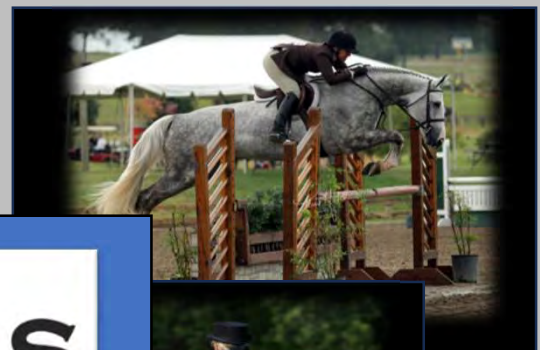

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulteur or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of _____ (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR907.4.

If not currently a USEF Active Competing member or Subscriber and competing only in classes that are exempt from membership requirements, I acknowledge and agree that I will be enrolled at no cost as a USEF Fan and my USEF Fan Account will continue to annually automatically renew unless and until USEF determines in its sole discretion to terminate my Fan account. Additionally, I acknowledge that the benefits of a USEF Fan are subject to change without notice. I acknowledge that I may opt out at any time by going to My USEF Dashboard or calling (859) 810-8733.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and _____ ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

WARNING:

UNDER TEXAS LAW (CHAPTER 87, CIVIL PRACTICE AND REMEDIES CODE), A FARM ANIMAL PROFESSIONAL IS NOT LIABLE FOR AN INJURY TO OR THE DEATH OF A PARTICIPANT IN FARM ANIMAL ACTIVITIES RESULTING FROM THE INHERENT RISKS OF FARM ANIMAL ACTIVITIES.

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (**Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"**), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("**Liability**") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

E. COMPLETE AGREEMENT AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: This Agreement represents the complete understanding between the parties regarding these issues and no oral representations, statements or inducements have been made apart from this Agreement. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unlawful, void, or for any reason unenforceable, then that provision shall be deemed severable from this Agreement and shall not affect the validity and enforceability of any remaining provisions.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS DOCUMENT IN ITS ENTIRETY, UNDERSTAND ALL OF ITS TERMS AND CONDITIONS, AND KNOW IT CONTAINS AN ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND WAIVER FROM LIABILITY, AS WELL AS A HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION OBLIGATIONS.

If, despite this Agreement, I, or anyone on my behalf or the minor's behalf, makes a claim for Liability against any of the Released Parties, I will indemnify, defend and hold harmless each of the Released Parties from any such Liabilities as the result of such claim.

The parties agree that this agreement may be electronically signed. The parties agree that the electronic signatures appearing on this agreement are the same as handwritten signatures for the purposes of validity, enforceability, and admissibility.

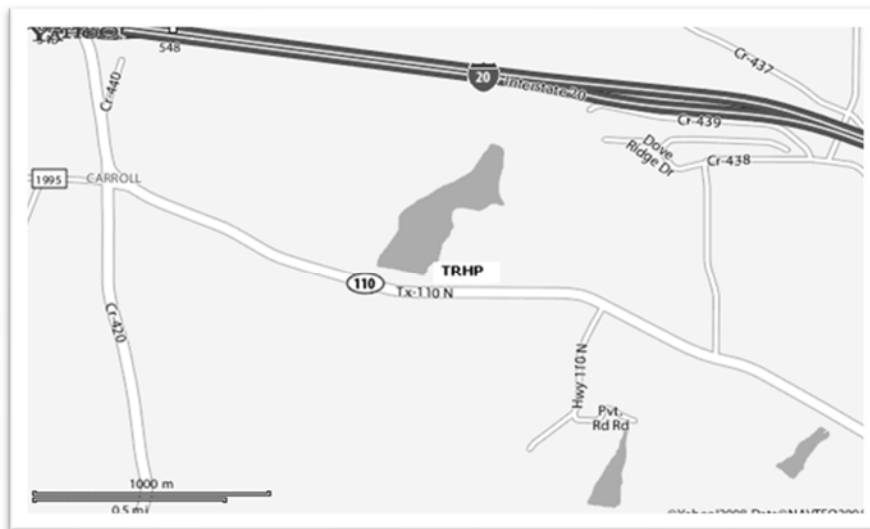

DIRECTIONS TO HORSE PARK



- From the east (Shreveport Area): take I-20 west to the Van/Tyler, Highway 110 exit (#548). Turn left/south. Go approximately 1 ½ miles. The equestrian center is on the left.
- From the west (Dallas Area): take I-20 east to the Van/Tyler, Highway 110 exit (#548). Turn right/south. Go approximately 1 ½ miles. The equestrian center is on the left.
- From the south (Houston Area): take US 287 north to TX-155 towards Tyler. At FM-2661 turn left. Left again at TX-64, right on to CR-413, then left at FM-724. Follow FM-724 to CR-42 and turn right. At TX-110 turn left. The equestrian center is on the right.
- From the south (San Antonio Area): take I-35 north to US-84 and turn right. Follow US-84 to TX-31, turn right. At FM-314 turn left, right on to FM-279, left FM-1955 and then left on to TX-110. The equestrian center is on the right.

