Show Rules, Entry Fees & Stabling Information

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN, WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULEBOOK, WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

The **2025 Texas Rose Summer Welsh** is a US Equestrian Federation licensed competition. Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specification of the current Federation rule book, will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. The rules of the Federation take precedence over the rules of any other association. Exhibitors are encouraged to refer to the current Federation Rule Book, which is available at www.usef.org. A Federation Steward approved by the Show Committee shall be present to administer these rules at the show.

Opportunity Classes: Will be conducted in accordance with USEF rules. There will be no USEF membership requirement for Opportunity Classes. Opportunity exhibitors may cross-enter into recognized classes.

Rules & Specifications: For All Breed Opportunity classes are contained in this booklet. If you would like a paper copy, please contact D'Anne Liljestrand at 903-882-8696 or info@texasrosehorsepark.com. Show rules will be available in the horse show office. USEF Show rules are also available at www.usef.org.

The Horse Show Executive Committee: reserves the right to itself, to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising out of, or incident to, the show, without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. Any question not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Executive Committee, their decision to be final. The Horse Show Executive Committee is to consist of Horse Show Manager, Horse Show Secretary.

Responsibility: Submission of entry to this show constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the TRHP, LLC, Texas Rose Horse Park, WPCSA, USEF, Show Management, their officers, respective directors, agents, employees or representatives against any claims, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fees for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or its use of the premises or from any breach on the part of Exhibitors of any conditions of this Agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests, or invites in or about the premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against the TRHP, LLC, Texas Rose Horse Park, WPCSA, USEF, Show Management or their officers, respective directors, agents, employees or representatives by reason of any such claim, Exhibitor, upon notice covenants to defend such action or proceedings by counsel, acceptable to the TRHP, LLC, Texas Rose Horse Park, WPCSA, USEF, or Show Management. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property.

To be eligible to participate: as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above, Dressage Competitions, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Endurance Rides, Reining Competitions, Para Equestrian Competitions and Vaulting Competitions, persons must be Members of the Federation as provided in Bylaw 201.

Life, senior active and Jr active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combine Driving Competitions at the Advance Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the

Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

All owners and exhibitors: will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agents to barns or Texas Rose Horse Park properties on the showgrounds and will be billed accordingly.

OPERATION OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES: In accordance with GR 1301.7: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an Ad with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Amateur Non-Members: Amateur cards are no longer available for non-members. Only active Federation members may obtain amateur certification. Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the Federation.

Management: reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or cancel any entries, and to cancel award prizes, without claims for damages; to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes; and to change judges or other officials. Class Schedules: The Tentative Class Schedule is included in this booklet.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING: Management reserves the right to adjust the class schedule and class order. If entries warrant, performance may begin earlier or later than published. Please check with the horse show office for each day's final schedule. Management reserves the right to cancel classes due to scheduling and/or weather.

Balances: Any prior balances owed from owner, trainer, rider and any connection to a horse, those balances must be paid in full before allowed on TRHP properties.

Class Fees: All class fees \$25. Stake classes \$40. Double-judged halter \$20 per judge.

Entries: To be accepted, the entry blank must be **COMPLETELY** filled out and accompanied by a check covering all fees and proof of a negative Coggins Test dated within twelve months of show dates for each horse. In addition, for out of state horses, Federal law requires a health certificate within 30 days of traveling. In the case of a minor the entry blank must be signed by the parent or guardian. If there is no trainer, the trainer line on the entry blank **must be signed by the owner.** Send the completed entry blank along with all entry fees, stall fees, all other fees, and if applicable, copies of the front and back of the Certificate of registration, USEF membership card. No entry will be accepted and processed without the above. All horses entering the grounds of a licensed competition must have proof of Flu/Rhino vaccination within 6 months of entering the grounds. Online Entries: Online entries may be submitted via <http://trhp.horsespot.net>

Closing date: August 12th, 2026

Post Entries: are accepted with a penalty of \$25 per horse.

Refunds: After the closing date, entries will only be refunded (less a \$30 office fee) if a Vet Certificate is received within five days of the event. **After the closing date, there will be no refunds on stabling fees.**

Office Fee: there is an office fee of \$30.00 per entry, per show. There will be an EMT Fee of \$20 per entry, per show.

