My brothers and sisters in Christ, this Sunday's readings turn their attention to the theological virtue of faith and its power. "If you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree," Be uprooted and planted in the sea and it would obey you". It is no surprise that we live in very troubling times, in which the majority of people have turned their backs on God, in which evil seems to be winning the battle, and in which we find it difficult to understand why God doesn't do anything to help us change the situation.

In these circumstances, we need to ask God to "increase our faith," and we need to remember the words of the prophet Habakkuk: "the just one, because of his faith, shall live." We need to remember that we have a God who fulfills His promises. There are two practical ways in which we can grow in faith. First, through daily silent prayer, in which we learn to surrender to God's will for us. Second, by reading and studying the Bible, through which we get to know more about God and His ways. I invite you to make these practices part of your daily schedule.

Finally, I would like to ask for your prayers for the 20 women from our pastorate who will be attending the Emmaus Retreat next weekend.