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN, WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULEBOOK, WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

The rules of USEF take precedence over the rules of any other association. Exhibitors are encouraged to refer to the current USEF Rule Book, which is available at www.usef.org. A Federation Steward approved by the Show Committee shall be present to administer these rules at the show.

HORSE SHOW OFFICE: Open Thursday, April 9th, 2026 from 2:00 PM to 7:00 PM. The office will open one hour prior to the first class each day and will remain open for 30 minutes after the last class each day. The Horse Show Office telephone number is 903-881-0348.

OPPORTUNITY CLASSES: Will be conducted in accordance with USEF rules. There will be no USEF membership requirement for Opportunity Classes. Opportunity exhibitors may cross-enter into recognized classes.

RULES & SPECIFICATIONS: For All Breed Opportunity classes are contained in this booklet. If you would like a paper copy, please contact D'Anne Liljestrand at 903-882-8696 or Danne@texasrosehorsepark.com. Show rules will be available in the horse show office. USEF Show rules are also available at www.usef.org.

THE HORSE SHOW EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE: reserves the right to itself, to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising out of, or incident to, the show, without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. Any question not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Executive Committee, their decision to be final. The Horse Show Executive Committee is to consist of Horse Show Manager, Horse Show Secretary.

RESPONSIBILITY: Submission of entry to this show constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the TRHP, LLC, Texas Rose Horse Park, WPCSA, USEF, Show Management, their officers, respective directors, agents, employees or representatives against any claims, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fees for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or its use of the premises or from any breach on the part of Exhibitors of any conditions of this Agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests, or invites in or about the premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against the TRHP, LLC, Texas Rose Horse Park, WPCSA, USEF, Show Management or their officers, respective directors, agents, employees or representatives by reason of any such claim, Exhibitor, upon notice covenants to defend such action or proceedings by counsel, acceptable to the TRHP, LLC, Texas Rose Horse Park, WPCSA, USEF, or Show Management. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property.

TO BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE: as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above, Dressage Competitions, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Endurance Rides, Reining Competitions, Para Equestrian Competitions and Vaulting Competitions, persons must be Members of the Federation as provided in Bylaw 201. Life, senior active and Jr active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combine Driving Competitions at the Advance Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deaux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

ALL OWNERS AND EXHIBITORS: will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agents to barns or Texas Rose Horse Park properties on the showgrounds and will be billed accordingly.

OPERATION OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES: In accordance with GR 1301.7: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an Ad with a valid

driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

AMATEUR NON-MEMBERS: Amateur cards are no longer available for non-members. Only active Federation members may obtain amateur certification. Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur

MANAGEMENT: reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or cancel any entries, and to cancel award prizes, without claims for damages; to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes; and to change judges or other officials.

SETTLEMENT OF ACCOUNTS: All show accounts must be closed out at the end of each week. Any open entry accounts will be closed by management and a \$60 processing fee will be added per entry. All questions about show accounts must be addressed within 48 hours of the conclusion of the show.

RETURNED CHECKS/DISPUTED CREDIT CARDS: A \$50 service fee or 10% of the amount (whichever is greater) will be charged for non-negotiable checks or credit cards declined/disputed for any reason. Entries for future shows will be declined until funds are paid in full.

CREDIT CARD FEE: A convenience fee of four percent (3%) of the total invoice will be added to all invoices being paid with a credit card.

SCHEDULE: The Tentative Class Schedule is included in this booklet. Management reserves the right to adjust the class schedule and class order. If entries warrant, performance may begin earlier or later than published. Please check with the horse show office for each day's final schedule.

CLASS FEES: All class fees \$25. Stake classes \$40. Double-judged halter \$20 per judge. Jumping Fee of \$15.

BALANCES: Any prior balance owed from owner, trainer, rider and any connection to a horse, those balances MUST be paid in full before allowed on TRHP properties.

