
The Exaltation of the Holy Cross



Today's Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross is described in the ORDO as a celebration of two anniversaries in Jerusalem. Constantine erected a round church, the Anastasis, above the empty tomb of Jesus, and a basilica, the Martyrium. In the square between the two churches, a shrine, the Calvarium, marked the place of the crucifixion. This was dedicated in 335AD. The Persians destroyed the two, then rebuilt, and that was destroyed by the Muslims in 1009. The present church of the Holy Sepulcher, rebuilt by the Crusaders, was dedicated in 1149. Today also commemorates the discovery of the Lord's cross by the empress St. Helena in 320. In reading the discovery of the Lord's cross, I'm reminded of the Shrine of Our Lady of Knock. You see, I have witnessed reliquaries with what was described to me as pieces of our Lord's cross. Wait... What!

Now I don't know who had the idea to whittle the cross down and send it around the world, but I'm sure these artifacts do exist. The reason it reminds me of Our Lady of Knock Shrine is that after the apparitions, people came to Knock to see for themselves, with chisels and hammers to take a piece of the church home with them. Today, a portion of the original church wall is inlaid in the new addition, allowing people to pray against the original wall where the apparition was seen. The apparition was an excellent consolation during the potato famine in Ireland in the 1800s. Talk about your crosses...

As we celebrate today's feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, let us remember our past, our present, and hopefully our future. That the crosses we've experienced, the crosses we are now enduring, and the crosses of our future will be nothing, as St Paul tells us, compared to the glory that awaits us in heaven. 