Stalls: Stalls will be available for a fee of \$115 (3 bags of shavings included) for Thurs-Sun. Tack Stalls will be available for a fee of \$95 (no bedding included) Thurs-Sun. Additional nights \$35.00 per day for each stall thereafter.

Stall availability: 12' x 12' stalls with doors, will be available on Thursday, April 10th, after 12:00 noon. Early arrivals MUST be pre-arranged with D'Anne at reservations@texasrosehorsepark.com by Tuesday, Aug. 18th, 2026. Early arrivals will be charged \$35 per stall per day.

Grounds Fees: the fee for trailering in (Grounds Fee) is \$45 per horse/per day. **Grounds fees are only required for horses not reserving a stall.**

Bedding: Additional bedding is available at the show for \$12 per bag, NO OUTSIDE SHAVINGS ALLOWED. Coastal hay is available at \$18 per bale.

Class Calls: Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, the PA System and paddock calls must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his horse is at the gate at the prescribed time. Every effort will be made to maintain a working PA System to carry class calls, however, no protest will be upheld, nor will any class be changed on the basis of PA malfunctions alone. The two minute gate rule will be strictly enforced. The in gate will be closed two minutes after the first horse enters the ring.

Food Service: During the competition food service will be available on grounds.

Camping: RV camping is available in the RV park for a fee of \$50 per night. The RV reservation form contained in this booklet must be completed and returned with payment prior to arrival. Limited number of VIP Slots (near Wagon Wheel Barn) are available for \$60/night.

Golf Carts: Golf carts are available for rent for the fee of \$100 per day. Golf Cart Reservations must be made on the enclosed form and returned with payment to guarantee a cart.

Dogs: Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition ground and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. **Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behavior.** Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6

and 7, issuance of warning cards pursuant to rule GR 1301.6 and a fine of \$100 per occurrence.

Arena Dimensions and Footing: Summerhill Ring is 160' x 300', Rose Ring is 160' x 280', Indoor Arena 125' x 225' with all-weather footing in both the competition arena and the warm-up arena.

Horse Show Office: will be open Thursday, August 19th, 2026 from 12:00 PM to 5:00 PM. The office will open one hour prior to the first class each day and will remain open for 30 minutes after the last class each day. The Horse Show Office telephone number is 903-881-0348.

Coggins Regulations: Each entry must include a copy of the animal's registration papers. Current Coggins (12 months) must be presented to Show Secretary in accordance with state law.

Health Requirement: Horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.

In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.

In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.

Driving: For animals in harness, animals must be fully bridled while hitching and unhitching. Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle, or leaving an animal unattended while hitched; anywhere on the show grounds will result in the instant elimination and removal from the show grounds. A properly attired groom or passenger is required for all pairs, tandems, unicorns or 4 in hand, capable of rendering assistance in case of an emergency. Failure to comply will result in elimination from the competition. Wire-wheeled vehicles will be acceptable in the Carriage Driving division at this show.

Attire: All riders in any class where jumping is required and/or when jumping anywhere on the show grounds must wear protective headgear. Anyone violating this rule will be prohibited from further riding until in compliance. **NOTE:** Protective headgear is advised and welcome in all classes of any age group, with no judging penalties.

Junior Exhibitors: An individual that has not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st, of the current competition year. When dividing Jr divisions into two separate age groups, these will be split into youth (age 12 and under) and youth (13 and over but who have not reached their 18th birthday by December 1st of current competition year). Jrs under 14 years of age cannot show a stallion. Jr Drivers under 14 years of age must have an experienced Ad in the carriage at all times.

Jr exhibitors must wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle at all times while on the show ground. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

Memberships: All exhibitors MUST show their current USEF membership card at the show or send a copy with show entries. EXHIBITORS AND OWNERS THAT ARE NOT USEF MEMBERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PAY A \$45 NON-MEMBER FEE directly to USEF. USEF Show Pass Fee only applies to professional and Jr competitors. In order to have amateur certification a competitor must be a member of USEF.

Measurements: All ponies in WPCSA performance classes must present a **USEF measurement card** to the show secretary or be measured at the show. All ponies and cobs (age 6 & over) entered in Halter classes must show a USEF or WPCSA measurement card or be measured. Ponies and cobs (age 5 & under) only showing in Halter classes do not have to be measured. Measurements will be done Friday, April 10th at 6:00am. Any measurements required after this scheduled time will be at owner's expense.