ENTRIES: To be accepted, the entry blank must be COMPLETELY filled out and accompanied by a check covering all fees and proof of a negative Coggins Test dated within twelve months of show dates for each horse. In addition, for out of state horses, Federal law requires a health certificate within 30 days of traveling. In the case of a minor the entry blank must be signed by the parent or guardian. If there is no trainer, the trainer line on the entry blank must be signed by the owner. Send the completed entry blank along with all entry fees, stall fees, all other fees, and if applicable, copies of the front and back of the Certificate of registration, USEF membership card. No entry will be accepted and processed without the above. All horses entering the grounds of a licensed competition must have proof of Flu/Rhino vaccination within 6 months of entering the grounds. Read the details: www.usef.org.

ONLINE ENTRIES: Online entries may be submitted via <http://www.horsespot.net>

CLOSING DATE: April 2nd, 2026.

POST ENTRIES: are accepted with a penalty of \$25 per horse.

REFUNDS: After the closing date, entries will only be refunded (less a \$25 handling fee) if a Vet Certificate is received within five days of the event. After the closing date, there will be no refunds on stabling fees.

FEDERATION FEES: for every horse participating in any competition recognized by the Federation, a \$25.00 Federation fee will be collected (\$10.00 is of USEF) and (\$15.00 shall be a drugs and medications fee to provide for research, inspection and enforcement of rules regarding use of medications and drugs; see Federation GR407.1, 2, 3). USEF fees only apply for Friday, Apr. 10th competition, USEF Lite competition does not require federation fees.

OFFICE FEE: there is an office fee of \$30.00 per entry, per show. There will be an EMT Fee of \$10 per entry, per show.

STALLS: 12' x 12' stalls with doors will be available for a fee of \$115 (3 bags of shavings included) for Thurs-Sun. Tack Stalls will be available for a fee of \$95 (no bedding included) Thurs-Sun. Early arrivals MUST be pre-arranged with D'Anne at reservations@texasrosehorsepark.com by Tuesday, Apr 7th, 2026. Early arrivals will be charged \$35 per stall per day.

GROUND'S FEES: the fee for trailering in (Grounds Fee) is \$45 per horse/per day. Grounds fees are only required for horses not reserving a stall.

FEED & BEDDING: Feed and bedding will be available on the show grounds. Additional bedding is available at the show for \$12 per bag. Coastal hay is available at \$18 per bale. Advance orders are recommended and appreciated. Advance order form located on the website www.texasrosehorsepark.com. A credit card is required with order. **NO OUTSIDE SHAVINGS ALLOWED.** TRHP will charge a \$100 fine per stall for anyone bringing in shavings from outside the facility.

PARKING: Fire regulations prohibit all vehicles, including trailers, vans and passenger vehicles from being parked in the stable areas. Vans and trailers will be allowed in the stable area only to load and off-load. **PARKING AREAS WILL BE DESIGNATED AND VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AWAY AT OWNER'S EXPENSE**

CLASS CALLS: Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, the PA System and paddock calls must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his horse is at the gate at the prescribed time. Every effort will be made to maintain a working PA System to carry class calls, however, no protest will be upheld, nor will any class be changed on the basis of PA malfunctions alone. The two minute gate rule will be strictly enforced. The in gate will be closed two minutes after the first horse enters the ring.

FOOD & BEVERAGE SERVICE: Breakfast, lunch, snack items, a variety of smoothies and coffees are available at Escaramuza's Concessions located across from the indoor arena.

RV'S/CAMPERS: Hookups with water and 20/30/50-amp electric are available for \$50 per night. Move-in is as follows: any time after 9:00am on Wednesday, April 8th, 2026. Please contact the show services office at 903-882-8696 or email at reservation@texasrosehorsepark.com arrange for early or late departure. RV spaces must be reserved (rented or self-owned) utilizing the form in this prize list or found at texasrosehorsepark.com. RV spots are on a first come basis and are limited. TRHP has 5 "VIP" spots available (50 amp only) located by the Wagon Wheel Barn. "VIP" spots are \$75 per night.

GOLF CART RENTAL: A limited number of Golf Cart Rentals are available on a first come basis for \$100 per day (3 day minimum) or \$400 per week. Reservations MUST be made utilizing the reservation form located on TRHP website www.texasrosehorsepark.com. USEF RULES PERTAINING TO THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES WILL APPLY.

DOGS: Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition ground and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behavior. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, issuance of warning cards pursuant to rule GR 1301.6 and a fine of \$100 per occurrence.

Footing is a priority and rings may be closed during inclement weather or for maintenance at any time during the competition.

