Humility in prayer(Lk 18:9-14) by Father Albert

I wanted to share with you my thoughts on humility. Humility and simplicity are the path to grace and blessings. In the parable of the prayer of the tax collector and the Pharisee, Jesus shows us that prayer is a humble dialogue between the child and His father or a dialogue between God and His people.

The church is the appropriate place to enter into a conversation with God. Prayer is not a moment to

For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted.

boast or to present to God your merits, and not a moment to accuse others, either, like the prayer of the Pharisee who thinks that by presenting his merits to God and blaming others, God will listen to him more.

In prayer, there are no competitions or settling scores with others. As we want to pray, we must adopt a good attitude of veneration and meditation, unlike the Pharisee who stands before God in the temple as if he wants to tell God what he deserves.

The right attitude to adopt during our prayers is that of a helpless child asking His father for help. Pride is the path to failure and desolation. Our prayer should be like the prayer of the tax collector—a humble and simple person. One who recognizes that he is a sinner and needs to be saved is a sinner.

The tax collector stood at a distance and did not even dare to raise his eyes to heaven. He presented himself before God as an honest sinner in need of salvation.

In our prayer, we must acknowledge the glory of God and ask for forgiveness of our sins. Because God saves the humble and resists the proud. Fr. Albert