Premium Checks: Premium checks will be mailed within 30 days of the show. **No prize money will be deducted or paid without a social security number on file.**

Prizes: Ribbons to be given through sixth place. Championships will be awarded on points in each respective division.

Returned Check Policy: No post-dated checks will be accepted. Returned checks will be subject to a \$50 fee and must be cleared within 30 days of the last day of the show or disciplinary actions will be sought through the WPCSA, USEF, and/or the District Attorney.

Schooling: Schooling will be allowed in the show ring up to 15 minutes before the start of the show and at any time in the schooling area. Schooling over fences in the show ring is not allowed after the show starts.

SAFE SPORT STATEMENT: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse

Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

Please see page 20 for complete fee schedule, and pages 21 for paper entry blanks. Do not forget to include your liability releases with your mailed entries.

Every entry at a WPCSA sanctioned show shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that all participants: 1) shall be subject to the rules of the WPCSA and the local competition; 2) every animal and exhibitor is eligible as entered; 3) agree to be bound by the rules of the WPCSA and the local competition and accept as final any decision of the WPCSA or competition on any questions arising under said rules and agree to hold the competition, the WPCSA, their Officials, Directors and Employees harmless for any action taken; 4) agree that they participate voluntarily in the competition fully aware that equine sports and the competition involve inherent dangerous risks and by participating they expressly assume all risks of injury, loss (including death), sickness or disease (including communicable disease) and agree to indemnify and hold the WPCSA, the competition and their Officials, Directors, Employees and Agents harmless from all claims including injury or loss during or in connection with the competition whether or not such injury or loss resulted, directly or indirectly, from negligent acts or omissions of said Officials, Directors, Employees and Agents of the WPCSA or the competition. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or others under my direction and control at any WPCSA event.

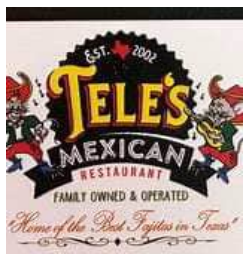

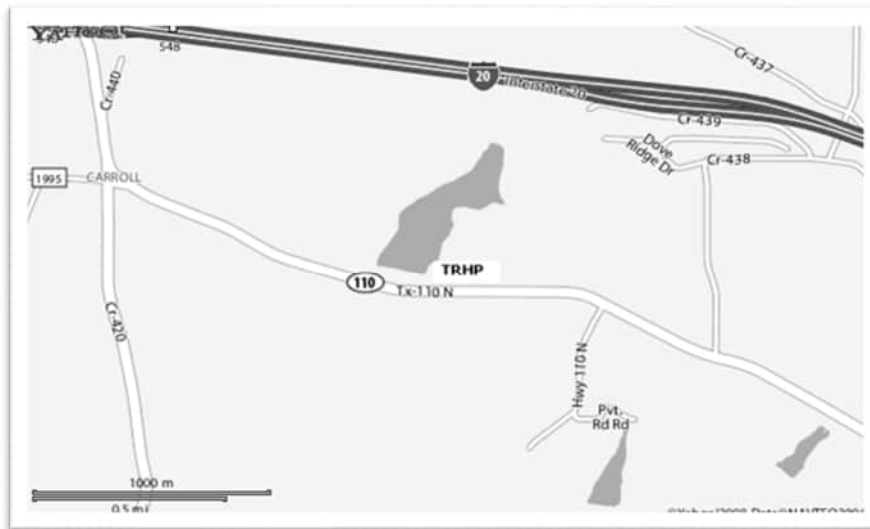

DIRECTIONS TO HORSE PARK



- From the east (Shreveport Area): take I-20 west to the Van/Tyler, Highway 110 exit (#548). Turn left/south. Go approximately 1 ½ miles. The equestrian center is on the left.
- From the west (Dallas Area): take I-20 east to the Van/Tyler, Highway 110 exit (#548). Turn right/south. Go approximately 1 ½ miles. The equestrian center is on the left.
- From the south (Houston Area): take US 287 north to TX-155 towards Tyler. At FM-2661 turn left. Left again at TX-64, right on to CR-413, then left at FM-724. Follow FM-724 to CR-42 and turn right. At TX-110 turn left. The equestrian center is on the right.
- From the south (San Antonio Area): take I-35 north to US-84 and turn right. Follow US-84 to TX-31, turn right. At FM-314 turn left, right on to FM-279, left FM-1955 and then left on to TX-110. The equestrian center is on the right.

