Show Rules & Information

ENTRIES: Please submit entries via <http://nthjc.horsespot.net>. E-mailed entries will not be accepted. **Please submit entries by March 6th.** A \$25 late fee will be applied on entries received after **11:59PM March 9th.** **Please reserve your stalls and shavings early via the barn account function on Horse Spot.** Location requests will be awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis.

CLASS FEES: \$25 per class. Classics & Mini-Derbies: \$50 per class. Hunter Derby: \$65. Add-Backs \$35.

STALL FEES: \$125 each, from Friday-Sunday. Shavings: \$13/Bag (3 Minimum). Early Move-In or Late Move-Out available for \$35 per night, including tack stalls. Horses not renting a stall will be charged a grounds fee of \$45. Please request early move-in with the show secretary either via the online entry form with your entries, or on your barn order.

SHOW FEES: A **non-refundable** office fee of \$15 will be required for each entry – this fee will be charged to the credit card on file in case of a scratch. Each horse/rider combination will be charged an EMT fee of \$20. An EMT will be on grounds during posted schooling and show times. A \$10 NTHJC scholarship fee will be charged to each horse-rider combination. An open check fee of \$15 will be charged for all accounts not closed at the show.

NTHJC MEMBERSHIP: All riders must be NTHJC Members for the 2026 season. Please join or renew your membership here:

NON-SHOWING ENTRIES: Non-showing entries will be charged a \$40 schooling fee, in addition to show and stall or grounds fees. Non-showing entries are required to pay office, scholarship, and EMT fee. All horses on the grounds must be registered in the show office and receive a back number.

NTHJC THOROUGHBRED HIGH POINT

AWARDS: Entry is free. TB registered name or tattoo # is required. Entry must be completed on <http://www.nthjc.com> prior to the completion of the show.

HEALTH RECORDS: Proof of a negative Coggins (EIA) within one year is required by state law. No entry will be accepted without a Copy of the Original Coggins. All horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of **Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino)** vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Vaccination records include: Documentation from veterinarian with name of given vaccinations and date. If given by other, receipt of purchase, name, serial #, exp date and date of administration. Please attach all health records to the online entry before check-in to avoid delays – **paper copies will not be accepted.**

SCHOOLING: There will be open schooling in all rings Friday from 12:00PM until 7:00PM. Schooling available prior to ring start according to the times posted on the schedule. **No Jumper schooling on Saturday or Sunday.**

LIMIT DIVISIONS: Limit divisions are open to riders who begin the show season without having won 5 blue ribbons over fences. After winning five (5) blue ribbons over fences the rider may continue to compete in this Division for the remainder of the show season. Warm up or Add Back blue ribbons will not count in the allowed Limit Blue Ribbons. Limit Riders may NOT show in any classes over 2'0 at this show.

MEDAL CLASSES: Medal classes are open to all participants. The top 8 point-earners for the 2026 season will be invited to compete at the Year End Show's Medal Finals.



Show Rules & Information (cont.)

CROSS ENTRIES: A horse/rider combination may cross enter only into divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference. Trot Poles riders may only cross enter in Trot Crossrails. Trot Crossrails riders may only cross enter into Canter Crossrails. Canter Crossrails riders can cross enter into Trot Crossrails OR Short/Rusty Stirrup 18". Entries competing in 2' Open Hunter may not cross enter into 2' Jr/Am Hunter.

AWARDS: All classes receive a first place Prize and 6 ribbons unless otherwise noted. A Champion ribbon & Prize and a Reserve Champion ribbon will be awarded for each division.

HELMETS: Properly fastened protective headgear must be worn at all times by all riders when mounted anywhere on show grounds. All headgear must meet or exceed ASTM standards, carry SEI tag and be properly fitted and secured by a harness.

DOGS: All dogs must be on a leash held in hand or confined.

CONCESSIONS: Concessions will be available during show hours.

SPLIT CLASSES: All classes, except warm-ups and specialty classes, with 20 or more entries will be split. Classes 18" and under will be split at 16 entries.

COMBINING CLASSES: Classes may be combined at the manager's discretion. Junior/Amateur classes will not be combined with classes open to professionals and the combined divisions will not exceed a 6" height difference.

ARENAS: Olde Oaks Ring (Main Hunter) – 160' x 300' Premier Equestrian artificial mix footing. Parks Ring (Hunter 2) 160' x 280' and Fairfield Ring is 135' x 300', both with sand composite footing. RWB Ring (Jumper Ring): 180' x 300' Premier Equestrian artificial mix footing. Footing quality is a priority and rings may be closed during inclement weather or for maintenance at any time during the show.

