General Purpose

Responsible for the operation and maintenance of the surface water treatment plant, and groundwater systems.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Assists in the daily operation and maintenance of groundwater well systems including hydrant flow operations.
- Assists in the operation of the surface water treatment plant including plant start up, shut down, filter operations and instituting alternative water supply procedures.
- Assists with basic water treatment plant and equipment maintenance and checks
- Observes variations in operating conditions and interprets meter and gauge readings
- Investigates customer water service quality issues
- Installs chlorine, ammonia, and sulfur dioxide cylinders
- Assists in performing chemical operations for the water treatment plant
- Extracts samples and performs routine laboratory tests and analysis and completes required paperwork
- Operates, calibrates, transports, and performs basic equipment maintenance
- Performs operational checks on wells and treatment plants and records information on operating records and logs.
- Performs basic electrical functions including resetting and / or restarting equipment and changing fuses.
- Processes computer work orders
- Performs all duties in conformance to appropriate safety and security standards

- Bachelor's degree in Chemistry, Biology, Environmental, or related science field.

- Must be able to obtain a "Class B" Water Treatment license within one year of date of hire