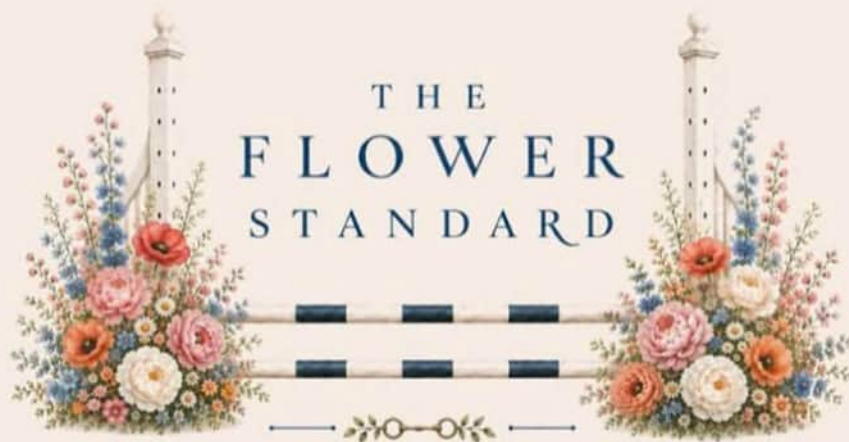

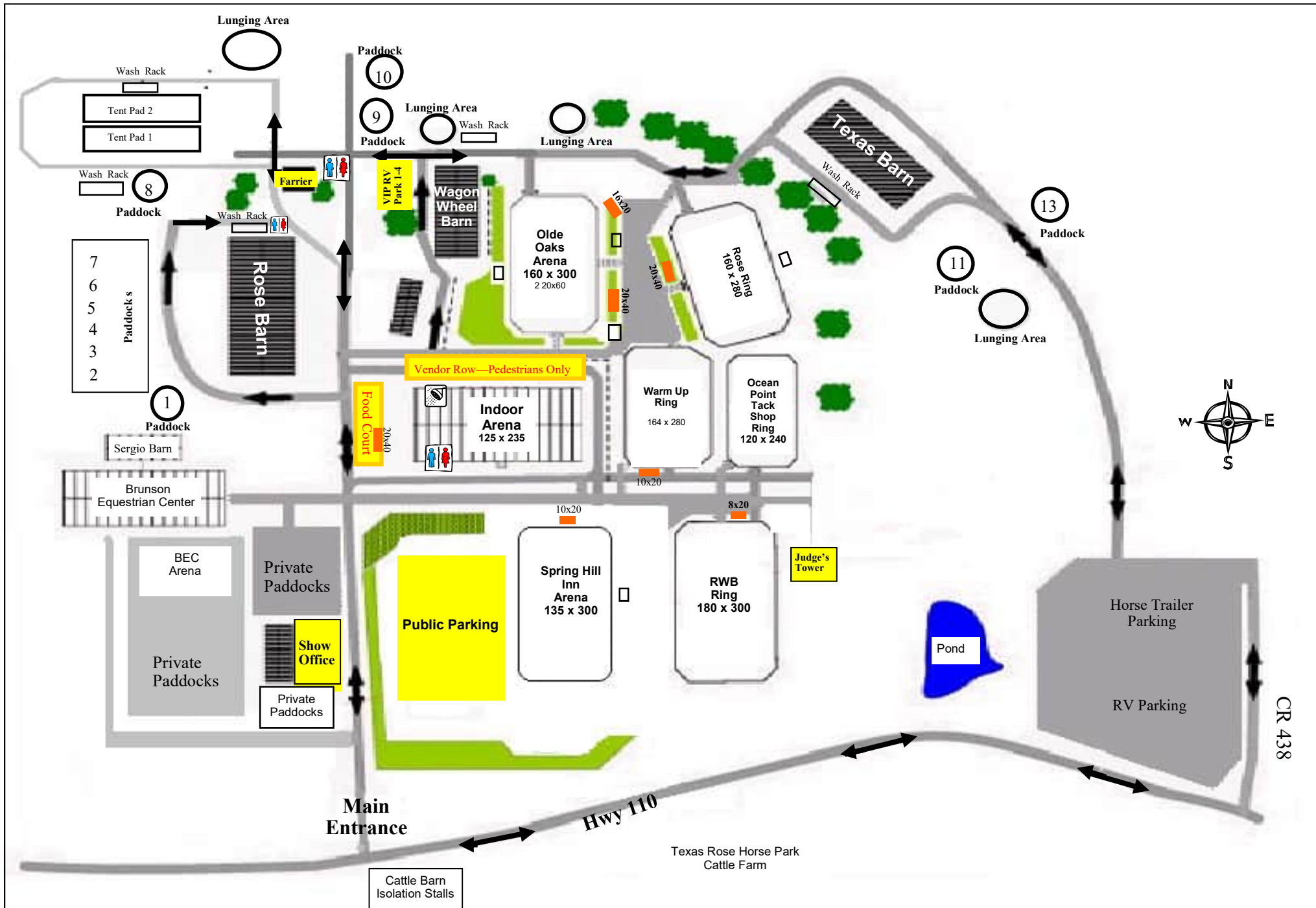

INFORMATION MUST BE POSTED IN EVENT PRIZE LIST OR COMPETITOR INFORMATION.

1. **PARKING:** Parking in designated areas only. NO PARKING is allowed in the barn area. TEMPORARY PARKING in barn areas is for the unloading and loading of trailers only. All trailers should be dropped in the approved lot and are not allowed to park in the stabling area. Public Parking is in designated areas only.
2. **CAMPER'S/RV'S/HORSE TRAILERS WITH LIVING SPACE:** Must go to campground for hook-up. NO HOOK-UP ALLOWED TO THE BARN AT ANY TIME! Limited spots available please reserve your space through the TRHP Show Services Office. RV spaces are assigned through TRHP Show Services Office.
3. **GOLF CARTS/ATV'S:** a privilege-not a right-extended to show participants. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicle, as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the Rental Agreement of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Golf carts can be rented through TRHP show services in the show office. Golf carts are rented on a first come first served basis and TRHP strongly suggests that reservations be made in advance. NO FOUR-WHEELERS, THREE WHEELERS, OR MOTOR BIKES OVER 50 cc ARE ALLOWED ON PARK GROUNDS. Golf Carts, mopeds, rural rate vehicles such as Gators and Mules, scooters, small motor bikes, and bicycles are allowed.
4. **DOGS:** Must be on a leash (not to exceed 6 feet in length) or suitably restrained in a tack stall/cage etc. Loose animal/s left in vehicles in distress, etc. can and will be removed from the grounds at the owner's expense.
5. **HORSES:** Have the right-of-way at all times.