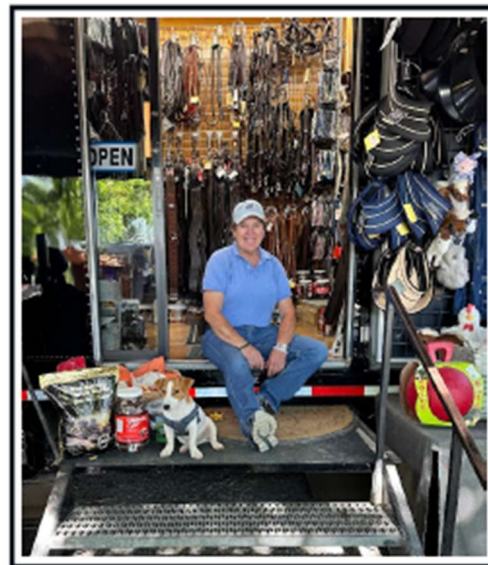

Rusty Stirrup 18" Hunter

Open to Amateur riders 18 years of age or older. Full course of 18" verticals. May be combined with Short Stirrup if entries warrant.

10,11. Over Fences 12. Under Saddle

Short Stirrup 18" Hunter

Open to Junior riders under 18 years of age who have not won 5 blue ribbons over a figure eight course or placed in a class 2'3" or higher. Full course of 18" verticals. May only cross enter into Short Stirrup Equitation and Limit Beginner 18" (WTC). May be combined with Rusty Stirrup if entries warrant.

13,14. Over Fences 15. Under Saddle

Open 2'0" Hunter

Without Oxers. Open to all riders. Horse/Rider Combination may not cross enter into Jr/Am Hunter 2'0".

19, 20. Over Fences 21. Under Saddle

Junior/ Amateur 2'0" Hunter

Without Oxers. Open to junior and amateur riders. Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into 2'0 Open Hunter.

22,23. Over Fences 24. Under Saddle

Junior 2'3" Hunter

Open to junior riders. May be combined with Adult 2'3 if entries warrant.

28,29. Over Fences 30. Under Saddle

Adult 2'3" Hunter

Open to adult amateur riders. May be combined with Junior 2'3 if entries warrant.

31,32. Over Fences 33. Under Saddle

Pony Hunter

Open to junior or amateur riders mounted on ponies. small 2'0, medium 2'3 & large 2'6.

37,38. Over Fences 39. Under Saddle 40. Pony Model

Pre-Green 2'6" Hunter

Open to horses and ponies in their first or second year of showing in any competition over fences. Open to all riders.

44,45. Over Fences 46. Under Saddle

Junior/ Amateur 2'6" Hunter

Open to junior and amateur riders.

47,48. Over Fences 49. Under Saddle

Working 2'9" Hunter

Open to all riders.

53,54. Over Fences 55. Under Saddle

Working 3'0" Hunter

Open to all riders.

Limit Equitation Trot Poles

Walk trot over ground poles, once around. Open to riders who have not won 5 blue ribbons over poles.

1,2. Over Fences 3. On the Flat

Limit Equitation Trot Crossrails 18"

Walk trot over crossrails, once around. Open to riders who have not won 5 blue ribbons over crossrails or poles.

4,5. Over Fences 6. On the Flat

Limit Equitation Canter Crossrails 18"

Walk trot canter over crossrails, twice around. Open to riders who have not won 5 blue ribbons at heights of 18" or higher.

7,8. Over Fences 9. On the Flat

Rusty/Short Stirrup Equitation 18"

Open to Junior and Amateur riders. Full course of 18" verticals.

16,17. Over Fences 18. On the Flat

Junior/Amateur 2'0 Equitation

Without Oxers. Open to junior and amateur riders. Horse/rider combination may enter into 2'0 Open Hunter or 2'0 Jr/Am Hunter, but not both.

25. Over Fences 26. Medal 27. On the Flat

Junior/ Amateur 2'3 Equitation

Open to junior and amateur riders.

34. Over Fences 35. Medal 36. On the Flat

Pony Equitation 2'0, 2'3, 2'6

Open to junior or amateur riders mounted on ponies. small 2'0, medium 2'3 & large 2'6.

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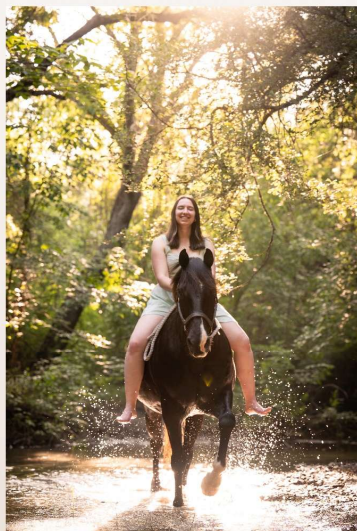