ANIMAL WELFARE: We require that all horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion and should never be subject to mistreatment. Owners, trainers, riders and grooms, or their agents must use reasonable care in the handling and treatment of their horses whether owned or placed in their care for competition or for any other purpose. At all times, while the horse is on the show grounds, we will provide for the continuous well-being of the horse. Abuse and use of whips will be strictly enforced. No poling, use of bamboo off set or excessive use of the whip will be tolerated. The well-being of the horse must be considered above the demands of the breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organizers, sponsors or officials. Violators may be subject to penalties pursuant to USEF rules. In the event of an acute and serious injury to or illness of a horse on competition grounds when the owner or trainer of the horse or agent of the owner is not present, after reasonable effort to contact that individual has been made, competition management, in consultation with a licensed equine veterinarian, may authorize the provision of emergency veterinary treatment of the horse. If competition management so authorizes treatment under the provisions of this rule, competition management and veterinarian are not liable for any resulting costs, damages, losses, claims or actions arising directly or indirectly from the treatment of the horse.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: GR845 EQUINE VACCINATION RULE: Horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino pneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the show grounds. Horses without proper proof of vaccines will not be permitted to enter the show grounds.

HEALTH CERTIFICATES/COGGINS TEST: A Health Certificate dated within 21 days of arrival to be presented when entering the show grounds. CVI must state the horse(s) has not been treated for an elevated temperature or anything related to herd health in the last 21 days. Horses without a Health certificate will not be permitted to enter the show grounds. Texas law requires that each horse be accompanied by a negative EIA certificate dated within one year. Horses without a negative EIA certificate will not be permitted to enter the show grounds.

DRIVING: For animals in harness, animals must be fully bridled while hitching and unhitching. Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle, or leaving an animal unattended while hitched; anywhere on the show grounds will result in the instant elimination and removal from the show grounds. A properly attired groom or passenger is required for all pairs, tandems, unicorns or 4 in hand, capable of rendering assistance in case of an emergency. Failure to comply will result in elimination from the competition. Wire-wheeled vehicles will be acceptable in the Carriage Driving division at this show.

ATTIRE: All riders in any class where jumping is required and/or when jumping anywhere on the show grounds must wear protective headgear. Anyone violating this rule will be prohibited from further riding until in compliance. NOTE: Protective headgear is advised and welcome in all classes of any age group, with no judging penalties.

JUNIOR EXHIBITORS: An individual that has not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st, of the current competition year. When dividing Jr divisions into two separate age groups, these will be split into youth (age 12 and under) and youth (13 and over but who have not reached their 18th birthday by December 1st of current competition year). Jrs under 14 years of age cannot show a stallion. Jr Drivers under 14 years of age must have an experienced Ad in the carriage at all times. Jr exhibitors must wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle at all times while on the show ground. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

MEMBERSHIP: All exhibitors MUST show their current USEF membership card at the show or send a copy with show entries. EXHIBITORS AND OWNERS THAT ARE NOT USEF MEMBERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PAY A \$45 NON-MEMBER FEE directly to USEF. USEF Show Pass Fee only applies to professional and Jr competitors. In order to have amateur certification a competitor must be a member of USEF.

MEASUREMENTS: All ponies in WPCSA performance classes must present a USEF measurement card to the show secretary or be measured at the show. All ponies and cobs (age 6 & over) entered in Halter classes must show a USEF or WPCSA measurement card or be measured. Ponies and cobs (age 5 & under) only showing in Halter classes do not have to be measured. Measurements will be done Friday, April 10th at 6:30am. Any measurements required after this scheduled time will be at owner's expense.

SCHOOLING: Will be allowed in the show ring up to 15 minutes before the start of the show and at any time in the schooling area. Schooling over fences in the show ring is not allowed after the show starts.

SAFE SPORT STATEMENT: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

PREMIUM CHECKS: Premium checks will be mailed within 30 days of the show. No prize money will be deducted or paid without a social security number on file.

PRIZES: Ribbons to be given through sixth place. Championships will be awarded on points in each respective division.

PRIZE MONEY: Prize money is indicated for each class. Prize money won can be paid by check or deducted from each horse's account. **An IRS W-9 form must be completed in full before any prize money will be paid.** Prize money will be withheld if the recipient's Social Security number or EIN number is not on file. Prize money will be payable to the owner unless written authorization, and **complete** alternate payee information, is on file with the show secretary. All prize money will be paid within 30 days of the show's conclusion.

