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GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

RESPONSIBILITY: Submission of entry to these shows constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify & hold harmless Texas Rose Horse Park & NTHJC Officials against any claim, demands, costs & expenses, including reasonable attorney fees for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of exhibitor's business or its use of the premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against TRHP & NTHJC management because of any such claim. Exhibitor, upon notice, covenants to defend such action or proceedings by council acceptable to owner. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property & TRHP & NTHJC Management is not responsible for accidents, fire or theft. It is the responsibility of the show management, exhibitors, trainers & spectators to conduct themselves in a civilized & sportsmanlike manner. It is the responsibility of all trainers & exhibitors to be familiar with the DHJSC rulebook

FEES & REFUNDS: An office fee of \$15, NTHJC Scholarship fee of \$10 & EMT fee of \$10 will be charged for every horse and rider combination. Stall fees will not be refunded after June 1st, 2026, unless a certificate of illness or injury prepared by an accredited veterinarian, or doctor's note regarding rider illness/injury, is presented to the secretary before the start of the show. Once the show has started, proper notification of the scratch must be made in the show office **BEFORE** the start of the class or classes being scratched or else the class fee may be charged. In either case the entry fee will be refunded less the office fee of \$15. Refund checks will be sent within 30 days of the conclusion of the show. Adds and scratches at the gate are not allowed; they must be done in the office first. Non-members will be charged a non-member fee of \$35/show. A \$15 service fee will be applied to open checks not closed by conclusion of the show. \$5 USHJA Outreach fee per horse entered in USHJA Outreach classes.

CLASS FEES: All classes are \$25 per class. Hunter Derbies are \$50.

ENTRY CLOSING DATE: Entries close Monday, June 1st, 2026 @ 6:00 pm. Entries must be made by closing date to avoid a \$25 late fee.

ENTRIES: Only online entries will be accepted. Enter at www.horsespot.net. Submitting your entry by the closing date will secure your stall reservation. Competition numbers will not be issued without an open check drawn on a US bank or valid credit card information. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry for any reason. The entry for each horse must include the following:

- Horse name and complete description
- Complete mailing addresses for owner/trainer/riders
- All mandatory signatures, including legal guardian in the case of a minor exhibitor
- All required organization membership numbers
- Current Coggins **MUST** be presented to the horse show office for all horses on grounds. A digital copy of the Coggins may be attached with entries. Texas law requires that each horse be accompanied by a negative EIA certificate dated within one year. Horses without a negative EIA certificate will **NOT** be permitted to enter the show grounds.
- Driver's license and date of birth must be noted on all checks
- Entries/post entries accepted based on stall availability

NON-SHOWING FEE: Horses, on the grounds not entered in any classes must have a completed entry blank on file in the office and will be charged a \$50 schooling fee. Non-showing entries are required to pay Office/Scholarship Fee and EMT Fee.

RETURNED CHECKS/DISPUTED CREDIT CARDS: A \$50 service fee or 10% of the amount (whichever is greater) will be charged for non-negotiable checks or credit cards declined/disputed for any reason. Entries for future shows will be declined until funds are paid in full.

STALLS: Permanent 12 X 12 stalls of wood/steel construction with doors with clay floor footing, are available for \$115/stall. Move in any time after 10:00am on Friday, June 5th, 2026. No stall doors or panels may be removed. Exhibitors are responsible for damage to stalls. Charges for any damages will be billed to the exhibitor or trainer. Trainers who submit a Block Stabling Request will have stalls assigned based upon entries received. Stall fees are not refundable after the entry closing date and are forfeited as part of the show scratch process. Early move-in or late departures must be arranged in advance at a cost of \$35 per stall per night. Please call 903-882-8696 or email reservations@texasrosehorsepark.com make these arrangements.

GROUND FEES: Horses not renting a stall will be charged a grounds fee of \$45.

SCHOOLING: Show rings will be open on Friday 12:00pm – 6:00pm for schooling prior to the show (NO EMT). Time and weather permitting, hunter rings may also be open for schooling prior to each show day until 30 minutes prior to their start times (see daily schedule). NO jumper ring schooling Saturday or Sunday.

USHJA OUTREACH PROGRAM: The show will be recognized by USHJA Outreach and qualify for USHJA Outreach points for Zone 7. To read more about the USHJA Outreach program and get your free membership, visit www.ushja.org/competition/outreach.

CHANGES: Show Management reserves the right to change, cancel, move, combine classes, alter courses and do all things necessary in the best interests of the horse show and its operations.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS (cont'd)

NTHJC THOROUGHBRED HIGH POINT AWARDS: Entry is free. TB registered name or tattoo # is required. Entry must be completed on www.nthjc.com prior to the completion of the show.

SPLIT CLASSES: All classes, except warm-ups and specialty classes, with 20 or more entries will be split. Classes 18" and under will be split at 16 entries.