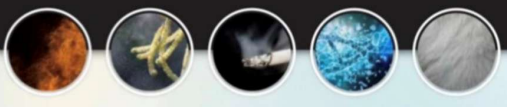

301. Leadline (Free Entry)

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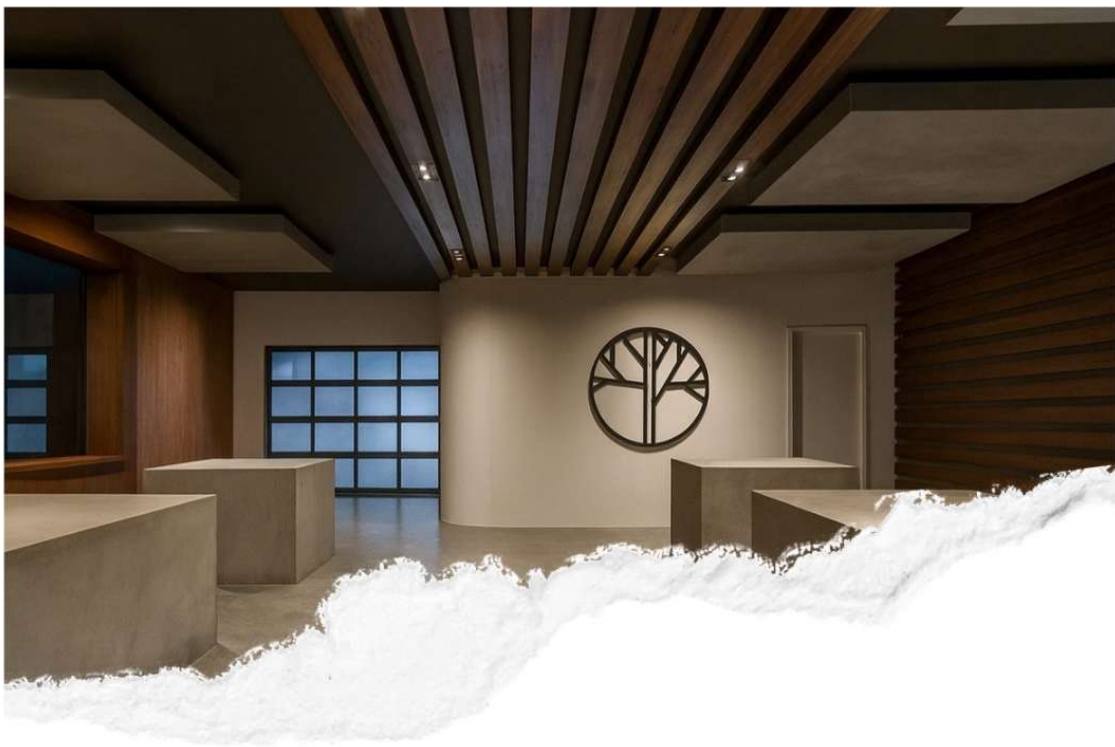
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Class 80, Entry fee \$65. Fence height 2'6" – 2'9" with 3'0" options. Open to all horses paying to compete in a full division at the show. 1st round: classic hunter course of at least 10 jumps including an in and out and minimum of 3 option fences. 2nd round scores will be based on each entry's numerical scores reflecting brilliance of pace and handiness, plus 1 bonus point for each option jump completed. No schooling of the course is allowed. Thirty minutes prior to the class entries may walk the course with horses in hand only. Three sets of ribbons 1st – 12th will be awarded.

\$500 2'0 NTHJC Mini-Derby

Sponsored by Type Six Design & Development

Class 81, entry fee \$50. Fences 2'0. Open to junior or amateur riders. Horses must compete in the Open or Jr/Am 2' Division.

First Hunter O/F round on Sunday will count as the first round. Handy Round on Sunday will be the second round.

Class may not be added at the gate, only in the office. Ribbons awarded 1st-8th place.

\$500 NTHJC 2'3/Pony Mini-Derby

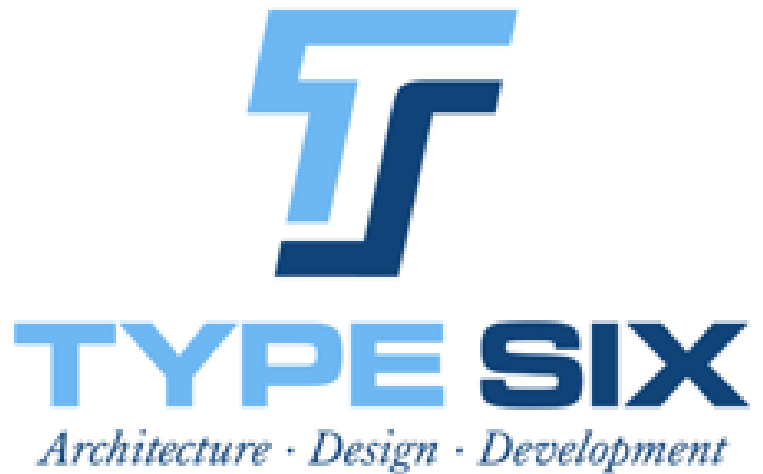