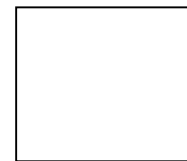

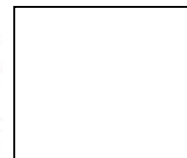

MEMBERSHIP

- a) Any person, firm or corporation owning or interested in Welsh ponies or cobs shall be eligible for membership.
- b) There shall be two (2) classes of membership: voting and non-voting.

Voting memberships are defined as follows:

1. Senior Life Membership – those persons who have reached their 18th birthday by January 1st of the current year.
2. Annual Membership – those persons who have reached their 18th birthday by January 1st of the current year.
3. Family/Firm – immediate family unit - parent/guardian and minor children (who have not reached their 18th birthday) or a corporation/firm or association. The Family/Firm unit will be entitled to only one vote.

Non-Voting Memberships shall be defined as follows:

4. Junior Life Membership – those persons who have not reached their 18th birthday by January 1st of the current year. Upon reaching 18, the membership will become Senior Life.
5. Annual Associates - those persons who have reached their 18th birthday by January 1st of the current year & who are interested in the breed but do not desire full membership privileges. No reduction of transfer & registration fees.
6. Junior Membership - those persons who have not reached their 18th birthday by January 1st of the current year.

New Life members receive a complimentary pin; new Annual, Family/Firm & Annual Assoc. members receive a complimentary three-inch decal; new Junior members receive a complimentary poster.

1. **PARKING:** Parking in designated areas only. NO PARKING is allowed in the barn area. TEMPORARY PARKING in barn areas is for the unloading and loading of trailers only. All trailers should be dropped in the approved lot and are not allowed to park in the stabling area. Public Parking is in designated areas only.
2. **CAMPER'S/RV'S/HORSE TRAILERS WITH LIVING SPACE:** Must go to campground for hook-up. NO HOOK-UP ALLOWED TO THE BARN AT ANY TIME! Limited spots available. Please reserve your space at www.texasrosehorsepark.com or through the TRHP Show Services Office. RV spaces are assigned through TRHP Show Services Office.
3. **GOLF CARTS/ATV'S:** a privilege-not a right-extended to show participants. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicle, as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the Rental Agreement of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Golf carts can be rented through TRHP show services in the show office. Golf carts are rented on a first come first served basis and TRHP strongly suggests that reservations be made in advanced. NO FOUR-WHEELERS, THREE WHEELERS, OR MOTOR BIKES OVER 50 cc ARE ALLOWED ON PARK GROUNDS. Golf Carts, mopeds, rural rate vehicles such as Gators and Mules, scooters, small motor bikes, and bicycles are allowed.
4. **DOGS:** Must be on a leash (not to exceed 6 feet in length) or suitably restrained in a tack stall/cage etc. Loose animal/s left in vehicles in distress, etc. can and will be removed from the grounds at the owner's expense.
5. **HORSES:** Have the right-of-way at all times.
6. **EXHIBITOR PROBLEMS/SPECIAL REQUESTS:** All non-emergency problems or special requests must be relayed through show management to ensure prompt attention.
7. **FIRE CODES:** TRHP does not allow any of the following in stalls, barns or tents:
 - No 2-prong plug appliances. No 2-prong plug extension cords. No light duty cords for indoor use.
 - No 3-way adaptors unless specifically made for outdoors.
 - No cooking in barns or tents.
 - No smoking in barns or tents.
 - No overloading electrical outlets.
 - No electrical cords on the ground or buried. FANS IN THE STABLE AREA THAT ARE CONNECTED TO A 3-PRONG HEAVY DUTY OUTDOOR EXTENSION CORD OR 3-PRONG OUTDOOR ADAPTER ARE ACCEPTABLE.
8. **STALLS:** TRHP does **not permit** the use of any **nails, fencing staples, screws, duct tape**, or any other things to be driven into any portion of the stalls or buildings, nor the signs to be affixed, with any type of material(s) that may cause damage, changes, alterations, repairs, painting or staining of any part of the stalls or buildings. Any erection or installation of equipment must be made with material(s) that are temporary in nature and will not cause permanent damage such as zip-ties, Velcro, light duty staples, masking tape, etc. A stall deposit will be charged for bringing in outside shavings, refundable if stall is clean upon leaving.
9. **WASTE DISPOSAL:** All trash should be placed in proper containers that are located throughout the park. Muck generated during event must be placed in designated areas. Muck should not be placed in the barns, at the end of the barns, or in any other non-designated area.
10. **SCHOOLING/LUNGEING:** Schooling is at designated times/places only and will be set and posted by show management. Lungeing is not allowed in any arena. Lunge in designated areas only.