DOGS: Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. **Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behavior**

FOOD & BEVERAGE SERVICE: Breakfast, lunch, snack items, a variety of smoothies and coffees are available at Escaramuza's Concessions located across from the indoor arena.

ATTIRE/HEADGEAR: All riders must be properly attired. No Chaps. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible. Protective headgear must be worn by **ALL RIDERS AT ALL TIMES WHILE MOUNTED**, anywhere, anytime on the show grounds. Headgear for **all riders** must meet or exceed ASTM Standards; must carry the SEI tag; and be properly secured by a harness. Peacock stirrups will not be allowed nor any piece of equipment with a rigid upward projection that may catch a rider's clothing.

RIBBONS/TROPHIES/CHAMPIONSHIPS: All classes receive a trophy and six ribbons unless otherwise noted. All divisions will receive a champion and reserve award based on points (10,6,4,2,1,1/2) unless otherwise noted. In the event of a tie, more over fence points will be the deciding factor.

Footing is a priority and rings may be closed during inclement weather or for maintenance at any time during the competition.

SHARPS DISPOSAL: Sharps containers will be provided in all barns for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments. **ALL** items of this nature **MUST** be disposed of in the provided containers. **NO SHARPS** are to be disposed of in any receptacle other than the provided sharps containers. **Any individual not in compliance will be subject to a \$100 fine.**

OUTSIDE COACHING: Coaching from outside the arena is not permitted while a rider is on course. Riders who receive outside assistance from their coach will be penalized at the judge's discretion.

CLASS LIMIT: Horses at NTHJC horse shows will not be permitted to show in more than 12 classes in a single show day.

DANGEROUS BEHAVIOR: If a horse exhibits dangerous behavior (such as rearing and bucking) in the show ring, warm up ring or in-gate, the Judge or Show Management reserves the right to dismiss the horse in order to protect NTHJC members, non-members, exhibitors, trainers, owners & their representatives. The judge will have final say for eliminating a horse and rider for the remainder of the show day for safety or lameness related issues.

ANIMAL WELFARE: We require that all horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion and should never be subject to mistreatment. Owners, trainers, riders and grooms, or their agents must use reasonable care in the handling and treatment of their horses whether owned or placed in their care for competition or for any other purpose. At all times, while the horse is on the show grounds, we will provide for the continuous well-being of the horse. Abuse and use of whips will be strictly enforced. No poling, use of bamboo off set or excessive use of the whip will be tolerated. The well-being of the horse must be considered above the demands of the breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organizers, sponsors or officials. Violators may be subject to penalties pursuant to USEF rules. In the event of an acute and serious injury to or illness of a horse on competition grounds when the owner or trainer of the horse or agent of the owner is not present, after reasonable effort to contact that individual has been made, competition management, in consultation with a licensed equine veterinarian, may authorize the provision of emergency veterinary treatment of the horse. If competition management so authorizes treatment under the provisions of this rule, competition management and veterinarian are not liable for any resulting costs, damages, losses, claims or actions arising directly or indirectly from the treatment of the horse.

TRHP SHOW SERVICES OFFICE

FEED & BEDDING: Feed and bedding will be available on the show grounds. Shavings cost: \$12/bag, Hay cost: \$18/bale. Advance orders are recommended and appreciated. Advance order form is located on the website www.texasrosehorsepark.com. A credit card is required with order. No outside shavings are allowed. TRHP will charge a \$100 fine per stall for anyone bringing in shavings from outside the facility.

RV'S/CAMPERS: Hookups with water and 20/30/50-amp electric are available for \$50 per day, Move- any time after 9:00am on Friday, June 5th, 2026. Please contact the show services office at 903-882-8696 or email at reservation@texasrosehorsepark.com to arrange for early or late departure. RV spaces must be reserved (rented or self-owned) utilizing the form in this prize list or found at texasrosehorsepark.com. RV spots are on a first-come basis and are limited. TRHP has 5 "VIP" spots available (50 amp only) located by the Wagon Wheel Barn. "VIP" spots are \$75 per day.

GOLF CART RENTAL: A limited number of Golf Cart Rentals are available on a first come basis for \$100 per day (3 day minimum) or \$300 per event. Reservations MUST be made utilizing the reservation form located on TRHP website www.texasrosehorsepark.com. USEF RULES PERTAINING TO THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES WILL APPLY.


PARKING: Fire regulations prohibit all vehicles, including trailers, vans, and passenger vehicles from being parked in the stable areas. Vans and trailers will be allowed in stable areas for loading and unloading only. Parking for cans and trailers is located next to the RV lot. **PARKING AREAS WILL BE DESIGNATED AND VIOLATORS WILL BE CHARGED WITH A \$200 NO PARKING FEE.**

OPERATION OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will **not** be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described vehicles so long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. **The parent, legal guardian, or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation.** Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or legal guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

PADDOCKS: Paddocks are available, on a first come basis. The cost is \$50per day. Please reserve, in advance, on the "TRHP Show Services Form" located our website www.texasrosehorsepark.com.

