#### The Theme of 2025 World Mission Sunday

"Missionaries of Hope Among the Peoples", was a gift started by our late Pope Francis in February of 2025 and continued by Pope Leo XIV. The theme serves as a call for all Christians to be messengers of Christ's hope and love, especially to communities that face hardships.



Since 2018, St Michael Parish has been a messenger of hope to a small village in Guatemala. In Playa de Oro, the school is what holds the community together. The teachers who are there are amazing Christians; they are true missionaries of hope each day. They do so much with so little for the children. They also do a lot for us when we come to the village. The school is our host home for our daily mission in Playa de Oro. In Guatemala, the teachers struggle to get funding for the school's needs. Last year, they were able to get a bit of grant money to complete two windows in the school; there are 10 more windows that need to be completed. Grant money is extremely hard to get in Guatemala, as there are many schools in need. This past July, when we were in Playa de Oro, we observed the transformation between the new and old windows and the difference it makes in the classrooms. The old windows do not have screens to keep dust from the dirt roads out.

World Mission Sunday began in 1926, when the Church initiated asking all Catholic Churches to show their solidarity and to be messengers of hope by giving to parts of the world that are so desperately in need.

#### There are two ways you can do that here at Our Lady of Victory Pastorate:

- 1. Pick up a World Mission Envelope at the St. Michael Welcome Table or the St. George gathering space and return that, and help other mission groups in the world complete their missions. There is a big need in many parts of the world.
- 2. You can stop by the Welcome Tables and find out how to assist Love is the Mission to get the funds that we need for the window project at the school. Cash or online donations will be gratefully accepted. We will also be selling one of four gifts of St Michael Holy Fudge (with many varieties of fudge) for Christmas Presents, starting at the Parish Bazaar on November 1st, where it will be featured at the table. Stop by and take a look. Take a sample sale paper to see if others you know would like to buy some Holy Fudge Christmas gifts. Or just come talk to one of our Missionaries on how they have been changed by the hope they witnessed being in Playa de Oro, Gt.
