the vine and the branches, the kingdom of God, the vineyard, the bride, the mustard seed, the mature wheat ready for harvest, the one fold, etc. Mother church, supported by scriptural authority, teaches that Jesus, as the head, has only one body and as the Bridegroom, only one bride.

Over the centuries, Mother Church has been a first-person witness of the realities prophesied by the Lord. Some of her most excellent members bore supreme witness of faith and love for the Lord by laying down their lives for Him. Because of their suffering, trials, but also a significant amount of virtues and invincible love and faith, she declared that such members had already canceled all their debt for sin and are already enjoying God's presence and gazing His countenance in Heaven's glory. Although, as a mother, she keeps track of such excellent members so their memory is never lost, the vast majority of the blessed in Heaven are known only to Him. This is the meaning of today's beautiful feast. All the blessed in heaven, known and unknown, canonized or not. All the ones whose souls have reached heavenly glory. We are to rejoice and glory in them. They should be a source of joy, hope, and motivation for us. They were the violent ones who had taken the Kingdom by force, but also the little ones to whom it belonged. Mother Church also invites us to pray for the souls of those thrown in jail until they have paid their last penny and those who have seen God but as though fire. Let us pray, work, and hope for the reunion of the whole mystic body of the Lord, when the Lord will be all in all.