TRAINER SPLITS: These shows offer a service that allows trainers to split the bill in the show services office among their clients. Trainer splits must be in by Saturday at noon. Any unpaid balance will revert to the trainer. Each show must be closed out Sunday, there will be no carry overs to the next show.



DIRECTIONS TO HORSE PARK



- From the east (Shreveport Area): take I-20 west to the Van/Tyler, Highway 110 exit (#548). Turn left/south. Go approximately 1 ½ miles. The equestrian center is on the left.
- From the west (Dallas Area): take I-20 east to the Van/Tyler, Highway 110 exit (#548). Turn right/south. Go approximately 1 ½ miles. The equestrian center is on the left.
- From the south (Houston Area): take US 287 north to TX-155 towards Tyler. At FM-2661 turn left. Left again at TX-64, right on to CR-413, then left at FM-724. Follow FM-724 to CR-42 and turn right. At TX-110 turn left. The equestrian center is on the right.
- From the south (San Antonio Area): take I-35 north to US-84 and turn right. Follow US-84 to TX-31, turn right. At FM-314 turn left, right on to FM-279, left FM-1955 and then left on to TX-110. The equestrian center is on the right.

Open to Junior riders under 18 years of age. Full course of 18" verticals.



INFORMATION MUST BE POSTED IN EVENT PRIZE LIST OR COMPETITOR INFORMATION.

1. **PARKING:** Parking in designated areas only. NO PARKING is allowed in the barn area. TEMPORARY PARKING in barn areas is for the unloading and loading of trailers only. All trailers should be dropped in the approved lot and are not allowed to park in the stabling area. Public Parking is in designated areas only.
2. **CAMPER'S/RV'S/HORSE TRAILERS WITH LIVING SPACE:** Must go to campground for hook-up. NO HOOK-UP ALLOWED TO THE BARN AT ANY TIME! Limited spots available please reserve your space through the TRHP Show Services Office. RV spaces are assigned through TRHP Show Services Office.
3. **GOLF CARTS/ATV'S:** a privilege-not a right-extended to show participants. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicle, as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the Rental Agreement of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Golf carts can be rented through TRHP show services in the show office. Golf carts are rented on a first come first served basis and TRHP strongly suggests that reservations be made in advance. NO FOUR-WHEELERS, THREE WHEELERS, OR MOTOR BIKES OVER 50 cc ARE ALLOWED ON PARK GROUNDS. Golf Carts, mopeds, rural rate vehicles such as Gators and Mules, scooters, small motor bikes, and bicycles are allowed.
4. **DOGS:** Must be on a leash (not to exceed 6 feet in length) or suitably restrained in a tack stall/cage etc. Loose animal/s left in vehicles in distress, etc. can and will be removed from the grounds at the owner's expense.
5. **HORSES:** Have the right-of-way at all times.
6. **EXHIBITOR PROBLEMS/SPECIAL REQUESTS:** All non-emergency problems or special requests must be relayed through show management to ensure prompt attention.
7. **FIRE CODES:** TRHP does not allow any of the following in stalls, barns or tents:
 - No 2-prong plug appliances. No 2-prong plug extension cords. No light duty cords for indoor use.
 - No 3-way adaptors unless specifically made for outdoors.
 - No cooking in barns or tents.
 - No smoking in barns or tents.
 - No overloading electrical outlets.
 - No electrical cords on the ground or buried. FANS IN THE STABLE AREA THAT ARE CONNECTED TO A 3-PRONG HEAVY DUTY OUTDOOR EXTENSION CORD OR 3-PRONG OUTDOOR ADAPTER ARE ACCEPTABLE.
8. **STALLS:** TRHP does **not permit** the use of any **nails, fencing staples, screws, duct tape**, or any other things to be driven into any portion of the stalls or buildings, nor the signs to be affixed, with any type of material(s) that may cause damage, changes, alterations, repairs, painting or staining of any part of the stalls or buildings. Any erection or installation of equipment must be made with material(s) that are temporary in nature and will not cause permanent damage such as zip-ties, Velcro, light duty staples, masking tape, etc. NO outside shavings permitted. Violators will be charged \$100 per stall.
9. **WASTE DISPOSAL:** All trash should be placed in proper containers that are located throughout the park. Muck generated during event must be placed in designated areas. Muck should not be placed in the barns, at the end of the barns, or in any other non-designated area.
10. **SCHOOLING/LONGEING:** Schooling is at designated times/places only and will be set and posted by show management. Longeing is not allowed in any arena. Lunge in designated areas only.
