#### YOU are invited!

I love people and I love words, but I am not a number person! Although most weeks I spend several hours at my desk, I am not a desk person! I do these "office things" so I can do "other things". Many years ago, one of our Priests (I will let you guess who), told me, after I asked him if I could take some teens on mission trips, "You have the freedom of the daughter of God to do what you want in your ministry"! But there was an addendum to that statement-he also said I would have to find ways to pay for whatever it was I wanted to do! In my ministry here at St. Michael, I have lived by that motto! Each month, we receive anywhere from \$2,200-\$2,400 in donations that go directly to "Love is the Mission Guatemala" from online giving. We generally pay out~\$1100 in food distribution to over 100 families in the village of Playa de Oro, ~\$825 for water supplies and employee salaries in the water plant and last but not least ~\$550 for 15 students to go to school after 6th grade. All this is paid by the donations that come in monthly. As you can see, we are not always meeting our budget, so there is a need for alternative fundraising. That is where I came up with Trivia Night and Holy Fudge! The extra money that goes directly to "Love is the Mission Guatemala" comes from our Holy Fudge Sales and our Trivia Night Fundraiser. THAT IS IT!

Twice a year, January and July, (we just got back) 12-24 participants, new and returning, make the journey to Playa de Oro, Guatemala, for a Love is the Mission Trip! The cost of the trip ranges from \$1750 to \$2250 depending on flights, and how many extra/free days we have, and what we do for those days. The breakdown of our July trip is charted below per person.

\*Travel Insurance ~\$50 Airline/Baggage~\$950

\*Hotel in Guatemala City flying in and out~\$100

\*Prepared food for the week ~\$150

\*Children's Field trip~\$100

\*Interpreters fee's ~\$100

\* VBS/shirts ~\$60

\*Housing during the mission ~\$150.00

\*Transportation for the week~\$150.00

\*out of pocket expense for Volcan Pacaya ATV Tour ~\$90

To go on a Love is the Mission trip, the participant has to pay or personally work to fundraise the \$1750 to \$2250 at events that St. Michael uses for fundraisers and/or Premier Center events where we run the concession stands. We provide many opportunities to help with the expense of the trip because we do not want money to be a reason someone is unable to go.

The cost of the trip NEVER comes from any funds that are given/donated for "Love is the Mission"! Those funds are strictly for the mission! Before each trip, we do ask for donations for our trip. These donations do not go to those attending the trip. This money goes toward the expense of providing medicine to the patients that we serve in the medical clinic on the mission.

So, as I said in the beginning, YOU are invited to join us and come, and see for YOURSELF what a Love is the Mission trip to Playa de Oro, Guatemala is like. Don't take our word or anyone else's word come and see for yourself! We thank you for your prayers while on our mission in July!