6. **EXHIBITOR PROBLEMS/SPECIAL REQUESTS:** All non-emergency problems or special requests must be relayed through show management to ensure prompt attention.

 - No 2-prong plug appliances. No 2-prong plug extension cords. No light duty cords for indoor use.
 - No 3-way adaptors unless specifically made for outdoors.
 - No cooking in barns or tents.
 - No smoking in barns or tents.
 - No overloading electrical outlets.
 - No electrical cords on the ground or buried. FANS IN THE STABLE AREA THAT ARE CONNECTED TO A 3-PRONG HEAVY DUTY OUTDOOR EXTENSION CORD OR 3-PRONG OUTDOOR ADAPTER ARE ACCEPTABLE.
8. **STALLS:** TRHP does **not permit** the use of any **nails, fencing staples, screws, duct tape**, or any other things to be driven into any portion of the stalls or buildings, nor the signs to be affixed, with any type of material(s) that may cause damage, changes, alterations, repairs, painting or staining of any part of the stalls or buildings. Any erection or installation of equipment must be made with material(s) that are temporary in nature and will not cause permanent damage such as zip-ties, Velcro, light duty staples, masking tape, etc. NO outside shavings permitted. Violators will be charged \$100 per stall.
9. **WASTE DISPOSAL:** All trash should be placed in proper containers that are located throughout the park. Muck generated during event must be placed in designated areas. Muck should not be placed in the barns, at the end of the barns, or in any other non-designated area.
10. **SCHOOLING/LONGEING:** Schooling is at designated times/places only and will be set and posted by show management. Longeing is not allowed in any arena. Lunge in designated areas only.
